



Information Letter to all drivers and competitors

1. Registration

Registration for the competition ends at midnight on May 6th (Monday evening going into Tuesday). Participants are considered registered if they have submitted their participation application and paid the participation fee (including mandatory slick tires from the qualifying rounds onwards).

Due to technical reasons, payment links are not yet operational within the registration application. Therefore, we kindly ask everyone to make payments directly to the organizer's bank account using the following details:

For late applications and/or payments, a fine of 75 euros will be imposed.

2. Information on the participation application

Many competitors have left some data selectively missing from their participation applications (frame manufacturer, engine manufacturer, registrant). It is not necessary to fill out a new application, but we kindly ask for the necessary data to be provided for inclusion in the starting list. We will contact the relevant competitors via email.

3. Training tires

LeCont training tires can be purchased in advance from the organizer's online store at https://kartingseries.eu/pood/ or on May 9th from 3:00 PM at the venue. The organizer guarantees that the LeCont tires sold belong to the same tire shipment used in the competitions. Pre-ordered tires are guaranteed.

The paddock area is open for tent setup starting from May 7th (Tuesday) at 3:00 PM. The paddock area must be vacated by May 11th at 10:00 PM.

From May 4th to May 9th, there are unofficial training days. Entry to the premises is from 9:00 AM, and track usage is from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

The competitions will take place on May 10th and 11th according to the competition regulations.
