Place and date

The Eiscup will be held in Innsbruck/Tyrol at **Tiroler Wasserkraft Arena** (Olympiaworld Innsbruck), Olympiastraße 10, 6020 Innsbruck, **from November 13 to 16, 2025**.

The Ice Rink (30x60m) is indoor and heated.

General Regulations

The 29th Eiscup Innsbruck will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications for the categories Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice. Pre-Novice (Cubs) and Juvenile (Chicks) will be held in accordance with Skate Austria national rules 2024 (ÖWO) and regulations for competitions 2025/2026.

Categories

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS	<p>In accordance with ISU Communication 2699</p> <p>An Intermediate Novice skater is a skater who has not reached the age of sixteen (16) before July 1st preceding the competition.</p> <p>Duration of the program: 3:00, +/-10 sec.</p>
BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS	<p>In accordance with ISU Communication 2699</p> <p>A Basic Novice skater is a skater who has not reached the age of fourteen (14) before July 1st preceding the competition.</p> <p>Duration of the program: 2:30, +/-10 sec.</p>
PRE-NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS (Cubs)	<p>In accordance with Skate Austria regulation for competitions 2025/206</p> <p>A Pre- Novice skater is a skater who has not reached the age of ten (10) before July 1st preceding the competition.</p> <p>Duration of the program: 2:00, +/-10 sec.</p>
JUVENILE GIRLS & BOYS (Chicks)	<p>In accordance with Skate Austria Regulations 2025/2026</p> <p>A Juvenile skater is a skater who has not reached the age of ten (10) before July 1st preceding the competition.</p> <p>Duration of the Programs: 2:00, +/-10 sec.</p>

RULES for Juvenile (Chicks) & Pre-Novice girls & boys

A well balanced Free Skating program for Pre-Novice (Cubs) & Juvenile (Chicks) girls & boys must contain:

- Maximum of four (4) jump elements for girls and boys. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps.
 - Juvenile (Chicks): Double and triple jumps are not permitted. Only one (1) single jump may be executed twice.
 - Pre-Novice (Cubs): Triple jumps are not permitted. Only one (1) single or double jump (incl. Double Axel) may be executed twice.
- There must be a maximum of two (2) spins (different abbreviations):
 - one spin in one position without change of foot in a basic position with a minimum of four (4) revolutions, no level features are allowed, and will be called max. level basic. Flying entry is not allowed. 8 revolutions can be done but will not count as an attempted feature.
 - one spin free of choice with a different abbreviation to the spin in one position (for example: USp and SSp are different abbreviations), minimum of four (4) revolutions, max. level 1, flying entry/entrance is not allowed.

- There must be a maximum one (1) step sequence. The step sequence must fully cover the ice surface and include at least one (1) skating movement (such as a spiral, spread eagle, Ina Bauer, hydroblading etc.) to be counted. If the skating movement is missing, the sequence will receive no value.
 - Juvenile: Maximum level basic
 - Pre-Novice: Maximum level 1: a minimum of one (1) clean difficult step or turn must be included (rocker/counter/bracket/twizzle/loop/choctaw)

The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is 1.67

Deductions

a) Interruption

For every Interruption of:

- more than 10 seconds up to 20 seconds: -0.5
- more than 20 seconds up to 30 seconds: -1.0
- more than 30 seconds up to 40 seconds: -1.5

Interruption of the program with allowance of up to three (3) minutes to resume from the point of interruption: -2.5 per program

b) Program time violation up to every 5 seconds lacking or in excess -0.5

c) Part of the costume/decoration falls on the ice -0.5

d) Costume/prop violation -0.5

e) Late start -0.5

f) Falls

- per fall outside elements (one Skater only – Single and Pair Skating) -0.5
 - per fall outside elements (both Skaters – Pair Skating) -1.0
 - falls in elements will be called by the Technical Panel but with no deduction(s).
- * A Fall is defined as loss of control by a Skater with the result that the majority of his/her own body weight is on the ice supported by any other part of the body other than the blades e.g. hand(s), knee(s), buttock(s), or any part of the arm (Rule 503, para 1).

g) Illegal elements -2.0

As all the values of the deductions above are not the standard ones provided by Rules 353, paragraph 1.n), the Referee must give specific instructions to the system operator and check the correct input in each instance.

Entries

- **Clubs from Austria** have to register skaters for Eiscup via **Skate Austria Portal** latest by **October 16, 2025**. If the category differs to your national category, please contact thomas.biegler@skateaustria.at
- **Clubs from other countries** must send the entry form for their skaters latest by **October 16, 2025** to: eiscup@eislaufen-innsbruck.at

Each Club may enter up to four (4) skaters per category. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of entries per club or / and enter more than four skaters. Entries of skaters may be made only by the club concerned on the designated official forms.

Entry lists, competition schedules, competition results will be published at the Sportity-app. The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries due to limited ice availability. If the limit is reached we will close the entry list and offer further skaters to be put on the waiting list.

Entries will be on first come first serve principle. Those skaters who have not paid their entry fees till the entry fee deadline will be replaced by skaters next on the waiting list.

Entries will only be confirmed if the entry fee is paid via bank transfer by October 16, 2025. Reimbursement of entry fees can only be offered for cancellations done latest by October 16, 2025. In very special cases we may offer reimbursement also later (medical attests need to be sent along with withdrawals).

Attention: Please send all entry fees as one payment for the whole club.

Music

The music playback will be exclusively digital (via computer)!

- Skaters/clubs from Austria should upload their music for **Eiscup** via Skate Austria Portal.
- Skaters/clubs from all other countries should send their music by E-Mail or via a file transfer service to:

The uploaded/sent music files must show competitor's name, nationality, category, program (short/free skating). Mandatory music format is .mp3.

We highly recommend to send the music files very soon after confirmation of participation. This will give us time to check compatibility of the music and to contact participating clubs, if problems should arise.

Live Stream

A Livestream on Solidsport will be provided. By entering the competition, each person agrees on recordings and/or transmissions (e.g. via the internet, TV) of his/her/their performance, appearance, picture, voice, or other personal characteristics displayed in connection with the event, towards an unrestricted audience and without temporal or geographical limits.

Draws for the starting order will be done electronically. The organizing committee will publish them via the Sportify-App latest 24 hours before the respective starting time.

Award ceremony & Prizes

Interclub victory ceremonies (Juvenile, Pre-Novice, Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice) will be held off ice 15 minutes after the free programs of each category ends for all participants.

The trophy „**Internationaler Pokal der Stadt Innsbruck**“ („International Cup of Innsbruck“) will be awarded to the skaters with the **highest total score**.
