



ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation Office is located at the Main Rink (Wellblechpalast). The operating hours are as follows:

Accreditation cards to skaters will ONLY be issued if the entry fee is paid in full, a picture ID (passport or EU id-card) is presented, and the competition music files have been received by the Organizing Committee.

Accreditation cards are required to enter the Main Rink and or Practice Rink and must be shown to security guards to access the venue. The accreditation card shall be always worn visibly.

Loss of Accreditation Card

In case an accreditation card gets lost, you need to report to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible. The OC will evaluate the situation and decide in accordance with the security measures if the accreditation card is reissued. The OC will charge 50.00 Euro for reissuing an accreditation card.

CHAPERONE ACCESS PASSES

Officially registered Chaperones (one per competitor) may purchase an access pass for the entire competition week at a price of 20.00 Euro. Chaperone access passes are available at the Accreditation Office.
