

## OnX - How to Guide for Racers

### Step 1

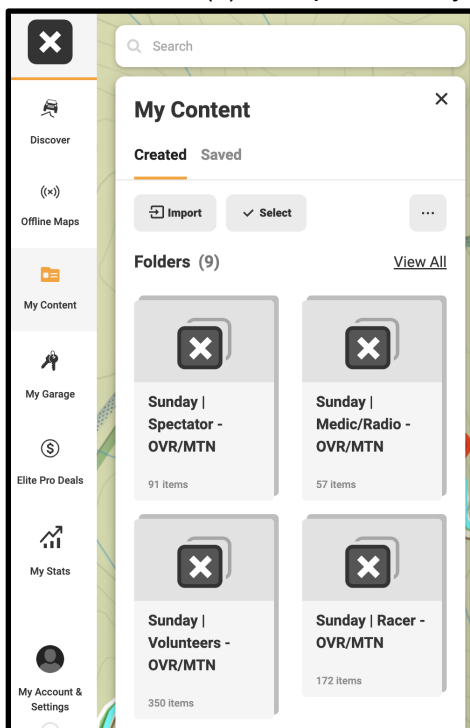
- Download OnX Offroad by searching 'OnX Offroad' in the app store (Apple or Android)
  - A free version is available for those that don't want to purchase the app. The free trial will still work to access the map folders.
  - For those that want to purchase the app, use code 'OVRMTN24' for 20% off.
  - Racers and Senior Volunteers will be provided with a special code for download.
    - Premium accounts will allow for offline map use

### Step 2

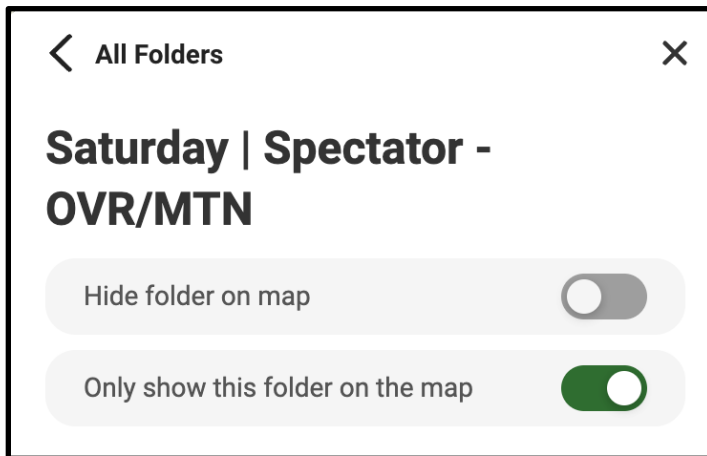
- Once the app is downloaded, access the map folders that are relevant to you
  - Spectators
    - Folders can be accessed here: <https://overmountain-rally.com/spectators>
  - Racers

### Step 3

- Clicking on the folder links will automatically open OnX Offroad
- Once the folder(s) are opened, they will appear in 'My Content'



- With a single folder selected, click on 'Only show this folder on the map' to only view the selected folder. This only displays data in the folder and hides all other routes, waypoints, etc.



- Multiple folders can be downloaded. They will all appear in My Content.

#### Step 4

- Download the maps for offline use by going to 'Offline Maps'
- Select 'New Map'
- Choose 'Medium' for map detail
- Adjust the map coverage by zooming in/out on your device.
- Assign a name to your offline map, then save for use during the rally!
