

NRC Regulations 2026

1. General

Nordic Rally Championship (NRC) will be held under the prescriptions of the FIA International Sporting Code, Sporting Code of the ASN (host event), Rally Regulations of the ASN (each event host ASN), Official ASN Bulletins or other communications, these Championship Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations of each event.

2. Cars eligible and Classes

2.1 Class 1

Cars eligible in the Class:

- 4WD Cars with valid International FIA Homologation

Accepted Cars:

- FIA Rally 2/R5/Rally2 Kit/S2000 (RC2)

2.2 Class 2

Cars eligible in the Class:

- FIA Rally 4/R2 (RC4) with valid International FIA Homologation
- FIA Rally 5/R1 (RC5) with valid International FIA Homologation
- FIA grp. N 1601- only 2wd.
- RGT (RGT) with valid International FIA Homologation
- 2WD Cars conforming to any National ASN regulations (Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Iceland)

Note:

Cars competing in NRC class 4, 5 or 6 do not score points in this class.

2.3 Class 3

Cars eligible in the Class:

- FIA Rally3 (RC3)
 - 4WD Cars conforming to any National ASN regulations (Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Iceland), including WRC cars homologated before 31.12.2016

2.4 Class 4

Cars eligible in the Class:

Volvo original Cup and cars homologated in: Swedish group F, Norway B-zero, Danish group E 0-1600 ccm, Finnish V1600 and BMW rallisarja

2.5 Historic class 5

Cars eligible in the Class:

- Historic cars (2WD and 4WD, all periods), with FIA Historic Technical Passport (HTP) or National Historic Technical Passport granted by Following ASN 's: Denmark, Sweden, Iceland

Categories:

- Category 1 (1931-1969)
 - Category 2 (1970-1975)
 - Category 3 (1976-1981)

2.6 Historic class 6

Cars eligible in the Class:

- Historic cars (2WD and 4WD, all periods), with FIA Historic Technical Passport (HTP) or National Historic Technical Passport granted by Following ASN 's: Denmark, Sweden, Iceland Category 4 (1982-1990)

3. Registration and competitor requirements

No Championship registration. All drivers in championship classes will collect points.

Minimum age for the driver is 18 years.

3.1 Competitors eligible for Points

All drivers holding a license given by following FIA member ASN:

- Denmark
- Finland
- Iceland
- Norway
- Sweden

Competitors must have a starting permission from own ASN to compete outside home country.

3.2 Entry Fee

Event entry fee as per event Supplementary Regulations.

No additional fee for NRC.

3.3 Returning of entry fee

Competitors who participate outside their home country can cancel their entry and get the total entry fee back, if the entry is withdrawn no later than Monday before the event.

4. Championships calendar and Allocation of Points

4.1 Championship events

The NRC consists of six (6) events, two (2) events in each country (Norway, Sweden and Denmark), if possible, even spilt between gravel and tarmac events.

4.2 Points

Points are allocated in NRC events individually in classes as follows:

Dead Heat in a Championship will be decided as per FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations Art. 8.

4.3 Participation requirements to be eligible for the NRC Championship classification and scoring of results for the final Championship

A competitor must start at least one event in each of the three host countries: Norway, Sweden, and Denmark.

Each competitor may freely select their best four (4) results, regardless of in which countries these results were achieved.

Only the four highest-scoring events will be counted, provided that the participation requirement above is fulfilled.

4.4 Prizes

Prizes will be given to first three Teams (driver and co-driver) of a class, as per final championship classification. Prizes will be presented at final event of the Championship.

5. Safety equipment

5.1 Personal safety equipment

According to the regulations in the country where the rally is organized.

5.2 Safety equipment and technical equipment, national cars

According to regulations of the driver's home country.
