5. Supplementary Regulations – Art 10.6 On-board cameras (new paragraph)

As an exception to Article 9.1.2 of the Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations, competitors may use on-board cameras (as described in Article 11.2 of the CCRSR) embedding GPS, Wi-Fi and/or Bluetooth functionalities, without being connected to the vehicle's systems.



































## 6. Supplementary Regulations – Art. 11.5 – Qualifying Stage (new paragraph & clarification)

The first 20 competitors on the start list will start separated by 2 minutes. The following competitors will start separated by 1 minute.

The qualifying stage will be held as per article 33 and 34.3 of 2022 FIA CCRSR. For each competitor, the maximum permitted lateness at the finish of the Qualifying Stage is 30 min.

Any competitor who, having started the rally, fails to complete SS1A as required by the regulations will be penalized as per Art. 33.6.2 of the FIA 2022 CCRSR.

Reconnaissance of Qualifying Stage is allowed under the following conditions:

- Must be done on foot, by bicycle (including electric bicycle) or kick scooter (including ekick scooter)
- There will be no limitation on the number of passages
- Schedule: (17<sup>th</sup>-and) 18<sup>th</sup> of October - from 09h00 16h00 to 18h00 19h00 19<sup>th</sup> of October - from 09h00 to <del>12h00</del>-**11h00**

Any infringement to this point of the regulations will result in a penalty at the Stewards discretion.

## 7. **Supplementary Regulations – Art. 11.10.1 – Service Areas / Bivouacs** (update)

The service park will be a Bivouac as defined by Art. 2.4 of 2022 FIA CCRSR.

The speed of vehicles in the bivouac may not exceed 30 kph.

From TCO onwards, service of a competing car may only be carried out in the Bivouac or in the Remote Service Area on Leg 2.

## 8. Supplementary Regulations - Art. 11.20 - Start order and intervals of subsequent legs (to be added)

The start order of the following legs will be based on the classification according to the times established during the selective section(s) of the previous leg.

The leading group will be constituted as follows:

- 1. The first 10 of the Classification (combining Groups T1, T2, T3 & T4), separated by 3 minutes;
- Competitors placed 11th to 20th in the Classification, separated by 2 minutes;
- The following competitors will start in the order of the selective section(s) of the previous leg classification, separated by a minimum of 1 minute.

FIA priority drivers classified beyond 25th place may be repositioned within the leading group at least beyond 10<sup>th</sup> place.
