

Appendix III – Installation / Fitting GPS-Device

The 6th CLASSIC1000 will use GPS devices from MI-RALLY. These are welltried-and-tested GPS trackers, proven in many international events, which the rally organizers will attach to the lower right edge of your vehicle's windscreen using a Velcro strip shortly before the start. Two devices will be installed in each vehicle (one of which is a backup).

This allows the rally organizers and the timekeeper to record and determine the location of all vehicles, their speed, whether they are stationary, and any deviations from the specified rally route throughout the rally.

For permanent power supply, each participant must equip their vehicle with a 2-way USB connector and two USB-C cables, which are connected to the USB-C socket on the GPS device. Since the power consumption of GPS devices is very low, they can also be powered by a sufficiently powerful power-bank if you cannot use a USB connector.

However, it is the participant's responsibility to ensure that both GPS devices function properly for the duration of the rally and that the data required for timing is transmitted to the timekeeper.

The functionality of the GPS devices will be checked by track personnel at various checkpoints.

The GPS devices will remain in the vehicles during the rally and must be returned after crossing the finish line at the end of the rally.
