It must be filled specifying which of these frequencies are booked to use in case of interferences (without cost) and which are going to be used with the authorization of the telecommunication service of the Fira Circuit S.L.U

To make a quicker legislation of them, you should send the question paper back **before 1<sup>st</sup> November the 2025.**

There is a cost for the use of frequencies and the total amount of money should be paid before the event by a bank transfer.

**Our rates:**

390 € per transaction and coordination cost  
162 € per frequency VHF or UHF simplex channel  
324 € per VHF or UHF duplex channel 2 frq (TX and RX)  
190 € per video camera 8/10 MHz bandwidth  
190 € per Telemetry Data SHF band

**FREQUENCIES NOT AVAILABLE (REGULATED IN SPAIN):**

- 1. UHF Busy Band reserved for LTE Services:**
  - 452,125 Mhz up link (no possibility of assignment).
  - 462,125 Mhz to 467,125 Mhz down link (no possibility of assignment).
- 2. MOBILE PHONE**
  - SHF Band reserved for 4G MOBILE Services.....790 Mhz to 820 Mhz “Busy Band” no possibility of assignment)
  - SHF Band reserved for 5G MOBILE Services .....694 Mhz to 790 Mhz “Busy Band” no possibility of assignment

**IMPORT NOTE TO ALL THE USERS OF THE FREQUENCIES**

**The frequency request questionnaire should be completed at 1st November 2025.**

All frequencies must be mandatory coordinated by the **FIRA CIRCUIT Technician's department** and authorized by the Spanish Telecommunications' ministry.

Therefore, **FIRA CIRCUIT** will not authorize any equipment or frequencies to be installed unless being processed by the former notice.
