4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The competition is organized in compliance with the valid AKK rally rules, as well as these HYAcenter Rally rules, which AKK Motorsport has approved with license number ??/R/25.

The total length of the race is 335 km including 6 special tests, the total length of which is 70 km.

If a competitor or someone acting on his behalf is met on the route in the area of the following municipalities or cities, Pälkäne, Kangasala, Lempäälä, Vesilahti, on the yellow, gray, black or unmarked roads of the Finnish road map before competitor's departure time, the competitor is denied the right to participate in the competition.

Classes 1–11 competitors are allowed to familiarize themselves with the route on Friday the 25.7.2025 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Turn arrows are used in the competition, the direction of travel at the intersection is indicated by the direction of the arrow tip. The competition follows the regulations of the Finnish Sports Ethics Center (SUEK), which can be found at suek.fi, as well as the legislation regarding doping.

The competition uses international time card. Finnish rules are decisive.

6. REGISTRATION

Anyone who wants to participate in the HYAcenter Rally must register via the KITI system or ask the competition secretary for secondary registration instructions.

Admission to the competition is in order of registration 100 competitors registered in accordance with the rules.

Classes require at least 3 participants/class. If the number of registrants is smaller, the competitors of that category can be combined with another category.

Seats and safety belts in accordance with FIA standards can be used in the competition, the validity date of which is not decisive. These must be in first-class condition. Competitors must have all driving equipment according to the rules (HANS, helmet, balaclava, overalls, underwear + socks, shoes, gloves for 1 driver).

Use of competitor data by the competition organizer:

When registering for the competition, the contestant accepts the processing of the personal data they have provided by the competition organizer and the publication of specified (name, club, etc.) personal data in the list of participants, list of results, etc. in competition communication. The aforementioned information and photos taken by the organizer may be used in communication of the HYAcenter Rally.

The document check is done electronically. The competitor must fill in the forms found in the KITI system, under HYAcenter Rally under "Attachments" ("Service crew contact information", "Announcer information", "Voluntary scrutineering" and "Recce information" form) as well as the necessary documents scanned; registration extract/transfer permit, Technical card (both pages), Homologation certificate/HTP or V1600 passport, just front page, (competitors license if necessary) and send them to the competition organizer before Monday, 21.7.2025 at 22.00. If the forms are submitted after the aforementioned date, they will not be checked but must be taken with you and presented at registration.

The documents are delivered by e-mail hya.ralli2025@gmail.com clearly scanned and named.

When the competitor has registered through KITI, he assures that all paperwork is in order and in accordance with motor racing rules. The 1st instructor and the 2nd instructor are obliged to notify if he has lost his driving license after registration.

Registration and participation fee must be with the organizer no later than July 15, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. Competition registration can be decided before this deadline, if the maximum number of competitors according to section 6 is full.

Competition is a region 5 (Häme) regional championship competition. If possible qualifying has to be done, it will not be done for those participating in the regional championship competition.

The license number of the 1 driver is used as the reference number.

The participation fee includes the transponder fee. If the competitor pair does not return the transponder undamaged to the organizer after the competition, the competitor pair will have to pay the competition organizer and transponder operator 200 €.

8. SERVICING

Service cars must have a competitor-specific fire extinguisher (new or checked), as well as an oil-absorbing mat ready for use, and a liquid-impermeable protective cover under the race car at least the size of the car's surface area and weights for the tent. Absence of any of these leads to immediate disqualification from the competition by the decision of the competition director.

The competition uses the service area located at: Ideaparkinkatu, 37570 Lempäälä

In the competition remote maintenance possibility for classes 1-11 to maintain EK 1 and after EK 4 (approx. 10 min). Maintenance time included on transit time.

The organizer reserves a 7.5 m x 10 m service area for each competitor. One service car per pair of competitors is allowed in the service area. There is a 20 km/h speed limit in the service area.

After this, the organizer charges a fee of 100 euros for the arrangements.

Penalties for other violations in the maintenance and refueling area:

1st violation €300
2nd violation €600
3rd violation, closing the competition by the decision of the competition director

9. REFUELING

Refueling during the race is only allowed in the areas marked in the road book (refueling area) and from the pumps at gas stations on the route (more details in the competitor's instructions). Refueling elsewhere during the race is prohibited.

Cars that use 98E, E85 and 2 t fuel, and those cars that according to Appendix J of the rulebook can use FIA racing gasoline, can be refueled from their own separate container (poured or pumped into the fuel tank). This refueling place is indicated in the road book (Service area and at the gas station near the meter field).

