SERVICE PARK

The service park is located on Sėlių square, Zarasai Surface: asphalt Service park opens on 27th of January (Saturday) at 06:30, closes on 27th of January (Saturday) at 22:00

Service areas will be allocated by Organiser according to information uploaded in e-application. Each competing car will be provided with a complimentary area of 48 m2. If an applicant has multiple cars participating in the competition and requires additional shared service space, this information must be included in the participant's application by the deadlines specified in section 4.1. of suplementary regulations.

The cost of additional service space is 5 EUR per m2 . The fee must be paid together with the entry fee in accordance with sections 4.4.1 and 4.4.2 of suplementary regulations. Payment details are provided in section 4.5 of suplementary regulations. Failure to pay the fee for additional service park area will result in the are not being allocated

In Service Park, all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Teams must bring weights for fixing their tents. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage.

Only one service car without trailer per one competitor is allowed in Service Park. Cars must be clearly identified by a "Service" sticker. Service stickers must be affixed in a visible location on the front windshield of the passenger side in the upper corner. It is prohibited to remove the stickers until the end of the rally. Reconnaissance cars are not allowed into the service park. Participants who fail to comply with the service park rules may face penalties ranging from 100 EUR to exclusion from the competition. Please, leave Your trailers in areas specified by the Organiser—Statybininkų str.2 GPS: 55.7162, 26.2486

TYRES

Eligible Tyres

During the competition, the use of studded tyres is allowed. Studded tyres must comply with the requirements specified in Supplementary Regulations Appendix No. 6. Tyre dimensions and manufacturer are not restricted

Tyre Count

The maximum number of tyres that can be used for all rally participants is limited to 8 units.

Tyres Used For Reconnaissance

During the reconnaissance, participants are allowed to use only certified tires designed for driving on public roads during the winter season, meeting the requirements of the Republic of Lithuania's Road Traffic Rules (RTR) without sports studs. Only wide series production tyres that meet the RTR requirements can be used. The tires must bear markings that comply with EU standards (the "E" symbol with the country code of homologation, e.g., E2, E4, etc.). The use of restored tyres is prohibited. Any alterations (i.e., removal or damage) to the markings or texts on the tyre are prohibited.











FUEL

Fuel Restrictions

It is allowed to use commercial fuel that is sold in retail, E85 fuel (bioethanol).

Refuelling

All participants are allowed to refuel only in the Refuel Zones (RZ), which will be installed when leaving the service park. **Remote Refuelling Zones will not be available.**

Refueling Procedure

Only two crewmembers with permission can access RZ for refuelling procedure. Only crew members and support personnel are responsible for compliance with fire safety regulations during the refuelling. Liquid proof mat must be used. Refuelling procedure must be followed as it is indicated in. T-2024 article 61.2. Non-compliance with the rules is subject to a penalty of 50 EUR.

RECONNAISSANCE

Checking of Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Article 35.1 of T-2024. If, for any reason, a crew is forced to replace the reconnaissance car during the reconnaissance, the Clerk of the Course (phone: +370 6 14 8 1141) must be informed about the details of the new reconnaissance car

National Speed Limits

Town / Village 50 km/h
Non residence: Gravel roads - 70 km/h
Asphalt roads - 90 km/h

Motorways - 110 km/h Highways - 110 km/h

All reconnaissance of Special Stages has to be done at reasonable speed in accordance with Lithuanian traffic rules. The maximum speed set for reconnaissance at the Special Stages is 70km/h, unless lower speed limit is imposed by traffic signs (50km/h or 30km/h) marked in the Road Book or additional signs placed by the Organizer. Violating the rules and exceeding the speed limits on public roads will also be fixed and fined by the Lithuanian Police according to Lithuanian Traffic Act. Safety tracing system (STS), GPS tracker data will also be monitored during liaison.



Number of Passages

A maximum 2 passages over each Special Stages is permitted during reconnaissance. Special Stages run twice are considered to be one Special Stage.

Number of Persons on Board

During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons are permitted in the car

Rally Safety Tracking system

The organiser will provide a rally safety tracking system, which has to be used during reconnaissance in the reconnaissance car. If the system will not be used, it is a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. The progress of reconnaissance will be monitored via a Safety tracing system (STS), GPS system by rally officials. GPS data from STS will also be monitored during liaisons. Evaluation of GPS data from STS is within the competence of the Clerk of the Course. If the reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with a working tracking device, Infringement will be reported to Stewards, resulting in penalizing of the crew.

After reconnaissance, crews must re-install the tracking device to the rally car according installation instructions appendix no. 7. Devices must be removed from rally car and returned to STS, GPS system administrator after TC8A, to rally headquarters before the 27th of January, 2024 (Saturday) 21:00. Devices can be returned at TC8A (before Park Ferme).

Principles on Safety and Tracking

Each device has a unique serial number that is assigned to a crew. During the competition, rally control center (RCC) follows the position and speed of each crew. The STS GPS tracking device is connected with rally control center (RCC) (which gathers all the data. All data is also gathered in the device itself. The device has an autonomic power resource that is enough for all rally. STS GPS tracking device control unit has "SOS" and "OK", "Roadblock" and "Fire" buttons. By activating "SOS" button, crew members are informing RCC about an accident and that they need assistance ASAP. In this case, calling the phone number on the sticker on the GPS device is also mandatory. If the car stopped in SS due to an accident or technical issues, by pressing "OK" button, crew members inform RCC about the race car being stopped on SS and no additional assistance is needed.

