

# ADA RIVER RALLY 2023- SPECTATOR GUIDE

## SPECTATING MUST DO'S

1. Be prepared, weatherwise. Bring a hat, ground cover, sun screen, and protection in case of rain or cold weather. If food and drink are not available at spectator points make sure that you bring your own.
2. Park your car sensibly so that it will not obstruct emergency vehicles, competitors, service crews or other spectators. Obey parking instructions given by signs or officials. It is advisable to park your car facing the way out. This will make your exit easier.
3. Do not try to emulate rally drivers. If you give cause for complaint it will reflect badly on the rally and the sport as a whole. Drive carefully to and from spectator points and be ready to give way to other traffic on narrow stretches of road.
4. If you have to take dogs or young children to spectator points, make sure they are completely under your control and that they do not get in the way of rally cars or mechanics or officials at work.
5. Do not light fires or smoke in the forests. Do not smoke near a car that is being serviced or refuelled.
6. Keep clear of rally control points at all times from the timing marker to the control. If control officials ask you to move, please help them maintain event safety by doing so. Remember that they have a difficult job to do as it is. If you want to see a control point in action, then stand well back.
7. Rally cars can lose control and leave the road at any time. Make sure that you stand behind the orange webbing within the areas designated for viewing by this spectator guide or officials or marshals. Do not stand in No Go areas or outside the designated viewing areas.
8. The instructions of spectator marshals must be obeyed. They have the power to stop a stage until the spectator point is controlled to their satisfaction.
9. Do not ignore this spectator guide and try and find your own way around. The spectator route in this Guide has been surveyed and is safe.
10. Take your litter home. It is handy to have bag or carton with you. Please leave our countryside tidy.
11. At service or refuel points do not crowd mechanics when they are working. Besides hindering them, you may get injured.

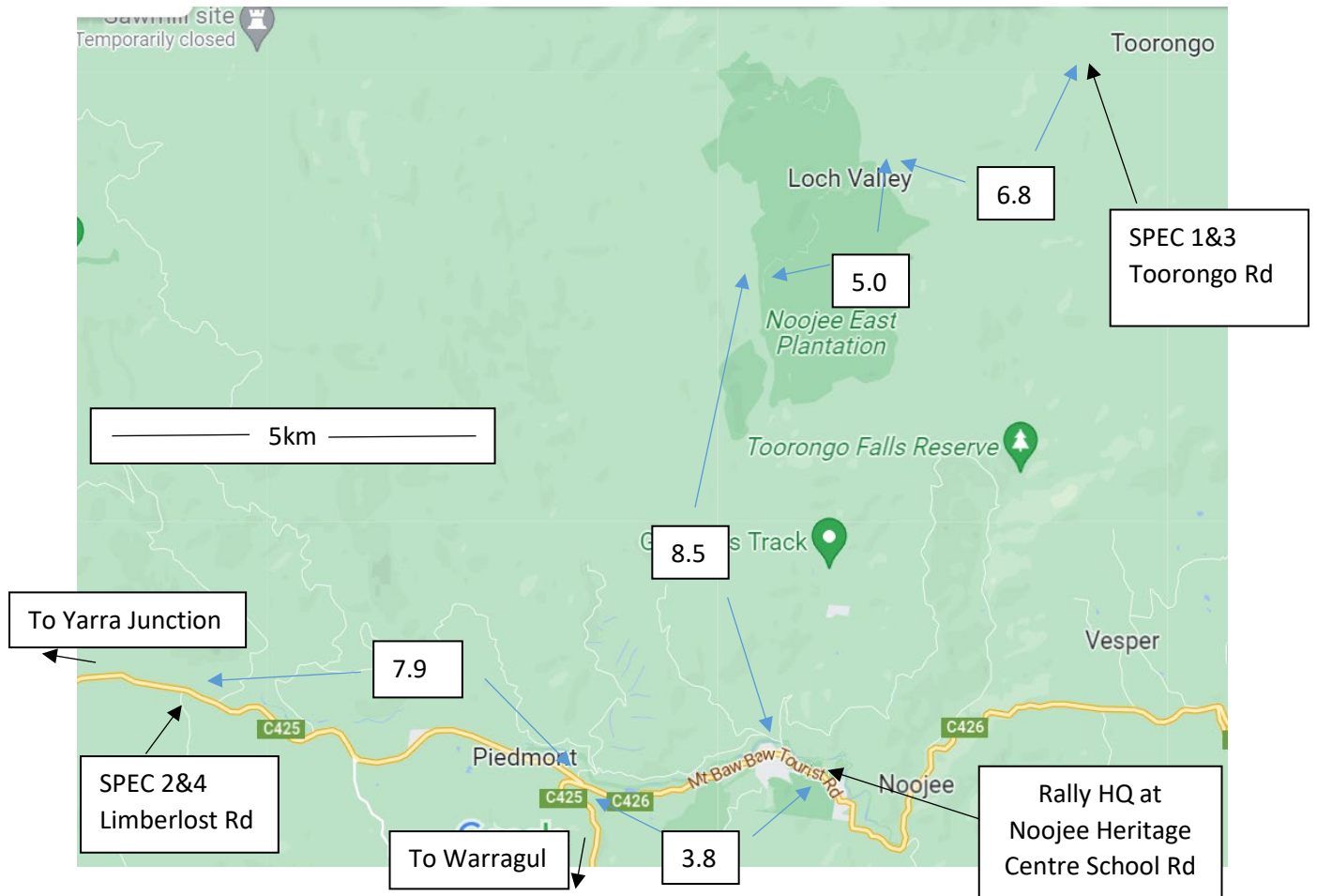

# SPECTATOR POINT 1&3

## Toorongo Road (SS2/6 Mundic)

Point 1 & 3 is a scenic drive up the Loch Valley. Care should be taken on the road as you will experience oncoming rally traffic so keep left. Please turn around and park on the south of the road as indicated by the signs. At the viewing location you will see cars approach a sweeping right before a turn left, viewing is good thanks to recent logging.

Directions to Spec 1/3 from Noojee Service Park	
Odometer total	Instruction
0.0	Head west on Baw Baw tourist rd (head through Noojee township)
0.6	Follow sign 'Loch Valley' SO over bridge
9.1	End bitumen and turn right on Toorongo Rd 50km speed limit two way traffic
12.6	Turn Right at camp ground
19.4	Turn around and park on the Left as per signs

## SPECTATOR POINT 2&4

### Limberlost Road (SS3/7 Limberlost)

Point 2 & 4 is just off the Noojee Yarra Junction road at the Limberlost car park. It is only 300m into the stage and you will see the vehicles turn right and head along a straight road for a few hundred meters. Ample parking can be found at the Limberlost motorcycle car park.

Directions to spec 2&4 from Noojee Service Park	
Odometer total	Instruction
0.0	Head west on Baw Baw tourist rd (head through Noojee township)
0.3	Veer Left at Noojee township, head towards Powelltown
3.8	Turn Right towards Powelltown
11.7	Turn Left of highway and park in carpark on right
11.8	Walk 150m to spectator viewing
You can return to Noojee the way you came
