



Clarification Tyrecard (BRC regulations art 19.4)

Completion of the tyre card is compulsory for all cars in classes RC1/RC2/RC3/RC4/RC5 and RGT. The tyre card is handed out at the technical scrutineering and looks like this:

TYRECARD MUST ALWAYS BE IN THE CAR - CREW ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FILLING THE TYRECARD - USE PERMANENT MARKER

1: Fill in the barcodes of all tyres used, both on the car and the spares in the boot. Both slicks and rain tyres may be entered here. The maximum number of tyres that may be used is indicated on the tyre card and depends on the number of race days and the class in which you are racing. In this case, 8 tyres may be used in RC4/RC5 and 12 tyres in RC1/RC2/RC3/RGT. Tyres used on the shakedown should not be entered.

2: New for 2023 is that on top of the allowed number of tyres, for all classes, an additional 5 rain tyres may also be used. Boxes R1 to R5 may therefore only be filled in with rain tyre barcodes.

If rain tyres are used, it is strongly recommended to fill in the first 5 rain tyres on lines R1 to R5. If further rain tyres are required, they may be entered on lines 1 to 8 (or 1 to 12).




3: The tyres used must be ticked each time before leaving the service park, at the corresponding time control.

4: At the bottom, in the yellow boxes, the total number of tyres taken per section must be noted.

Repetition of some rules:

- RC1/RC2/RC3 class cars must compulsorily use the tyres of the official tyre supplier designated for the BRC.
- All tyres on the tyre card must be on the FIA list of approved tyres and have an FIA bar code (see example below).
- The tyre card must be completed in indelible ink. Pencil or anything erasable is prohibited.
- It is forbidden to delete data or to use Tippex (or similar) to erase data from the card. In case something was wrongly noted on the card, the Chief Scrutineer of the race must be notified immediately before leaving the service park, before anything may be adjusted on the tyre card.
- The tyre card must be always on board the car and can be checked at any time after leaving the service area.
- The participant is responsible for the correct completion of the tyre card.