Attention! If the crew has stopped in the special stage for a longer period than 10 seconds, even when the crew is still trying to continue participation, crew members must press "OK" button on STS GPS tracking device control unit. Mobile phones of the crew members must always be on (or switched on within 60 seconds) so that the rally control centre (RCC) could acquire current information about the situation. If the crew receives a Red Flag signal from the device, also known as a signal of danger (Loud sound and RED indicators on STS GPS tracking device control unit), the "OK" button must be pressed for 3 seconds so that RCC receives Confirmation from the crew. The crew must slow down the car and follow marshal instructions accordingly. Failing to comply with these requirements will be reported to the Stewards, who will investigate according to Rally sporting regulations, who may apply a penalty.











SCRUTINEERING MARKING AND SEALING

Participants may request the suitable scrutineering time during on-line registration at www.autorally. It . However organiser, reserves the sole right to move the scrutineering time in attempt make scrutineering as efficient as possible. The detailed time table for pre-rally scrutineering will be published on www.autorally.lt , "Sportity" Application.

Any crew taking part in the rally, or their representative must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the timetable. Any lateness entering to pre-rally Scrutineering area will be fined by 30 EUR for each 10 minutes delayed. Driver and Co-driver are not required to be present during Scrutineering.

Documents to be presented during Scrutineering:

Valid vehicle insurance policy ("Green card");

Vehicle registration documents.

Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it's applicable;

Vehicle ASN technical passport, when it's applicable;

Fully and correctly filled Safety Equipment declaration; (Filled with entry form in www.autorally.lt);

Drivers Safety Equipment

During scrutineering all items of protective clothing are going to be checked, including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR). **During the winter rally event an exception applies to the co-driver's footwear – the use of FIA non-homologated footwear is allowed.**

Noise Level

The maximum noise level must not exceed 103 dB for engine rotation speed of 3500 RPM.

SAFETY RULES FOR SPECTATORS

The rules below will help minimize the risk to a minimum:

Arriving to watch the race, choose a spot to park your car in a way that doesn't obstruct the movement of rally cars and is at a safe distance from the track. Do not bring your pets with you; they may unexpectedly run onto the track! Do not leave children unattended. A high-speed racing car will not be able to stop in time!

Select and secure your viewing spot in advance. Then, you won't need to drive or walk around constantly looking for impressive spots, wondering if a high-speed rallying or safety official's car will suddenly appear behind you.



Always maintain a safe distance from the track. There have been cases where a car veered off the track in the most unexpected places and went quite far beyond the track boundaries, leaving very little time to make decisions for your safety. Consider this when choosing a viewing spot. Hazardous areas are marked with STOP lines and signs saying "Danger Zone." It is strictly forbidden to stand in these places.

Never stand facing the track. Remember that you may not hear an out-of-control car approaching. Always keep an eye on the racing car, even if it seems slow.

The most dangerous place is after a turn or jump. The most dangerous areas are 50-70 meters immediately after a turn or jump on both sides of the track. A car jumping off a ramp (or after a turn) can suddenly change its trajectory. This can happen due to a malfunction or a mistake made by the crew. An uncontrollable car can collide more than 100 meters in any direction.

Always follow the recommendations and requirements of judges, police, security personnel, and other official competition personnel. If possible, help them perform tasks related to your safety and the safety of others.

Do not drive onto the road until it is opened to public traffic by the safety car (usually a car with green warning lights or a green flag).

Remember that the special stage may be canceled due to unsafe behavior of spectators, so respect the competition participants and other spectators.

Especially dangerous places:

- Outer sides of all turns;
- Outer and inner sides of turns immediately after a long straight (about 300-400m);
- Zones immediately beyond the jump from both sides;
- Zones from both sides immediately beyond potholes, irregularities, altered road surface.

All speed zones are closed 1 hour before the start of the first car. The road closure time is indicated on the maps, so, to see the competition from more points, choose areas where there is an opportunity to arrive and leave at your convenient time. Organizers recommend selecting three observation points where you can see rally participants pass by twice. Remember that after the speed zone, entry into the race track is allowed only after the passage of the "Sweeper car" with a green flashing light.

Under no circumstances park your cars in fields and residents' fields; only use designated parking areas. Remember that evacuation routes are planned in special stages so that, in case of an accident, emergency and medical services can pass freely. Therefore, please observe road signs and do not park cars in prohibited areas. Cars should be parked only on one side of the road.

In case of accident:

- Do not succumb to panic and do not rush straight onto the track. Remember that there are other
 cars on the track! Calmly and cautiously assess whether there are any casualties. If urgent medical
 assistance is needed for athletes or other individuals at the accident site, immediately display a sheet
 with the SOS symbol for the following athletes. This sheet is present in all participant cars.
- Remember, if it is necessary to stop the following cars, you need to stand in a clearly visible place at least 50 meters before the accident.



Failure to respect this rule shall result in driver being reported to the Stewards. Crew might be eliminated from competition.
