1. Introduction

Thank you for taking part in The **Boone Forest Rally** located in McKee, KY, situated in the foothills of Appalachia.

This rally is a **Super Regional** counting toward the ARA East Regional Championship.

Date of the event: Friday and Saturday July 26-27, 2024.

Optional: Partial Recce and Shakedown on Thursday July 25, 2024.

1.1 Competition Regulations

The Boone Forest Rally will be run in accordance with the current General Competition Rules, Rally Technical Rules, and Rally Competition Rules of the American Rally Association (ARA).

1.2 Road Surface

The stages are smooth gravel with portions of asphalt on most stages.

1.3 Route Overview

The Boone Forest Rally route will consist of 7 individual stages, with most run twice. The total stage length is 74.3 miles; the transit distance is 179.7 miles. The stages are **ALL NEW** from last year. Thursday's activities will be in the McKee area. Friday's Rally will start in McKee (Jackson County) and end the evening with a Parc Expose in Beattyville (Lee County). Saturday's start will be in Livingston (Rockcastle County) with the finish of the event in McKee.

4 Entries

4.2 The maximum number of entries will be 40. If more than 40 entries are received a wait list will be kept based on order of full payment.

4.4 Entry fees include recce participation, one Official route book, JEMBA notes, Service information, recce route information, event stickers, one single service spot (20' x 50') & RallySafe tracking & timing.

4.5 Your service vehicle and rally car MUST fit in your service space. If they don't fit within the standard space, you must purchase oversize or extra service spots with your registration. Additional service spots 20 feet by 25 feet will each be an additional \$100.00

4.6 Competitors may revise or withdraw their entry prior to 23:59 EDT on Sunday July 21 by completing an entry update/withdrawal form available in the Registrar Folder on the Sportity App.

4.7 Withdrawn entries will be refunded in accordance with ARA GCR 4.9.

- Prior to 23:59 on 7/7/2024 – full refund
- After 23:59 on 7/7/2024 and until 19:00 on 7/21/2024 – full refund less \$100.
- After 19:00 on 7/21/2024 – no refund

The organizer reserves the right to cancel the event for any reason up to the end of the Entry period or up to the day of the rally due to force majeure. Registered competitors will be given a full refund.

5 Insurance

5.1 USAC Insurance – Third party liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage, effective during the competition, will be provided by a policy secured by USAC and displayed on the Official Notice Board

5.2 Competitor Documentation – Competitors must have documentation showing Bodily Injury and Property Damage liability in amounts equal to or exceeding limits as stated in the current ARA rules for both the rally car and any service vehicles.

5.3 Secondary Coverage – Competitors, service crew members and all event participants including officials, marshals, staff, stewards, and all other volunteers who have obtained an ARA license, signed an ARA waiver and have been issued and are in possession of an event wristband confirming the signature of the waiver will be covered by a secondary USAC participant accident insurance policy which covers excess medical expenses to their primary medical insurance provider.

6 Advertising

6.1 Boone Forest Rally will use the event sponsor advertising space allowed by the current ARA rules. Teams may refuse the rally sponsor's advertising by contacting the registrar & paying a \$1000 fee. All ARA series advertising must be properly displayed on competition cars.

7 Fuel and Tires

7.1 Choice of Fuel and Tires are as per ARA regulations. While in service areas, all refueling must be done in the official "refuel area".

8 Reconnaissance (Recce)

8.1 Drivers and co-drivers must Check In prior to participating in the event. This will be the only Check In required. Wrist bands, Routebooks and Jemba will be provided.

- The speed limit on stages during recce is 35 mph; However, be aware of houses in the stages and proceed slowly past the houses as appropriate, 20-25mph. Speeds may be monitored with the ARA RS Lite Recce APP Per ARA Bulletin 2024-4.
- All recce roads will be open to the public including logging trucks, forestry trucks, hunters, hikers and horses. Inconsiderate or irresponsible driving may result in exclusion from the event.
- Vehicles used for recce must be normal street vehicles with no lettering or advertising which would call undue attention to the vehicle; exhausts must be quiet. No prepared rally cars will be allowed.
- The Clerk of the Course shall be the arbiter of the suitability of all reconnaissance vehicles.
- There will be a video recce offered.
- A recce information document with a recommended route will be provided.
- Teams will have flexibility in their recce schedule.
- Remember the ARA rules on pre-event road reconnaissance.

9 Competitor & Service Crew Check In

9.1 All participants (competitors and crew) must have completed the licensing process online. In person check-in at McKee High School is required during the times noted in the event schedule.

Items to be checked and provided:

- Wrist bands distributed.
- Rally documentation distributed
- Any remaining paperwork provided.

