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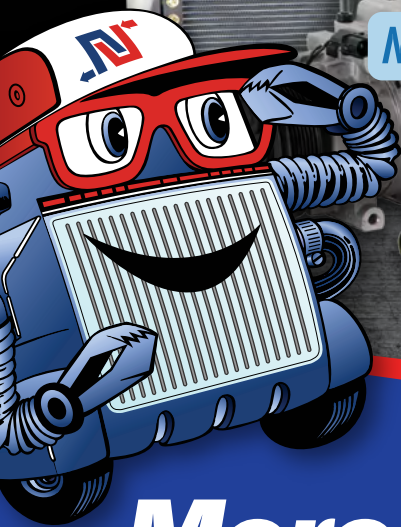

The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, The National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorsport Australia Rally Standing Regulations – Vehicles General, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Special Stage Rallies, Motorsport Australia National Rally Standing Regulations – Events General, The Motorsport Australia Western Australian Rally Championships and Series Season Standing Regulations (MAWARCS SSR), these Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

This event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

The maximum number of entries will be 100, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR, the entry fee must be received in full before the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event before the close of entries. A \$150 administration plus the Rallysafe fee may apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries.

### 3.1 RE-JOINING

For all crews which re-join a time penalty will be applied:

- (i) For every special stage missed, a 10 minute time penalty will be added to the fastest stage time for each special stage missed, which will include the special stage on which the crew has retired;
- (ii) For every super special stage missed, a 3 minute time penalty will be added to the fastest stage time for each super special missed, which will include the super special stage on which the crew has retired;

### 3.2 DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

Pre-event Documentation is to be emailed to [rally@wacarclub.com.au](mailto:rally@wacarclub.com.au) prior to Metro Scrutiny & Documentation (see Event Program).

Scrutiny will be undertaken as per MWARCS SSR F5 Event Scrutiny (Selected).

Competitors not required for scrutiny will be able to collect their stickers and road books etc at Scrutiny & Documentation as per the Event Program

Location and time of scrutiny and documentation are shown in the Event Program and a Communique showing the location and times for each car selected for scrutiny will be issued.

### 3.3 APPAREL

All competitors in the Event must comply with the apparel requirements as per the “State” level Gravel / Tarmac Rally in *Schedule D – Apparel* of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

### 3.4 NEUTRAL ZONE (NZ)

Competitors are reminded of Article 5.6(b)(iii) Neutral Zone (NZ) of the Rally Standing Regs – Special Stage Rallies. The MAXIMUM Speed for the Neutral Zone is 40kmh. The MINIMUM speed is 10kmh. Competitors are not to stop within the NZ.

Competitors exceeding the maximum speed or going below the minimum speed will be referred to the Stewards for allocation of an appropriate penalty.

The actual time within the NZ will be subtracted from the elapsed time of the special stage.

## 4. ALL COMPETITORS IN THE EVENT MUST COMPLY WITH THE APPAREL REQUIREMENTS AS PER THE “STATE” LEVEL GRAVEL / TARMAC RALLY IN SCRALLYSAFE

- 4.1 Rallysafe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rallysafe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed and location.
- 4.2 All competitors are to have a full Rallysafe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny and it must be powered from a permanent power source. Fitting kits are available directly from RallySafe <https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/>  
If a “Push to Pass” is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied.
- 4.3 The RallySafe unit in each car must be fitted and “Powered on” PRIOR to the commencement of the Drivers Briefing
- 4.4 RallySafe “Tech Zone”  
All cars must be present in the Rally Safe Tech Zone (immediately prior to TC0) no later than 10 minutes prior to their due time at TC0 so that the RallySafe unit location, cables, connections, aerial position, power and connectivity can be inspected and checked.

## 5. AWARDS

A provisional awards presentation will be held as per the Event Program immediately after the event.

### 5.1 EXPERTS CUP

In addition to normal awards a trophy, the Experts Cup, will be awarded to crews with a stage time, excluding road penalties, that is one of the SIX fastest on every special stage

## 6. SERVICING & REFUELLING

The service park for the event will be located at Lot 2864 Forest Street, Collie. See service park map for approved areas. Please note that traffic flow within the service park is ONE WAY (clockwise direction only),

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/refuelling operation.

Crews are allowed to deviate from the Road Book for the sole purpose of refuelling from Service Station Pumps.

## 7. RECONNAISSANCE

- 7.1 Reconnaissance time is flexible as per the schedule in the Event Program.
- 7.2 Crews may complete two passes (only) of each stage.
- 7.3 An electronic copy of the Road Book (PDF) and Stage Maps (Google Maps link) will be provided to competitors who have completed their entry form online (including accepting the Motorsport Australia Disclaimers), whose entry has been accepted and who have paid their entry fee.
- 7.4 Crews must inform WA Car Club by either email [rally@wacarclub.com.au](mailto:rally@wacarclub.com.au) or SMS 0419 894 555 when they are completing their recce. Email / SMS is to include Competition Number and Reconnaissance vehicle Make, Model, Colour and Registration Number.
- 7.5 Competitors are reminded that all roads are open to the public and to expect oncoming traffic. Road rules must be adhered to at all times.
- 7.6 Note that Control Boards, Instruction Numbers, Caution Boards, Delineators and other course markings may not be in position during Flexi Reconnaissance
- 7.7 Complaints received regarding behavior during recce will be treated with the utmost severity. Times for reconnaissance are shown in the Event Program.

## 8. ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TC0.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

## 9. PROTEST

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

## 10. POST EVENT FUNCTION & PRESENTATION

There will be a FREE post Event function and awards presentation for Clubman Masters, Clubman and WARC competitors at the Club Hotel, 138 Forrest Street, Collie.

## 11. INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au)
