1. ORGANISATION

The Event shall be a State Special Stage Rally incorporating a Club Special Stage Rally held under the following –

- The FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices
- The National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia
- The Motorsport Australia Rally Standing Regulations - Special Stage Rallies (SSR)
- The Rally Standing Regulations - Vehicles General (VG)
- The Rally Standing Regulations - Events General (EG)
- The Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR),
- These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

2. ENTRIES

Entries may only be made by using the Motorsport Australia online entry system via the Motorsport Australia member portal.

Crew members must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Rally (Drivers), or a Rally Junior (Co-Drivers) competition licence.

The maximum number of entries will be 70, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

The Event Organiser reserves the right to postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee will apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries and prior to reconnaissance being completed. A \$350 fee will apply to withdrawals after reconnaissance and prior to scrutiny. NO REFUND will be granted for entries withdrawn after Tuesday 17 June 2025.

2.2 Event Details

See Event Program for Dates and Times. See Itinerary for Distances.

The Official Notice Board will be located online at www.rallywa.com and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (See Event Program).

Bonus points will be allocated as per the MAWARCS SSR Article H2 (vi) on SS6.

2.3 Documentation and Scrutiny

Competitor documentation (licenses, permits etc) are to be submitted electronically to grimwade@lightcarclub.com.au before close of entries date.

Scrutiny will be undertaken as per MAWARCS SSR F7 Event Scrutiny (Selected).

Event stickers and road books can be collected by competitors as per the Event Programme.

Location and time of scrutiny are shown in the Event Programme and a Bulletin with the selected vehicles and times will be issued.

3. RALLYSAFE

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed, location and "Push to Pass" notification.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny and it must be powered from a permanent power source. There are available from RallySafe

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the RallySafe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied. RallySafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact for "Push to Pass" notification.

All cars must present to the RallySafe "Tech Zone" at least 10 minutes prior to their due time at TCO. A final check of the RallySafe unit, location, cables, connections, aerial position, power and connectivity will take place to ensure it is working correctly.

4. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the Event. Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish.

5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A. The Service Park for the event will be located at VC Mitchell Park Donnybrook. Service Vehicles may be parked in the Service Park overnight. The Organisers take no responsibility for any vehicles.
- B. Refuelling is also permitted at both BP and Vibe Service Stations **But must be within Liaison times** (both supply 98 Octane Fuel) There will be only one opportunity to refuel the car. The Refuel will be located within the Service Park. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- C. **Remote Refueling** will be available at Grimwade-Wilga Road between SS2/SS3 and SS4/SS5 within signposted refuel zone. Enough Fuel will need to be sent for both refuels. Transport of fuel will be the responsibility of the Competitor and fuel containers will need to be taken back to the Service Park at the completion of the rally. Please ensure that your containers are clearly marked.
- D. Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming into contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied.
- E. No service vehicle may drive on a competitive stage during the running of the Event without the express permission of the Clerk of the Course. If vehicle recovery is required, service crews are to contact the Competitor Relations Officer or Rally HQ for instruction.
- F. In order to be covered by the Motorsport Australia Personal Accident Insurance, service crew members must be registered with the Organisers by the close of Documentation Verification.
- G. The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" area.

6. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance will be available as per the event schedule.

Competitors are reminded that speed is restricted to 60kmh during reconnaissance. Penalties will apply for any breaches which may incur a time penalty to be applied to the competition.

7. ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TCO.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

8. PROTEST

Any protests lodged must be in accordance with the NCR.

9. ROOKIES

All Rookies should advise the Event Secretary that they are eligible for the Rookie Award by emailing grimwade@lightcarclub.com.au prior to the start of the event.

10. INTEGRITY

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
