IMPORTANT REMINDERS TO ALL COMPETITORS

1. Rally car's **extinguisher system must be armed**. This will be checked throughout the rally by the scrutineers and all infringements will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty.
2. Drivers must ensure that they **wear their safety equipment properly on special stages all the way until the STOP control** (helmets and seat belts fastened, balaclava inside the overall, overall zipper closed, driver's gloves worn etc.). All infringements will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty. **Please see 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 53.1.**
3. Any crew which has the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has suffered an accident and the OK sign is not shown, shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance. Any crew stopping on a special stage and who does not require immediate medical assistance, must activate the OK display in the FIA safety tracking device within one minute and show the OK sign to all other cars. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty. **Please see 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 53.3.**
4. **All crews that are shown the Red Flag must immediately slow down and continue that lowered speed until the finish of the stage.** The Red Flag can be a physical one shown at radio points or an electronic one sent to the FIA safety tracking device. The electronic Red Flag must be acknowledged by the crew. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty. **Please see 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 53.5.**
5. **Refuel Zones**
All crews are reminded to comply with **2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Articles 61.2.7 and 61.2.8:**

<p>61.2.7 The use of mobile phones and radio communications is forbidden while in a RZ</p> <p>61.2.8 It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling.</p>

Taking pictures with a mobile is therefore not allowed at the Refuel Zones.

6. **Airbottles**
All competitors are reminded to comply with **Art. 13.1.6 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations** (as published on 14 June 2024):

13.1.6 Devices for maintaining full tyre performance
 The use of any device for maintaining the full performance of the tyre with an internal pressure equal to or less than atmospheric pressure is forbidden. The interior of the tyre

(the space between the rim and the internal part of the tyre) must be filled only with air.

The air must be naturally occurring standard air collected from the earth's atmosphere without any modification to its composition. The use of dryer units on compressors is allowed in order to reduce only the moisture content. The use of all artificially purified bottled gases is forbidden, except for the sole purpose of adjusting the pressure by using canisters carried inside the car, used by the crew members outside of the service park but inside of the official itinerary up to a maximum of 250 grams (maximum total weight canisters) per section.

For the avoidance of doubt, the FIA Technical Delegate confirms that the "maximum total weight canisters" is considered as the maximum total weight of the content of the canisters.

7. Frontal head restraint

For your own safety and as reminder, ensure that your FHR (Hans or Hybrid) and your belts are well installed. Please check the video links below to ensure that your FHR straps are well and tight adjusted in order to limit the risk of serious injury.

8. Traffic rules

All competitors are strongly reminded of the traffic regulations in force throughout the entire event, in particular concerning respect of speed limits and the prohibition of zick-zag driving. The police will carry out radar controls at critical points, both during recce and the rally.

All competitors are also strongly reminded that, according to traffic laws, it is illegal to use hand-held mobile devices while driving. This will be monitored and all infringements will be reported to the Stewards.

9. Water bottles

Water bottles will be given to the crews at the STOP controls of stages. Empty bottles must be taken to the next TC – Do not throw them out of the car!

SCRUTINEERING

Documents relating to the rally car (e.g. insurance cover certificate, registration papers) must be brought to scrutineering for further checking by the local police.

BORDER CROSSINGS

When crossing the border, all persons must carry a valid and recognised passport and, if applicable, a residence permit or visa as border controls may be carried out when travelling to Germany.

RECONNAISSANCE

During Reconnaissance crews are permitted to drive in the opposite direction at

- SS 4/7 – 130 metres at the start (RB page 2-32 box 2 to box 1 start)
- SS 10/13 – 280 metres at the start (RB page 3-32 box 3 to box 1 start)
- SS 15/17 – 40 metres at the start (RB page 4-18 box 1)
