4.6 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- to competitors whose entry has not been accepted.
- in case of the rally not taking place.

The organisers refunds 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reason of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN), are unable to start in the rally and contacts the organisers no later than 4 days before the rally. Later cancellations will not result in a refund.

The mandatory fee for RallySafe is non-refundable.

5. Insurance

The entry fees include the insurance premium to insure the competitors and other parties as necessary against third party risks whilst racing on the special stages of the rally. The indemnity provided under this special insurance is DKK 20.000.000.

6. Identification

The location of rally plates, competition numbers and organiser's advertising is shown in Appendix 4. Competitors failing to display the required rally plate and/or competition numbers will receive a financial penalty.

Failure to display all required competition numbers may be reported to the Stewards, who may impose additional penalties up to and including exclusion from the event.

All rally plates, competition numbers and mandatory advertising must be correctly affixed to the car before scrutineering.

6.1 The organisers' advertising

Competitors who accept the organiser's optional advertisements must reserve the required space in accordance with App. 4.

The organisers' advertisements must be visible throughout the event. Any competitor failing to comply with this will be fined unless an increased entry fee has been paid.

7. Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance shall be carried out in accordance with the Danish rally regulations Art. 35 including all applicable sub-articles. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in Appendix 2 of these supplementary regulations

Passages on circuit stages is defined as driving from start to finish of the stage in accordance with the roadbook.

8. Administrative checks

8.1 Documents to be presented:

- Competitors' licence
- Driver's and co-driver's competition licences
- Driver's and co-driver's valid driving licences
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Car insurance cover certificate (foreign competitors only)
- Car registration papers (foreign competitors only)

9. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

9.1 Scrutineering, venue and timetable

A detailed scrutineering schedule will be published. It is the competitors' responsibility to complete scrutineering within the timeframe in the program.

9.2 Noise level

Noise level control takes place in accordance with DASU Technical Regulations art. 296.

Noise levels at time of control and during the rally must be in accordance with the Regulations for Rally in Denmark Art. 18.3.

Max Noise level: 103.

9.3 Special national regulations

9.3.1 Technical passports

The technical passports of the cars will be collected during Scrutineering and retained in the rally secretary during the rally.

When your rally is over a good faith declaration is to be submitted before returning the passport, However, for retired competitor, the organizers' may demand the car to be inspected by a scrutineer before the passport can be returned.

9.3.2 Danish special plates

Not in use for non-danish competitors.

9.4 Onboard cameras

Onboard cameras must be mounted in the car at the time of scrutineering. The onboard camera system as fitted must be approved by the scrutineers.

9.5 Tracking system

The tracking system must be mounted in the car and approved at the scrutineering in accordance with Regulations for Rally in Denmark Art. 18.2. The tracking system must be functional from time of scrutineering to the end of the rally. If the tracking system is not functional a report will be made to the stewards.

10. Other procedures

10.1 Start *parc fermé*

Not in use.

10.2 Starting procedure on the Special Stages

All Special Stages will use an electronic starting system.

The starting clock will display **five red lights** beginning five seconds before the start.

The lights will extinguish one at a time at one-second intervals.

The official start signal is given when the final red light goes out.

False starts will be detected by photocells and indicated by flashing start lights.

The normal start interval will be **one minute**.

10.2.1 Starting procedure on the Special Stages, circuit type:

Timing begins at the vehicle's actual start.

The normal start interval will be one minute; however, for safety reasons this may vary.

Under no circumstances will the interval be less than **40 seconds**.

At the **STOP** control, competitors must use the RallySafe system to determine their official start time for calculating the driving time to the next Time Control.

Only hours and minutes shall be used when calculating the target time.

10.3 Finish procedure

The overall prizes are present on the podium at TC 12A.

10.4 Time controls with permitted early arrival

TC's where early-check in is allowed TC12B

10.5 Traffic laws

According to Danish Rally Regulations Art. 34.

10.6 Service Parc

Location

Behind Rally Headquarters in the harbour area.

Each entered crew will be allocated a **48 m²** service area.

Additional service space may be ordered using the form available on Sportity.

Late applications will incur an administration fee of **DKK 300**.

The Service Park allocation plan will be published on **Thursday 20 August at 22:00**.

Service Park personnel will be available to assist competitors on arrival.

Electricity will **not** be available in the Service Park.

Surface

Gravel and asphalt.

Opening Times for Service Vehicles

Service vehicles may **not** enter before the official opening times.

Friday 21 August 08:00

Saturday 22 August 06:30

Whenever work is carried out on the rally car, a groundsheet or environmental mat must be placed beneath the vehicle.

The use of such protection is mandatory during oil changes or when handling any other fluids.

Failure to comply will result in a **DKK 500 fine** imposed by the Clerk of the Course.

10.7 Refuelling

After each service, there is the option of filling up with petrol in your own tent. You may not refuel elsewhere unless it is described in the roadbook.

Service personnel must bring fuel in approved containers.

A waste tray and "cat litter" must be brought in when refuelling.

The rally car's engine must be switched off, and a 6kg fire extinguisher must be available.

10.8 Official time during the rally

10.9 Official timing

RallySafe is used for timing in the rally.

10.10 Power Stage

SS 7 is power stage for DSR. (DASU dispensation applied for.)

10.11 Rally Safe procedure

Every participant must report back to Race control via the Rally Safe system when stopping on a stage.

