Session	R2 – Excel – Race 1
Fact	Car 77 turning across the path of Car 25, causing Car 25 to make contact with the wall
Rule	CRSR 6.2.9 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the Automobile (such as leaving the Track) will be reported to the Stewards and may entail the imposition of a penalty/ies up to and including Disqualification of the Driver concerned.
Decision	30 Second Time Penalty
Reason	Due to the damage caused to Car 25, we classed this as a high-level incident. The penalty is in line with previous breaches of this rule.

The Competitor/Driver is reminded that decisions and penalties that may be subject to appeal are set out in the Circuit Race Standing Regulations, Article 7, and the right to and process for appeal are set out in the National Competition Rules, Article 101 and Articles 105 - 106.
