The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, The National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorsport Australia Rally Standing Regulations – Vehicles General, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Special Stage Rallies, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Events General, The Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR), these Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

This event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

2. ENTRIES

Entries may only be made by using the WOLF online entry system at:

<https://app.wolfacility.com/>

Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Entries Secretary. Payment is to be by Credit Card or EFT, as directed on the entry form. Entries will only be accepted when the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver/Navigator have been nominated on the entry form and payment has been made in full.

Crew members must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Rally (Drivers/CoDrivers), or a Rally Navigator (CoDrivers) competition licence.

All entries MUST include an electronic copy of all required documentation as listed in the WARC Sporting and Technical Regulations and/or as directed on the entry form. The Motorsport Australia Risk Warning, Disclaimer and Indemnity document, the Motorsport Australia Statement of Vehicle & Crew Compliance document as well as any further documents required via the entry system must be acknowledged by the Competitor, Driver, Co-Driver/Navigator and Service Crew via the electronic requirements of the entry system.

Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations.

Entries close as per the EVENT PROGRAM.

The maximum number of entries will be 70, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full BEFORE the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee may apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

3. EVENT DETAILS

3.1 See Event Program for Dates and Times

3.2 Ceremonial Start

A ceremonial start will be conducted through Brockman Street Mall, cars are to be arranged from 1530hrs onwards in starting order.

All Crew are required to be in the Ceremonial Start area in **their racing attire** from 1600hrs. Crews are encouraged to bring posters, giveaways and other team merchandise to add to the atmosphere.

Competitors will be flagged away from the ceremonial start between 5pm and 5.30pm

3.3 See **Itinerary** for Distances

3.4 The **Official Notice Board** will be located online at www.rallywa.com via the SPORTITY application (Password: WACC) and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (see Event Program)

3.5 Re-joining

For all crews which re-join a time penalty will be applied as per MWARCS SSR F17.

3.6 Documentation and Scrutiny

Pre-event Documentation is to submitted through the WOLF entry system prior to Metro Scrutiny & Documentation (see Event Program).

Scrutiny will be undertaken as per MWARCS SSR F5 Event Scrutiny (Selected).

Competitors not required for scrutiny will be able to collect their stickers and road books etc at Scrutiny & Documentation as per the Event Program

Location and time of scrutiny and documentation are shown in the Event Program and a Communiqué showing the location and times for each car selected for scrutiny will be issued.

3.7 Apparel

All competitors in the Event must comply with the apparel requirements as per the “State” level Gravel / Tarmac Rally in *Schedule D – Apparel* of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

4. RALLYSAFE

4.1 Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed and location.

4.2 All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny and it **must be powered from a permanent power source**. Fitting kits are available directly from RallySafe <https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/>

4.3 The RallySafe unit in each car must be fitted and “Powered on” PRIOR to entering the RallySafe Tech Zone (WARC) or Drivers Briefing (Clubman Competitors).

4.4 RallySafe “Tech Zone”

As per the Itinerary all cars must be present in the Rally Safe Tech Zone (Brockman Street Show n Shine) at the time stated in the Event Program so that the RallySafe unit location, cables, connections, aerial position, power and connectivity can be inspected and checked.

4.5 If a “Push to Pass” is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied.

5. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the Event.

6. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

6.1 The Service Park for the event will be located as per the attached map at Rose St (between Mount St and Brockman St). **Please do not park in Chicken Treat car park. See service park map for approved service areas and designated trailer parking.**

6.2 Note that the Service Park is NOT open Friday. There is NO Parc Fermé on Friday evening.

6.3 Only 1 service vehicle per competing car will be permitted in the Service Park.

6.4 Trailers are not permitted to remain in the Service Park. Trailers must only be parked in the

allocated area and access must be via the marked driveway/crossover (see Appendix 3 below).

- 6.5 Please be aware of not restricting access to the Police station rear entrance on Rose Street when loading/unloading, parking or collecting trailers.
- 6.6 There will be refuel area available adjacent to the Reject Shop. The service crew are to comply with apparel requirements and to follow the directions of rally officials.
- 6.7 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/refuelling operation.
- 6.8 Crews are allowed to deviate from the Road Book for the sole purpose of refuelling from Service Station Pumps.

7. RECONNAISSANCE

- 7.1 Reconnaissance time is flexible as per the schedule in the Event Program, with the exception of the MotoX stage which has restricted access. Reconnaissance times for the MotoX stage will be advised in a separate communique.
- 7.2 Crews may complete two passes (only) of each stage.
- 7.3 An electronic copy of the Road Book (PDF) and Stage Maps (Google Maps link) will be provided to competitors who have completed their entry form online (including accepting the Motorsport Australia Disclaimers) AND have paid their entry fee.
- 7.4 Crews must inform WA Car Club by either email rally@wacarclub.com.au or SMS 0412 973 722 when they are completing their recce. Email / SMS is to include Competition Number and Reconnaissance vehicle Make, Model, Colour and Registration Number.**
- 7.5 Competitors are reminded that all roads are open to the public and to expect oncoming traffic. Road rules must be adhered to at all times.
- 7.6 Note that Control Boards, Instruction Numbers, Caution Boards, Delineators and other course markings may not be in position during Flexi Reconnaissance
- 7.7 Complaints received regarding behavior during recce will be treated with the utmost severity.

8. ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TCO.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check

9. PROTEST

Protest must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

10. INTEGRITY

Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
