1. ORGANISATION

The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, The National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Vehicles General, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Special Stage Rallies, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Events General, The Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR), these Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

This event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

2. ENTRIES

Entries may only be made by using the Motorsport Australia online entry system at: https://evententry.motorsport.org.au/v2/events/5173

Crew members must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Rally (Drivers/CoDrivers), or a Rally Navigator (CoDrivers) competition licence.

The maximum number of entries will be 70, with entries accepted in order of receipt. Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full BEFORE the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee may apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

- 3.3 The **Official Notice Board** will be located online at <u>www.rallywa.com</u> via the SPORTITY application (Password: WACC) and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (see Event Program)

3.4 Rejoining

For all crews which re-join a time penalty will be applied:

- For every special stage missed, a 10 minute time penalty will be added to the fastest stage time for each special stage missed, which will include the special stage on which the crew has retired;
- (ii) For every super special stage missed, a 3 minute time penalty will be added to the fastest stage time for each super special missed, which will include super special stage on which the crew has retired;

3.5 Documentation and Scrutiny

Pre-event Documentation is to be emailed to <u>rally@wacarclub.com.au</u> prior to Metro Scrutiny & Documentation (see Event Program).

Scrutiny will be undertaken as per MWARCS SSR F7 Event Scrutiny (Selected).

Competitors not required for scrutiny will be able to collect their stickers and road books etc at Scrutiny & Documentation as per the Event Program

Location and time of scrutiny and documentation are shown in the Event Program and a Bulletin showing the location and times for each car will be issued.

3.6 Apparel

All competitors in the Event must comply with the apparel requirements as per the "State" level Gravel / Tarmac Rally in *Schedule D – Apparel* of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

4. RALLYSAFE

- 4.1 Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed and location.
- 4.2 All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny and it must be powered from a permanent power source. Fitting kits are available directly from RallySafe https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied.

4.3 The RallySafe unit in each car must be fitted and "Powered on" PRIOR to the commencement of the Drivers Briefing

4.4 RallySafe "Tech Zone"

As per the Itinerary all cars must present to the Rally Safe Tech Zone so that the RallySafe unit location, cables, connections, aerial position, power and connectivity can be inspected and checked.

5. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the Event. Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish.

6. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- 6.1 The Service Park for the event will be located as per the attached map at Winvale Park Complex. See Service Park Map for approved areas. Service Vehicles may be parked in the Service Park overnight. The Organisers take no responsibility for the vehicles.
- 6.2 Note that Service Park is open ONLY for setup on Friday. No Servicing of cars is to take place on location.
- 6.3 There is a minimum service area, only 1 service vehicle per competing car will be permitted in the Service Park. Any vehicle not required for servicing and all trailers are to be parked alongside the Service Park as shown on the Service Park map.

- 6.4 There will be be only one opportunity to refuel the car. The Refuel will be located within the Service Park. Whilst refuelling service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- 6.5 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/refuelling operation.
- 6.6 Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming into contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied.

The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" area.

7. RECONNAISSANCE

- 7.1 Reconnaissance time is per the schedule in the Event Program.
- 7.2 Crews may complete two (2) passed only of each stage
- 7.3 Competitors are reminded that the rally is held on private property. Please always respect the land and property during reconnaissance. Please stick to designated roads per road book during reconnaissance.
- 7.4 Note that Control Boards, Instruction Numbers, Caution Boards, Delineators, and other course markings may not be in position during Reconnaissance.
- 7.5 Complaints received regarding behaviour during reconnaissance will be treated with the utmost severity. Please ensure to respect the local land owner, property and paddocks.

8. ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison out from TC0.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

9. PROTEST

Protest must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

10. INTEGRITY

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

Camping

Camping is not permitted within the Winvale Park Complex

Fires

No fires are permitted at any location during the event.

Smoking

Winvale Park Complex is a private property in a high-risk fire area, therefore utmost caution must be used at all times when extinguishing cigarettes and matches. It is preferred that you do not smoke at the venue.

Duty of Care

We all have a duty of care to each other, if you see something that is not safe or believe could be an issue, please advise the event organisers immediately.

Alcohol

The service park is a community area (public place) normal local and state laws apply regarding the consumption of alcohol.
