

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee may apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

A ceremonial start will be conducted through Brockman St Mall, cars are to be arranged from 11am onwards in starting order. The street will be closed from 1100 until 1300.

### 2.3 Documentation and Scrutiny

Pre-event Documentation is to be emailed to [karri@wacarclub.com.au](mailto:karri@wacarclub.com.au) prior to Metro Scrutineering & Documentation

Event Scrutineering will be conducted in accordance with *Article F5 Event Scrutiny (Targeted)* of the MWARCS SSR. A list of vehicles selected for Scrutineering will be provided following close of entries. Vehicles selected must attend Scrutineering as per the Event Program. Competitors are required to complete a *Self Scrutiny Checklist – Rally/Road* and *Targeted Scrutineering Program Statement of Vehicle Compliance TSP03* and present them with their pre-event documentation. The Statement of Vehicle Compliance may also be accepted via the Event Entry System.

Competitors not required for Scrutineering will be able to collect their stickers and road books etc at Scrutineering & Documentation as per the Event Program

Location and time of Scrutineering and documentation are shown in the Event Program.

### **3. RALLYSAFE**

Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed and location.

All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to Scrutineering and it must be powered from a permanent power source. Fitting kits are available directly from RallySafe <https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/>

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied.

### **4. AWARDS**

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the event. Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. This will be held at Tall Timbers Brewing Co. (Giblett St, Manjimup).

WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish and will be held at Tall Timbers Brewing Co. (Giblett St, Manjimup).

### **5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING**

The Service Park for the Event will be located as per the attached map, Rose St (between Mount St and Brockman St). **Please do not park in Chicken Treat car park. See service park map for approved service areas and designated trailer parking**

There is a minimum service area, only 1 service vehicle per competing car will be permitted in the service park.

There will be refuel available adjacent to the reject shop. The service crew are to comply with apparel requirements and to follow the directions of rally officials

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation.

### **6. RECONNAISSANCE**

Reconnaissance times are shown in the Event Program.

### **7. ODOMETER CHECK**

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TCO.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

### **8. PROTEST**

Protest must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

### **9. INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au)

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
