Introduction

Welcome to the TradeCarMats 061 Targa Road Rally.

The Event will run on a Motorsport UK Clubman Permit and also an Interclub Permit and will be based at Weeton Army Barracks, near Preston. The Event will run 8 daylight tests with a total mileage of around 42 test miles. The special tests will run on a mixture of surfaces from tarmac, broken concrete and gravel tracks. A sump guard is recommended for the more competitive driver!

The route will be by a road book containing special test diagrams and details.

1. Announcement

Stockport 061 Motor Club Limited will organise a Motorsport UK ('ASN') Clubman & Interclub Permit Status Targa Road Rally on the 20th June 2026.

2. Jurisdiction

The Event will be held under the ASN 2026 National Competition Rules, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), the Official Documents of the Event including these Supplementary Regulations.

3. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Interclub Permit No:	207514
Motorsport UK Clubman Permit No:	207515

4. Eligibility

The 061 Targa Rally (Interclub) is open to all fully elected members of the Organising Club and members of ANWCC, ANCC, EMAMC & WAMC Clubs.

The 061 Targa Rally (Clubman) is open to fully elected members of Stockport 061 Motor Club and Kirkby Lonsdale Motor Club (Non-members can pay to join for the next 12 months at £12.00).

All Competitors **MUST produce a valid club membership card** to sign-on.

The 061 Targa Rally (Interclub) requires a valid ASN Competition Licence of Interclub status or higher for both crew members to be presented to sign-on.

The 061 Targa Rally (Clubman) requires a valid ASN Competition Licence of RS Clubman status or higher for both crew members to be presented to sign-on.

Both Events will follow the same route and be subject to the same Penalties. Drivers must hold a full valid Road Traffic Act ('RTA') driving licence for a Car.

Navigators must have attained the age of 12 years.

5. Programme

The Event will start and finish at Weeton Army Barracks, Singleton Road, Preston, PR4 3JQ. Map 102 Grid ref 387 364.

The total mileage will be approximately 42 miles of special tests at Weeton Army Barracks.

A colour printed test diagram book will be provided for the special tests.

6. Format

Cars will start at one minute intervals and will run under Scheduled Time. Tests may start at 30 second intervals.

Marshals' clocks will be set to BBC time. All crews are advised to carry their own accurate time piece.

Included in your Entry Fee will be tea/dinner for both crew members. Food and drink will be available to be purchased from the catering van throughout the day.

Any Competitor not signed on by 08:00, 20th June 2026 may be deemed a non-starter.

7. Identification

Two rally plates and high-viz numbers will be supplied by the organisers to identify competitors. The plates must be fixed to the front and rear of the car, and the high-viz numbers to the rear windows in accordance with Ch.13 App.9 Art.5.3.

These must be removed if the competitor retires, is disqualified, or on completion of the event.

8. Classes

The event will consist of three classes as follows:

Interclub EXPERT Any crew member having finished in the Top 10 of any Targa Rally or a restricted (Interclub) or higher status rally. Cars must meet the requirements of Ch.13 App.11 Part.C.

Interclub NOVICE All other crews. Cars must meet the requirements of Ch.13 App.11 Part.C.

CLUBMAN All crews on the Clubman Event.

9. Awards

Awards will be presented as follows – no crew may win more than one Award:

10. Entries

Entries for the Event open on 1 May at 20.00 and close finally on 16th June 2026. The Entry Fee is £185.00 (this includes full colour test diagram book and a meal for both Competitors).

If your payment bounces, your Entry will be rejected, you will be informed by telephone and you will lose your place in the queue. Any new payment must then include a bank handling charge of £15.

Registered and recorded delivery post will only be collected once a week from the sorting office.

Competitors will be seeded using the information provided on the Entry form. Remember – no information = lower seeding. The Organisers will not enter into negotiation regarding seeding or Entry. Therefore, please fill in the Entry form correctly. Data supplied will be verified.

The maximum entry for the event is 60 plus 10 reserves. The minimum is 30. The maximum for each class is 50, the minimum is 5. Should the minimum not be reached the organisers retain the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.

Entries will be accepted for those registered with a championship in SR4 (with payment received) until 23.59 on 3rd May 2026, following this they will then be accepted on a first come first served basis.

Entry fees will be refunded as below:-

Up to and including the 12th June 2026 - Full refund less £30.00 to cover administration costs (except for dishonoured cheques) provided written or email confirmation of such is received by the Event Secretary before the closing date, subject to organiser discretion.

After the 12th June – at the discretion of the organising committee, subject to final budget status.

Competitors who fail scrutineering will forfeit the whole entry fee.

Competitors who fail to start for whatever reason and who do not inform the organisers will forfeit the whole entry fee.

If the event is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of the entry fee to cover any costs incurred.

Competitors are advised that information they provide may be stored on a computer retrieval system and may be used for organisational and publicity purposes.

11. Route Information

The route will be clearly defined by photocopied maps and/or by written instructions with marked maps and/or any other information allowing Competitors to comply with Ch.13 App.5 Art.2.

The route information will be given out at documentation.

Competitors will only be allowed to make up time at specific times as directed by the organisers.