Any participant who receives an overtake warning via the Rally Safe system must allow the faster vehicle to pass as soon as it is safe to do so.

10.12 Good faith declaration

A good faith declaration, issued in the Rally Secretary, must be completed, signed and returned before conclusion of the rally. Failure to do so can be penalized up to exclusion at the Stewards' discretion.

10.13 Chicanes

The position of each element of chicanes is marked by a line on the road corresponding to +20 cm around each element.

If one or more elements are moved so much that the element touches or exceeds the line, a penalty is imposed.

Judges of fact monitor the chicanes. Judges of fact are appointed in a bulletin before the start time of the first competitor on the first special stage.

More can be distributed, but this is the minimum.

13. Final Checks

The final checks will be informed in IK Auto, Industrivej 9, Juelsminde.

Cars involved in final checks (at the discretion of the Stewards and notified to the participant at the last TC) must be accompanied by the crew and one mechanic (if dismantling is required).

13.2 Protest fees

The protest fee set by DASU is regulated in Adm. Cir. H4 must be paid in cash when the protest is lodged.

13.2.1 Additional Fees

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of parts of the car, an additional deposit must be Paid.

Is the protest referring to a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, brake system, electrical system, chassis, etc.) a deposit of DKK 4,500 is paid.

Is the protest referring to the entire car a deposit of DKK 45,000 is paid.

Expenses distributed according to DASU Adm. Cir. I4.

14. Appeal

14.1 Appeal fee

The fee for a national appeal is DKK 6,000.

The fee for an international appeal is EUR 5,000.

14.2 Appeal time limits

The deadline for appeals to the DASU national court of appeal is 14 days after publication of the decision being appealed.

The deadline for appeals of decisions issued on the day of the competition by the stewards or clerk of the course is, however, no later than 7 days after publication of the decision that is to be appealed, as the appellant must, however, notify the stewards or clerk of the course in writing of their intention to appeal within one hour of the publication of the decision and that the appeal fee will be paid as specified in clause 14.3

14.3 Procedure

An appeal to the DASU national court of appeal is submitted in writing and signed by the appellant to the secretariat of DASU. The fee should be enclosed.

Bank transfer of the fee on the same day as sending the appeal is considered timely.

Appendix 2 – Reconnaissance schedule

The rally consists of five different Special Stages.

The Juelsminde stage may only be driven during reconnaissance between:

16:00 and 17:00

All other stages:

10:00–16:00

Date: 21 August 2026

The RSLite App must be installed and active throughout reconnaissance.

Instructions for the application will be published on Sportity.

Driving in the opposite direction on any Special Stage during reconnaissance is strictly prohibited.

Each reconnaissance vehicle must display the issued reconnaissance identification number in the upper right-hand corner of the windscreen.

Maximum reconnaissance speeds:

Urban areas: 50 km/h

Rural roads: 60 km/h

Gravel roads: 30 km/h

Where a lower speed limit is indicated in the Road Book, that limit shall apply.

A crew is limited to two passes on each special stage (special stages driven twice or more are considered one stage).

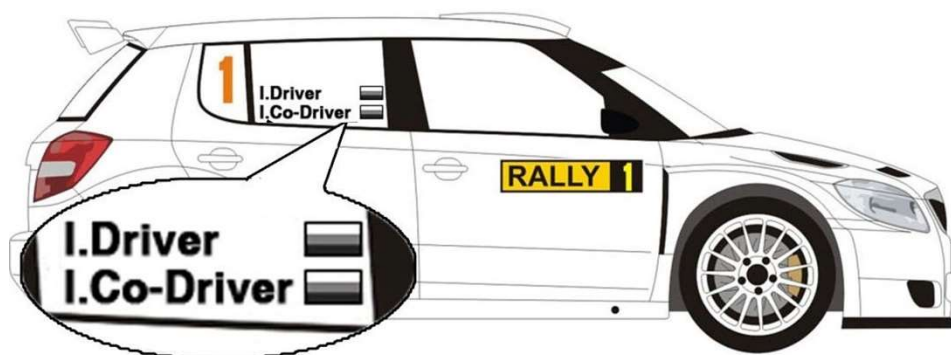
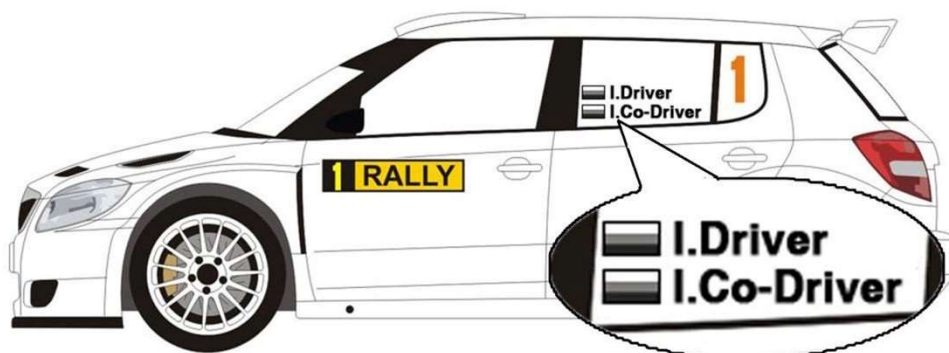
