- ISU Rules 253-260 & 265 will be followed for the event along with ISU Communication 2572, 2586 & 2651 and the Red Book's D3-200 & D3-300 rules.
- We will be pulling skaters out of the ISU Mass Start race when they are lapped.
- False starts will be restarted right away, so will Fresh starts for double false starting.
