<b>Fact</b>	Car 8 gained an advantage on Car 31 by leaving the track at Turn 7
<b>Rule</b>	CRSR 6.2.9 If an Automobile leaves the Track for any reason it may re-join. However, this may only be done when it is safe to do so and without gaining any lasting advantage. A Driver will be judged to have
<b>Decision</b>	5 Second Time Penalty
<b>Reason</b>	Car 8 was observed to gain an advantage by leaving the track at Turn 7. The penalty is consistent with similar breaches.

The Competitor/Driver is reminded that decisions and penalties that may be subject to appeal are set out in the Circuit Race Standing Regulations, Article 7, and the right to and process for appeal are set out in the National Competition Rules, Article 101 and Articles 105 - 106.
