

Driver's briefing

- 1. Some of the stages will be more complicated than usual, so we specifically ask you to review and process the itinerary and stage layouts in advance! There will be neither time nor space for this at the start. If you still need extra time before the start of the stage, please stand aside at the appropriate distance so that the rest of the field can pass. If the marshall has given the signal to start the stage, you must start from the yellow 1/100 board as soon as possible, but within 10 seconds at most, otherwise you will be penalized for starting late! Stopping after the yellow sign is prohibited until the end of the stage.
- 2. There are two types of secret stages on the route: the longer is approx. 40-50 m and has to be completed in 9 seconds; and the shorter one is approx. 20-30 m and prescribed time 6 seconds. They alternate in the order of long short long short If there is a double secret section, the pattern continues with its two parts. Example: if the first secret is a single and the second is a double, then the prescribed times will be 9 seconds and 6 + 9 seconds. A secret stage can occur independently, inside a marked 1/100 stage, or (except for the start) attached to any of its measurement points. In the case of a stand-alone secret stage, a green 1/100 indicator board warns of the timing, where you can stop for a maximum of 10 seconds or until the arrival of the next car. There is no green 1/100 warning sign if the secret stage is inside or at the finish of the normal 1/100 stage, and in such cases, of course, stopping is not allowed either.

3. Stamps: three types can occur:

Stamp indicated in the itinerary: it must be collected, regardless of whether it is on the right or left side of the road. Alternatively, it may also happen that the marked stamp can be reached by a short walk.

Secret stamp (not indicated in the itinerary): marked with a stamp symbol on a visible red-based sign on the route, always on the right side of the road. These must also be stamped in the right order into the itinerary.

False stamp: there may be a stamp that is visible from the route, but not in the route. You do NOT have to collect it, but if you do, you will get a penalty for collecting it.
