

MEMO FROM THE CLERK OF COURSE #1 12th April 2023

1. Competitors should note that the Further Regulations contain a **REVISED** Event Schedule. Due to the large field it has been necessary to adjust several key times.

Of particular importance are the following adjustments; Drivers Briefing time of 0800hrs- compulsory for all crews to attend. First car starts at 0830hrs HQ opening hours have also been extended on Friday 14th April and Saturday 15th April

2. A reminder to all crews that the deadline for provision of documentation to the Event Secretary was Friday 7th April.

There are MANY crews that have not completed this task. With a field of 80 cars, the Event Secretary has to sight and verify over **800 separate items of documentation**.

I ask that you please consider the workload of our volunteers and provide the information promptly if you haven't already, or are asked to do so by our Secretary.

A big thank-you to those that have completed this task already.

- 3. Another reminder that **fires are NOT allowed** at the service park at any time.
- 4. When arriving at the Service Park, please enter via **Gate 2**, which is directly off Mt Baw Baw Tourist Rd. This will be signposted clearly. The main entrance to Rally HQ (Gate 1) is for competing vehicles only.
- 5. Series Sponsor windscreen banners and stickers will be available from Rally HQ during the opening times noted in the Revised Schedule.

These must be positioned on your vehicle as per the relevant series regulations. This information will be in your Competitor Packs. This will be checked and must be correct before you are allowed to start the Event.

6. A reminder that this Event is a 'Blind' rally and no form of Pace Notes are permitted to be used. Spot checks may be carried out at any time, and any competitors found to be in the possession of any form of Pace Notes will be referred to the Stewards.
