- Officials/Coaches Food Room (Hospitality)

- Officials Area
  - Any people without badges should be directed out of the official's areas.
- Change Rooms
  - Change rooms for all athletes are on the main floor accessed to the left of the foyer for the men and to the right for the women. *They must be vacated by 6:00 pm each day for hockey use.* This is an accreditation required area but we will not have the volunteers to enforce that at all times. Coaches may access the central area but are discouraged from entering the actual change rooms.

- Timing Deck access limited to Electronic Timing, Recorders, Live Stream Crew and Meet Coordinator. As needed access by Chief Referee.
- End of day reviews. 15 minutes after racing a day review will be held in the hospitality room.
- Walking Track- Athletes must follow the direction listed for the day and be respectful of other users. This privilege may be revoked by the facility if it is abused.
- TVs in the change room foyer run the live stream on a slight time delay.
- Charging stations will be available in the change room foyers and the coaches infield area.
- Transponders- collected and returned for each race. Allow extra time.

**Competition Format, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines**

A few reminders for the event:

- ISU Rules 253-260 & 265 will be followed for the event along with ISU Communication 2586 & 2651 and the Red Book's D3-200 & D3-300 rules.
- No trains over 2 skaters during the warm-up, except during the Team Pursuit warm-up.
- There will be a marked area on the backstretch for practice starts during morning warmups. NO Practice starts anywhere but in marked area.
- No earphones/communication device on ice.
- Equipment check for the ISU Mass Starts prior to warmups Saturday morning in both change room foyers.
- No acceleration thru the starting area or corners in the warmup lane during races.
- No skaters or coaches in the warm up lane or coaches box during mass starts.
- No skaters in the warmup lane during team pursuits.

**Canada**

- No coaches skating with skaters in the warmup lane
- Only 1 coach per skater in the coaches box and stay 20m away from the start.
- We will be pulling skaters out of the ISU Mass Start race when they are lapped and directing them into the warmup lane and the infield chairs by the clerk of the course.
- False starts will be restarted immediately, so will Fresh starts for second false start for seeding purposes only in the 500 OS. Second false start is a DQ
- Withdrawal forms will need to be submitted to the timing deck no later than 1 hour prior to the race.
