STOPPING AND WAITING ON ROAD SECTIONS

To avoid speeding and disruption to normal traffic, target times for road sections are calculated with ample margins. As a result, crews often arrive early and may need to wait before checking in at the time control.

According to Spanish Road Traffic Law, waiting or parking on public roads is prohibited. It can also create a potentially dangerous situation for other road users. The consequences may include a traffic violation report, a fine, and wasted time dealing with the proceedings.

There is sufficient space between the road closure point and the time control before each special stage. These areas are closed to public traffic. Therefore, it is strongly recommended to wait in these designated zones.

SS 16/18 Santa Lucía Agüimes	RB 4 - km 67,69 - p52 - between b66 & b67
