Safety Bulletin

- **New this year, yellow danger signs have been placed at locations that have deemed to warrant special attention, it could be trees, exposures and so on. When you see these signs remember this is not the corner to try and go faster on! Take care. At recent events cars have crashed at these signed corners.**

ARA is serious that you adhere to the following safety procedures. Failure to do so could be brought to the event or steward's attention and may result in penalties.

- **If you have stopped on stage, for whatever reason, press "OK" or "SOS" on the RallySafe ASAP.**
- **If you press "SOS", you must then select either fire or medical. Only press fire if it is an active fire. Medical must be used for medical and all other emergencies.**
- **Then display triangles and show each car your "OK" or "SOS".**

- **If you don't immediately have access to the route book or triangles, you may use the approved hand signals. Arms up, Thumbs up for OK, arms crossed above your head for SOS.**
- **If you come upon a stopped vehicle which is not showing "OK" or any triangles, You MUST stop and assess the situation.**
- **If you determine the stopped competitors are OK, you may continue competing on the stage at race pace. The stoppage time may be returned by filing an inquiry. If the situation warrants an SOS, follow the emergency procedures.**
- **If you are the first car at an emergency scene must stop and render aid to the best of your abilities. You must also gather information on the situation.**
- **If you are the second car on the scene, take that information and proceed at transit speed to the next radio position. This may be the stage finish. Radio positions are marked in the route book and by radio signs on stage. Remain at the radio position until released by Net Control.**

Once the SOS button has been pushed or the SOS is shown to another competitor, the stage is stopped.

- If you are “OK”, but present a hazard to oncoming cars, select “Car blocking road” to warn approaching competitors. If you clear your hazard, also clear it on RallySafe.
- If your “OK” status changes to “SOS”, then press the “SOS” followed by “Medical” or “Fire”.