If rule violations regarding refueling are detected, it will lead to immediate disqualification from the competition by the decision of the competition director.

10. ADVANCE INFORMATION

On Friday 25.7.2025 from 8.40 a.m., competitors can pick up reconnaissance material from the Rally HQ. When acknowledging the material as received, the competitor must give the organizer information about his recce car and his phone number.

The two (2) identifier car badges given by the organizer must be affixed to the windshield in the middle up in the windscreen and on the right rear window and must be visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

On reconnaissance, a speed limit of 80 km/h is valid for all special tests, unless the speed has been set lower by traffic signs or signs placed on the terrain by the organizer. The driving style must be such that it does not endanger or disturb other traffic or nearby settlements. The organizer performs speed and driving style monitoring during the reconnaissance period. The police also supervise the route and punishes traffic violations in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.

The stop sign of officials of the organizers must be obeyed under threat of denial of the right to start

The reconnaissance period starts on the 25.7.2025 at 9:00 and ends at 25.7.2025 at 17:00.

A more detailed schedule for special stages is published in the competitors' instructions.

Recce restrictions:

- The special stages may only be driven twice
- On special stages, you must follow the possible reduced speed limits on the terrain
- Only 1st and 2nd drivers are allowed on the car during reconnaissance on special stages.

10.1 Speeding violation during preliminary inspection

The Clerk of the course can impose the following penalty for excessive speed measured by the police or the race organizer with a speed monitoring device:

1st time: written warning and €90 fine. If the violation is more than 30 km/h, the race director can deny the competitor's right to start.

2nd time: the right to leave is denied.

The fine received for a speeding violation during pre-registration must be paid to the competition office before the competitor's own departure time. Failure to pay leads to the refusal of start.

11. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Competition number sized 50x50cm and hood number sized 50x25cm are used in the competition.

Advertisements are announced in the competitor guidelines. The stickers are distributed at the distribution of materials and their presence is checked during the safety inspection.

12. START AND FINISH

The competitors' ideal starting times are announced according to the program on the competition's official notice board, in the Sportity application. Competitors will receive their time card after an approved security check at the start of AT. Start happens 26.7.2025 Ideaparkinkatu, 37570 Lempäälä, from at 10:01.

The competitor must follow the competition route determined by the organizer throughout the competition. Failure to follow the competition route always results in disqualification from the competition.

The finish is at the Rally HQ.

13. COMPETITION MATERIAL

26.7.2025 at 08:01 a.m. starting each crew receives a road book, which shows the route to be followed in detail, 2 route maps, 2 door numbers, 1 bonnet advertisement and an inspection card.

The 1st driver and the youth class co-driver must present a driver's license and the co-driver must present an identity document (photo ID, e.g. driver's license).

More detailed information on the distribution of material and transponders in the competitor instructions.

14. RE-START AFTER RETIREMENT

In case of retirement competitor has a possibility to rejoin the event at any point of the rally on Clerk of the courses permission. If retirement is due to an accident, car must be presented to scrutineers before re-entry.

Anyone wishing to re-enter should contact competitors relations officer.

15. SECURITY SCRUTINEERING

It is possible to perform the scrutineering in advance on Friday the 25.7.2025.

Friday's voluntary scrutineering must be registered in advance on July 21, 2025 inspection manager **Heikki Valkama**, e-mail: hessu@maanrakennusvalkama.fi

The safety inspection will be organized on the 26.7.2025, a more detailed schedule and place will be announced in the competitor instructions. During the security inspection, the numbers and advertisements must be affixed.

The safety inspection ends on 26.7.2025 10 minutes after the last race number.

Cars must have valid Finnish traffic insurance, inspection and license plates/transfer plates. The Rally Organizer can assist foreign drivers in obtaining transit plates, compensation of 50 € office fee + official fee.

Possible need for plates must be reported to the organizer by July 18th, at the latest by email to:

16. RESULTS

The conditional results will be published by category according to the schedule according to the competitors' instructions on the competition's official notice board in the Sportity application. The final official results can be found in the KITI system and the Sportity application.

Prizes will be awarded to both instructors in the finish area, Ideaparkinkatu, 37570 Lempäälä.

The prize distribution schedule by category is announced in the competition instructions. All award-winning contestants must attend the award ceremony. For compelling reasons, permission to be absent can only be granted by the competition director.