All the organisers times and distances will be deemed to be correct.

Competitors will start at one-minute intervals, unless otherwise instructed by an Official.

Any competitor deemed by a Judge of Fact to be making excessive noise will be disqualified from the event.

All tests must be visited in numerical order as shown on the event timecards.
Lateness: Competitors will be instructed to reduce lateness en-route. Ch.13 App.5 Art.5.15.

Baulking - Competitors are to note Ch.13 App.2 Art.2.26.

Maximum permitted lateness is 15 minutes and 59 seconds at any Main Time Control.

13. Penalties

Marking, Penalties, Timing and other regulations will be as 2026 NCR Ch.13 App.7, except for the following, which are modified/additional: -

Penalties on Special Tests:

Taking the Bogey Time or less than the Bogey Time	Bogey Time
Taking longer than the Bogey Time but less than the Maximum Time	Actual Time Taken
Taking longer than the Maximum (target) Time	Test Maximum
Not attempting a test when instructed	Test Maximum
Failing to comply with test route (wrong test) / test instructions	Test Maximum
Striking a cone or marker	+10 seconds per cone/marker
Failing to stop astride a finish / stop line	+30 seconds per offence
Starting but not completing a test	Test Maximum
Travelling a test in the wrong direction	Disqualification
Contact with another competitor	Disqualification
Not providing proof of visiting a Passage Control	Test Maximum
Not recording the correct code from a code board (if used)	+20 seconds per offence
Jump Start	+10 seconds per offence

Small corrections, e.g. three point turns at tight corners are allowed. However, if you make a mistake during a test, e.g. go the wrong side of a cone or go the wrong way by more than a notional car's length, DO NOT attempt to retrace your route, you will already have been penalised with the maximum penalty. Continue through the test and complete it. CARE!! It may be dangerous to reverse on a test.

14. Results

Ties will be judged in the favour of furthest cleanest. (Fastest crew from test 1 onwards). If still unresolved engine capacity will be the decider.

Results (Interim/Provisional/Final) will be available online via rallies.info in accordance with section Ch.3 App.6.

Any Protest must be lodged in accordance with Ch.2 App.9.

Any Appeal must be lodged in accordance with Ch.2 App.4.

15. Damage Declaration

DAMAGE DECLARATION: -

Competitors who retire will be required to submit their Damage Declaration to the Event Secretary within 72 hours of the Event. Failure to return this form may be penalised by a fine of £100.00. Ch.13 App.5 Art.57 - 58 applies.

Competitors will be required to complete and sign a report declaring that they have not been involved in any incident resulting in damage to private property or injury to persons or animals, or alternatively giving details of any such incident where damage or injury has occurred within 24 hours of the incident occurring.

Any information given will not incur a Penalty but failure to hand in a duly completed form will be penalised by DISQUALIFICATION and reported to the ASN.

DAMAGE TO THIRD PARTY PROPERTY: -

Competitors causing damage to any third party property will be liable for any excess Stockport 061 Motor Club Ltd has to pay to the ASN insurers and also any cost that is not covered by the Insurers. The excess is currently £500.

An Event Safety Officer has been appointed for this event, they will be checking all incidents that occur on the tests and will also be checking out vehicles leaving the tests for damage. Photo or video evidence may also be used to ensure that an incident report is completed by each Competitor for every incident that they have on a test that results in damage to any third party property.

16. Notes

- REMEMBER – this is a Road Rally, however as per Ch.13 App.11C Art.4.1 we will allow a maximum of 8 wheels / tyres, these may be marked by the Scrutineers. Furthermore, no ‘service crew’ will be permitted.
- The Digital Notice Board will be online via Sportity with the Event Password of 061RR.
There will be no physical official notice board.
Rally documents will also be available in the Sportity app (downloadable for iOS devices on Appstore and for Android devices on Google Play).
When any information is posted to Sportity by the organisers, all competitors will be deemed to have read it. You are therefore required to enable notifications.
- Final instructions, having the same authority as these SRs and forming part of the Official Documents of the Event, will be available for download on the [website](#) on Monday 15th June 2026.
- Any notice signed by the Clerk of the Course or Deputy Clerk of the Course displayed during the event will have the same authority as these SRs (Ch.3 App.10 Art.1.)
- Petrol is NOT available at the venue. Please ensure you have enough to last the day.
- No bonfires or barbecues or any form of fire may be lit at the venue. Please place litter in the bin bags provided and take it home.
- A maximum speed of 10mph will apply at all times within the confines of the venue, and on all private roads leading to the venue except for competing cars on a special test.
- No dogs will be allowed into the venue.
- Red reflective warning triangles, SOS/OK board, High visibility vest or jacket, and spill kit MUST be always carried (Ch.13 App.11C Art.2.1). A first aid kit is advised.
- Weeton Army Barracks is a non spectator venue **Only Competitors, Officials, and Pre Registered Marshals will be allowed entry to the venue.**
- Cars will need to produce at scrutineering a V5 Registration Document and a valid MOT Certificate. As the event is being run entirely on private land they do not need to be taxed unless being driven to the event.