10 Scrutineering

10.1 Scrutineering will be held at the PRTC Mc Kee Industrial Park during the times listed in the Time schedule by appointment only. Appointments may be requested by sending an email to: walterclark171@gmail.com.

Requests must be submitted by July 19, or the scrutineer will assign a time to you. The email should clearly state: The appointment hour requested – i.e., 2-3 pm, 3-4 pm, etc. – and the name, car number and phone number of the person presenting car to tech. All requests will receive a confirmation email with the scheduled time.

THERE WILL BE NO LOGBOOKS ISSUED AT THIS EVENT.

10.2 All ARA required stickers and identification are to be in place when arriving at scrutineering.

Competitor ID packages, including ARA door panels, series sponsor's decals, windshield decals, and number packages must be purchased in advance online. Local event stickers will be provided at team check-in.

10.3 The rally will use the RallySafe tracking, and timing system as detailed at:

www.americanrallyassociation.org/rallysafe. Units will be distributed during scrutineering.

Teams must enter scrutineering with the fitting kit installed. If needed, rental RallySafe fitting kits are available. They are free and must be requested with entry.

11 Service

11.1 The service locations for both days of the rally are at the McKee High School. The only vehicles allowed in the High School area will be competitor's vehicles with organizer supplied identification.

More information on the exact service layout will be available in mid-July.

- Standard service spots are 20 feet by 50 feet.
- Your service vehicle and rally car MUST fit in your service space. If they don't fit within the standard space, you must purchase oversize or extra service spots with your registration. Additional service spots 20 feet by 25 feet will each be an additional \$100.00
- Teams with special service requests (2 cars near each other, last minute change of space needs, etc.) must contact the Chief of Service before Friday, July 19.
- Each entry will be provided with 2 parking "passes"; one for the service vehicle and one other (this might be your recce car). There will be a designated area for the second vehicle.
- Trailer parking is available in a special area at the high school.
- All service must be done on a tarp and with boards or supports under jackstands to prevent damage to tarmac.

12 Shakedown

- A 2-mile Shakedown stage will be available on Mill Creek Road per the Time Schedule; the stage is less than 5 miles from the Service Park.
- Completion of tech inspection is required prior to participating.
- Directions from the Service Park to the Shakedown stage and back to the Service Park will be in the event Route Book.

13 Procedures of the rally

13.1 Parc Exposé

- There will be four Parc Exposés: One preceding the event start in downtown McKee. The second is at the end of Friday night's competition in Beattyville, K, the third before the start in Livingston and the last at the Finish in McKee.
- Please understand the Parc Exposé's are essential to garner local support for our event.
- Directions to all four Parc Exposé's are included in Saturday's Routebook.

13.2 Running of the Rally

- The unposted speed limit on gravel roads is 35 mph; the unposted speed limit on asphalt roads is 55 mph unless otherwise posted.
- The Stage Itinerary will have the times and locations of the controls. The final competitor Start Order will be available after the stewards meeting on Friday.
- The event will be timed and scored (EDT) using RallySafe, which will be the official time.
- All official times will be shown on RallySafe, including stage start countdowns.
- Control procedures will be according to ARA Rules.
- Informational and Provisional scores will be posted on Sportity. Friday's posted provisional scores will be subject to inquiry per GCR 8.2d up to 30 minutes from the time they are posted. After the resolution of any inquiries and protests on Friday's posted scores no subsequent inquiries on these scores will be accepted.

13.3 Restart after retirement

Competitors who have missed one or more controls and are Restarting After Retirement or wish to rejoin as a Non-Competitive Entry, are required to complete and submit an inquiry on Sportity before they may be allowed to restart. The Clerk of the Course will respond to the inquiry and notify the Chief Scrutineer who will verify that the team meets the re-entry safety requirements and have any required tracking or monitoring equipment before having the RGC issue a timecard for the Rally Re-Entry. The reentry may be accomplished only at the Regrouping controls (at the two services) or in the morning after the overnight restart. The competitors must find the Scrutineer in these locations.

13.4 Finish of the rally.

- A Parc Exposé' will be located immediately following the final time control at the McKee Town Square. Any post-rally inspections and tear downs of a competing vehicle will be performed within this impound area at the discretion of the event officials.
- Podiums will be conducted with provisional results at the McKee Town Square.
- Trophies for the class winners in positions 1st – 3rd will be awarded. Trophies not collected at the awards ceremony may be shipped.

14 Sanction exceptions

Maximum Permitted Lateness (MPL) MPL will be 15 minutes for Turkey Foot 1 and the transit to Turkey Foot 2. The rest of Leg 1 will be run with 30 minutes of MPL. Leg 2 will have the standard 30 minutes of MPL.
