7. Administrative Checks

7.1 Documents to be presented

Documentation and Signing-On will be completed on line any time from now until 21.30 on Tuesday 8th October 2024.

Competitors should use the link in their rallies.info entry acknowledgement email to access their entry home page. In here you will find two sections: **Electronic Documentation** and **Signing-On**. Use this system to upload pictures of your Competition Licence and Club Membership cards. Competitors should also complete their signing-on declaration. Competitors under 18 can also get their parent/guardian/guarantor to countersign the declaration.

There is no need to complete any pre-event scrutineering information in here.

Any team entries can be emailed to <u>entries@mullrally.org</u> and the team entry fee of £20 sent by bank transfer with the team name as reference, and/or advised at Material Collection.

If you haven't already arranged Third Party Insurance for road sections you can also register for Reis by contacting <u>entries@mullrally.org</u> and paying the £39.00 fee.

If you have any problems completing this process then you should contact <u>entries@mullrally.org</u>

Rally packs will not be issued to any competitors who have not fully completed the online documentation process.

Competitors will be issued with their time cards at Material Collection – inclusion on the Start List will be pending successful completion of administrative checks, sound test and scrutineering.

Time cards for all three legs will be issued at each briefing session, upon successful completion of administrative checks, sound test, scrutineering and competitors' briefing.



7.2 Competitors' Briefings

All competitors (Driver and Co-Driver) will be required to watch a safety briefing video, which will be posted to the Official Notice Board by 18.00 Thursday 10th October latest.

All competitors (Driver and Co-Driver) will be required to attend a safety briefing. These will take place on Friday 11th October in Aros Hall, Main Street, Tobermory, PA75 6NU, ///coarser.unopposed.luxury.

There will be 3 briefing sessions based on the seeded entry list. Time cards will be issued at each briefing session. Any crew not attending will not receive their time cards and will not be allowed to start. All reserve competitors should attend the final briefing session at 15.45.

Session times are:

Cars 1 – 50	14.15
Cars 51 – 100	15.00
Cars 101 onwards	15.45

8.4 Running Order, Starting Intervals and Timing

Time cards will be issued to competitors at Material Collection.

Time cards for all three legs will be issued at each briefing session, upon successful completion of administrative checks, sound test, scrutineering and competitors' briefing.

In accordance with new-for-2024 GR R.30.1.3., timing will be by "traditional" / "contact" methods, with competitors presenting timecards to the marshals. Time cards will be collected at Time Controls. In select individual cases, timekeeping marshals may elect not to engage in contact timing – please respect their wishes, and follow marshals' instructions in the completion of your time card at these controls.

9. Servicing

9.1 Permitted Areas

Emergency, Management or Auxiliary service is prohibited on the event and organised assistance anywhere other than these permitted areas is forbidden and could lead to disqualification from the event. **This will be stringently monitored and policed.**

Specifically, the forecourt of MacDonald's Filling Station, Salen, PA72 6JF, ///forensic.await.meanders is out of bounds for management service outside of refuelling operations – specific request of the landowner.

Driving Standards Observers and Interim Cars will be on patrol, and monitoring for compliance.



9.5 Refuelling

The event will operate one official Refuel Zone:

Isle of Mull Rugby Club, Garmony, PA65 6BA, NM/ 6751 4062, ///momentous.cheek.broth

Harbour Garage Tobermory, have confirmed that they will have a supply of Super Unleaded (98 RON) fuel available during event week, "hopefully on sale from Tuesday 8th", for competitors to obtain fuel for self-refuel, or to use as a filling station on the rally route.

Gulf Race Fuel will be in attendance with a refuel rig at the Refuel Zone.

Last we were advised, Vital Equipment / Carless Fuels will not have a refuel rig, but will have a fuel can delivery service in operation from Salen, from which competitors may then take their self-refuel cans to the RZ.

Further details of Refuel Zone operation, including Opening Times, will follow subsequent to a site visit by the Environmental Scrutineer / Refuel Zone Officer, Peter Clingan (<u>refuel@mullrally.org</u>).

2. Ledaig Car Park & Tobermory High School (Rally HQ)

No service vehicles or trailers are allowed in the grounds of Ledaig Car Park, from 12.00 Thursday 10th October until 09.00 Saturday 12th October.

No service vehicles or trailers are allowed in the grounds of Tobermory High School, from 12.00 Thursday 10th October until 11.00 Sunday 13th October.

The penalty for non-compliance is:

- First offence Fine of £100 to be paid before start
- Second Offence 5 minute time penalty added to time the crew or crews of the vehicle
- Third offence Start not permitted or disqualification

3. Red Flags & OK/SOS Procedures

On any special stage where in extreme circumstances is it necessary to authorise the movement of non-competing or rescue vehicles before the stage is cleared of competing cars, a system of red flags will be in place. These flags will be at every radio location marked in the road book on the special stages.

Information given to Marshals or Officials regarding the display of an OK/SOS Board, must **ALWAYS** be **FACTUAL** and **ACCURATE**. **NO INFORMATION** is better than **FALSE OR INACCURATE INFORMATION** – please only report what you have actually seen, if you did not see anything, say so. If you are not sure of the OK/SOS Board procedure, please refer to section R25.4 of the Motorsport UK Yearbook.

Competitors are urged to familiarise themselves with **SR 8.12 Safety Tracking** and associated non-compliance penalties, including new-for-2024 standing regulations in Motorsport UK GR **R.25.4**.

A reminder on Red Flags & OK/SOS Procedures will be provided in the Competitors' Briefing.



4. Medical Facts

Any competitor with medical facts which may be pertinent to their treatment in event of an incident, are requested to provide such details, in confidence, to the Chief Medical Officer.

This can be done by contacting <u>medical@mullrally.org</u>, or by way of submitting a sealed envelope to the Event Secretary at Material Collection.

6. Competitor Liaison Officers (CLOs)

Amanda Morrison, Bryan Hull & David Thompson will be in attendance at the first and last control of each leg for any issues that are easier dealt with face to face.

Please note, that in the case of being stopped on stage or reporting retirement from the event, competitors are requested to contact the **HQ Emergency Line – 07594 216246**, displayed at the bottom of each page of, and NOT the CLOs.

7. Readiness to Start Special Stages

Considering recent events, please ensure that you arrive at the start of each Special Stage, in a state fit to start that stage. The event's scrutineers will be checking that helmets, belts, balaclavas and FHR devices are fitted correctly, throughout the course of the event.

8. Service Areas A & C - Craignure

The ferry terminal is to be kept clear to allow passengers and cars to disembark and embark during the evening of Friday 11th October.

Ferry arriving at 19.05 and departing at 19.25 - No competitor's service team is to set up on any CalMac ground in Service Area A before 20.00 on Friday 11th October.



Ferry arriving at 21.00, and ferry arriving at 22.30 & departing at 22.45 – The area of yellow hatching at the end of the passenger walkway and the area for loading vehicles as shown in the sketch below must be kept clear at all times.



No competitor's service team is to set up in Service Area C before 21.30 on Saturday 12th October.

The penalty for non-compliance with any of the above will be a five-minute penalty to the corresponding competing car or cars.

9. Recovery on Legs 2 & 3

Competitors are advised that while efforts may be made to recover stranded vehicles in between the first and second running of stages during Legs 2 & 3 – i.e. SS10 vs SS12, and SS13-16 vs SS17-20 – in many cases recovery between runs may not be possible, and as such you may be in a remote autumnal location for periods of time. As such, for your own welfare, you advised to take with you in the rally car, suitable protection from the elements, as well as hydration and sustenance.
