

As per the NCR, the entry fee must be received in full before the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event before the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee may apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

1.8 DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

Pre-event Documentation is to be emailed to experts@wacarclub.com prior to Metro Scrutiny & Documentation (see Event Program).

Event Scrutiny will be conducted in accordance with *Article F5 Event Scrutiny (Targeted)* of the MWARCS SSR. A list of vehicles selected for scrutiny will be provided following close of entries. Vehicles selected must attend Scrutiny as per the Event Program. Competitors are required to complete a *Self Scrutiny Checklist – Rally/Road and Targeted Scrutiny Program Statement of*

Vehicle Compliance TSP03 and present them with their pre-event documentation. The Statement of Vehicle Compliance may also be accepted via the Event Entry System.

Competitors not required for scrutiny will be able to collect their stickers and road books etc at Scrutiny & Documentation as per the Event Program

Location and time of scrutiny and documentation are shown in the Event Program.

1.9 APPAREL

All competitors in the Event must comply with the apparel requirements as per the "State" level Gravel / Tarmac Rally in *Schedule D – Apparel* of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed before scrutiny.

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied.

Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact for vehicle speed, location and "Push to Pass"

A to A timing will be used as per the 2023 Motorsport Australia WA Rally Championship Regulations.

AWARDS

1.10 PRESENTATION

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the event.

Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish.

WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish

1.11 EXPERTS CUP

In addition to normal awards a trophy, the Experts Cup, will be awarded to crews with a stage time, excluding road penalties, that is one of the SIX fastest on every special stage

SERVICING & REFUELLING

The service park for the event will be located at Lot 2864 Forest Street, Collie. See service park map for approved areas. Please note that traffic flow within the service park is ONE WAY (clockwise direction only),

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/refuelling operation.

Crews are allowed to deviate from the Road Book for the sole purpose of refuelling from Service Station Pumps.

RECONNAISSANCE

Times for reconnaissance are shown in the Event Program.

ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TC0.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

PROTEST

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Manual and NCR.

POST EVENT FUNCTION & PRESENTATION

The awards presentation for Clubman Masters, Clubman and WARC competitors at the Club Hotel, 138 Forrest Street, Collie.

INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES
