1 | What Awaits You This Weekend

The Cisalpina Classic Race is a "Superclassica" event on the Aci Sport calendar for historic and youngtimer cars produced up to 1990. It is also valid for the Italian Grandi Eventi Championship for modern Supercars and Gran Turismo. The Grand Hotel Royal and Golf in Courmayeur (AO) is the event's headquarters. The detailed program as follows:

20:00 | Welcome dinner on the terrace of the Grand Royal restaurant

- 09:15 | Start of the 2nd stage from La Salle
- 12:00 | Gran San Bernardo Lunch at Ristorante Italia
- 16:15 | Arrival of the 2nd stage in La Salle
- 19:30 | Aperitif at Royal Champagnerie area
- 20:30 | Awards Gala Dinner at the Grand Royal restaurant

Sunday, September 1st

- 09:00 | Breakfast at the hotel and greetings
- 10:00 | Spa available to all guests until 20:00

2 | How to Reach the Royal and Golf Grand Hotel in Courmayeur

After taking the Courmayeur exit on the A5/E25, proceed to the second roundabout, turn right, and from Piazzale Monte Bianco take Via Circonvallazione on the right. After about 350 mt, at the roundabout, turn left in the pedestrian area (Via Roma) that you have to cross very slowly. After about 130 mt you will have the Royal and Golf on your left.





3 | When You Should Arrive

We have prepared a program to make you comfortable even on the arrival day. We wait you on the afternoon of Thursday, August 29th, starting at 14:30. From this time, we recommend arriving at the hotel as soon as possible. Once the formalities are completed you can relax in your room, by the pool, or take advantage of the Royal and Golf SPA.

4 | Where to Park Cars – Trailers – Training Area

The parking for trailers and the vehicles used to tow them is located at the Royal Driving Experience – SS 26 della Valle d'Aosta nº 35 – Courmayeur (coord. 45.812772, 6.959620).

Since this is a private area, please let us know if you need to leave your trailer and your estimated arrival time. A portion of the same area is available for the guests for training with their own equipment.

IT IS ABSOLUTELY FORBIDDEN TO ARRIVE AT THE HOTEL WITH THE TRAILER; there is no space or way to unload the race car.


Upon arrival at the Royal & Golf (entrance on Via Roma), park your car temporarily in front of the main entrance, leave your luggage at reception and move your car following the staff's instructions.

- If you arrive with a car NOT registered for the race, your parking area is marked on red.

- If you arrive with a classic or GT car registered for the race, your parking area is marked on green.







After parking your race car, head to the Lounge area in the hotel for sporting scrutineering, where you receive the necessary materials for technical scrutineering, which will take place near your racing car.

Once the administrative formalities are completed... **let the experience begin**! We look forward to seeing you at 20:00 for the welcome dinner on the terrace of the Grand Royal Restaurant.





5 | Dress code

The Cisalpina Classic Race is both a sporting event and a showcase of charm and elegance. Along with your favourite clothing, we suggest an elegant outfit for the Awards Gala Dinner on Saturday, August 31st and an heavy garment for the evenings since the temperature can drop quickly in the mountains.

6 | Always Wear the Bracelet

Upon arrival, you will receive a bracelet: this will serve as your pass, so remember to wear it at all times. This will help the staff and the personnel at the restaurants and hotel to recognize you and provide the best possible service.

7 | What to Do in Case of Car Breakdown

GT: Classification Etroubles PC (from PC 60 to PC 63) – Tot 4 PC

TROFEO SICAV *

CLASSIC: Classification Colle S.Carlo PC (from PC 1 to PC 7) - Tot 7 pc (without Coeff)

GT: Classification Colle S.Carlo PC (from PC 1 to PC 7) – Tot 7 pc
