



To all Competitors

Due to recent rain, we have reviewed Earl's Bad Day, Stages 7/10/13, and Gods of the Valley, Stages 9/12 – we will run both. **We will not be running Quest for Darwin due to a new river and road damage that appeared mid-stage.** I will publish a route and timing between Earl and Gods of the valley in another bulletin.

Below are notes after reviewing the stages. Other than noted, stages are similar to conditions prior to the rain. The stages dry quickly and will get better as the day passes.

For Earl's Bad Day (Stages 7/10/13) we have these notes:

1. The **ATC** has been moved 0.20 down the road.
2. 3.32 (Instruction 9): washout is IN the road an additional 18 inches
3. 5.85 has minor ruts
4. 6.05 has minor ruts and is rough
5. 6.50 has standing water
6. 6.61 has minor water after crest
7. 6.91 has mud
8. 7.05 has mud
9. 7.50 to 7.90 has minor ruts
10. 8.10 has mud with some water
11. 8.38 has mud
12. 8.91 has minor ruts
13. 9.00 has a water splash
14. 9.93 (Flying Finish) has mud

For Gods of the Valley (Stages 9/12) we have these notes:

1. 2.60 minor wash with some mud
2. 4.41 to 4.85 minor ruts
3. 6.41 mud
4. 6.94 standing water
5. 7.14 rough
6. 7.61 to 7.89 minor water in spots
7. 7.99 extra rough & water on exit
8. 8.50 mud
9. 8.78 minor water
10. 10.00 standing water
11. 10.29 standing water
12. 10.64 Mud

13. 10.80 mud

14. 11.30 mud and some water
