LaitseRallyPark Maintenance Area and Racing Kart Track Rules and Regulations

REGISTRATION AND OPENING HOURS

- LaitseRallyPark is open from Monday to Sunday, 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM, and on competition days exceptionally from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM.
- The track's owner and manager are Piko Hobikross OÜ.
- All information, document completion, and payments are handled at Hobikardikeskus.
- Prior reservation for track access is required and must be made via phone or email.
- Before accessing the track, participants are required to complete a liability waiver and pay the track rental fee.
- Quiet hours begin at 9:00 PM. Starting from 9:00 PM, starting race vehicles is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- During the nighttime, from 9:00 PM to 8:00 AM, unauthorized persons are prohibited from being on LaitseRallyPark's premises without prior approval. This includes overnight stays in caravan vehicles and camping. Parking for caravan vehicles during nighttime is arranged in the external guest parking area. If desired, for an additional fee, LaitseRallyPark provides electrical hookups.
- LaitseRallyPark reserves the right to make changes to its opening hours.

MAINTENANCE AREA RULES

- The location of your pit box in the maintenance area is determined by LaitseRallyPark's service personnel.
- The pit area is divided into modules of 3x6 meters. The size of the pit area you require will be decided by LaitseRallyPark's service personnel, depending on your technical needs.
- Only competition vehicles and their service vehicles, as well as trailers
 transporting competition cars or a significant amount of spare parts and other
 competition-related equipment, are allowed in the maintenance area. Vehicles
 transporting a competitor and their gear are not considered service vehicles.
 Access to the maintenance area is strictly prohibited for all other vehicles.
- Parking on LaitseRallyPark's premises is subject to a fee of 15 euros per day.
 Parking is only permitted in designated and marked areas.
- Pedestrian traffic on the maintenance area is allowed at a walking pace.

- It is MANDATORY to use a non-permeable base mat under the kart and cover the entire kart base area, with a minimum size of 1.5x2 meters.
- All work related to liquids and lubricants, including refueling, must be done exclusively on the mat in your pit area.
- Any damage to the asphalt surface, including anchoring and drilling for tent installation, is STRICTLY PROHIBITED in the maintenance area.
- The secure installation of tents is the sole responsibility of the tent owner. Tent weights, such as water containers, sandbags, etc., are permitted for anchoring. If desired, tent weights can be rented from the track owner.
- Smoking and open flames are STRICTLY PROHIBITED in the maintenance area.

CLEANLINESS

- Upon leaving the maintenance area, it must be left in the same condition as when you arrived.
- Any generated household waste, including tires, must be taken away when leaving. The disposal of waste on LaitseRallyPark's premises incurs a fee.

LIABILITY

- LaitseRallyPark is responsible for the technical condition of the track and pit area.
- LaitseRallyPark provides electrical supply (220V) in the maintenance area.
- LaitseRallyPark offers the possibility of washing racing vehicles on the premises.
- LaitseRallyPark provides access to restroom facilities on the premises. The stationary restroom buildings are subject to a fee, while the container restroom is available for free use.
- LaitseRallyPark is not responsible for the customer's equipment in the maintenance area.

FEES AND PENALTIES

- Track admission fee is 65 euros, including 22% VAT.
- Track admission tickets can be purchased at Hobikardi Keskus and must be affixed to the front of the vehicle for visibility.
- Information on additional services is available at Hobikardi Keskus.
- LaitseRallyPark reserves the right to demand fines of up to 500 euros for violations of the established house rules.
- In the event of damage to LaitseRallyPark's property, including the race track, associated infrastructure, and equipment, LaitseRallyPark reserves the right to demand compensation based on a calculation.
- LaitseRallyPark reserves the right to change track access fees, conditions, and penalty amounts.
