Art. 1.1 Preamble

This event will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) including appendices, the FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations (FIA CCRSR) including appendices, the WADA/NADA Codes, and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations of the countries the event passes shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins. Bulletins will be issued by the Organiser, up to the commencement of administrative checks with the approval of the FIA, after the administrative checks by the Stewards of the Meeting. Exceptionally, modifications to the itinerary may be made by the Organiser. Additional information will be published in the Rally Guide. The "Service" ID bracelets will grant access to the service park and intervention to race vehicles (together with the Arm band to enter the Scrutineering) in the case laid down in the Regulations.

In the case where the ID bracelet becomes damaged, the person must get the bracelets replaced by the Organization, in exchange for the damaged one.

Checking by the organisation of this identification will be systematic at each service entrance and HQ zone, and at the entrance of the prize-giving. Presentation of the identity bracelet is compulsory each time it is requested by the Organiser or their representatives.

Any fault remarked by a judge of fact or member of the organisation will result in a 250 € penalty.

Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full:

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry application is rejected.

The organiser may partially refund entry fees if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

The entry fee includes the insurance premium to insure civil liability of competitors against all third part risks whilst taking part in the Italian Baja.

The provided indemnity under this special insurance is **€ 25.000.000,00** covering each incident or accident.

- The Organisers decline liability for any accident caused to competitors and competing cars during the whole of the event, any in case of cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism etc. Competitors and crewmembers will have to suffer all consequences (damages, fines and penalties) created by any accidents. Organisers also decline any liability for breach of the Italian Laws and regulations. Injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating cars are not covered by this insurance.
- Entrants and drivers are free to take on at their own convenience any individual insurance policy that they deem fit, independently from the above-mentioned liability insurance.
- Vehicles carrying service, auxiliary, and/or any other equivalent special plates issued by the Organiser are not covered by the event's insurance policy. These vehicles circulate under the sole responsibility of their owners and the organizer bears no responsibility for them.
- The Organiser guarantees the recover of the injured driver in the Udine or Pordenone hospital. All medical costs and hospitalization, after repatriation to Europe, remain entirely at the expense of the beneficiary. Competitors are recommended to take information about the cover afforded by their racing driver's licence and take out additional insurance with an insurance company of their choice.

Art. 5.1 Accident reporting

If a driver taking part in the Baja is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver concerned must report this to the next marshal point. If he fails in observing this rule, the Stewards may impose to the responsible crew a penalty, which may go as far as disqualification.

Un case of accident in the Baja itinerary, competitor or his representative must notify **in writing the Clerk of the Course, the Crew's Relation Officer or the Organizer as soon possible**

Art. 6. Advertising and Identification

See Appendix 3 of these SR “Decals and positioning of supplementary advertising”.

The organiser will provide each crew with the advertising and identification panels, which must be affixed to their vehicles in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. **It is not allowed to cut the panels.**

Art. 6.1 Obligatory organiser’s advertising

- Class Ultimate T1.2: 36 x 36 cm
- Groups Challenger/SSV: 30 x 31 cm

LINO SONEGO

These panels must be affixed to the right and left sides of the vehicle, on the front door, in the area between the wheel arches provided they are fully visible from the side, and on the roof of the Vehicle, readable in the direction of travel.

To keep the time required for the administrative checks to the necessary minimum, make sure to bring and present the following documents:

- Competitors’ licence
- Driver’s and co-driver’s competition licences (if one of the drivers should be the competitor, he must also hold a competitors’ licence)
- Driver’s and co-driver’s ID cards/passports
- Driver’s and co-driver’s valid driving licences valid for the vehicle entered.

- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car registration papers
- **FIA Technical Passport**

The Competitor is the only responsible for the validity of the different administrative documents required to participate in the ITALIAN BAJA 2024 and in particular the validity of the driving licence, vehicle registration papers and vehicle insurance

The installation of the tracking system and the NAV-GPS will be checked at scrutineering.

The complete original FIA homologation form / FIA Technical Passport and all other necessary certifications/documents must be available for final checks.

Art. 10.2 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

Each vehicle must be equipped with a medical kit from the FIA Technical List n°83, that must be placed inside the cockpit, and a survival kit according to FIA CCRSR Appendix IV-2.1 and the defined Safety Type (see SR Art. 1.5).

Art. 10.3 Installation of the Safety Tracking System and Navigation System

Art. 10.3.1 Safety Tracking System (FIA CCRSR Art. 12.1)

All vehicles must **only** be fitted with the Safety Tracking System(s) provided by the Organiser. The instruction for the use of the Tracking System is in the Appendix 5 of these Supplementary Regulations.

The rental of these units is included in the registration fee.

The installation will take place before the Scrutineering (see Art.3 of this SR). Tracking Officer will collect the device from the vehicles at the finish Parc Fermè or Service Park for retired competitors.

Manual switching on the Tracking System alarm without security resins (red button) will result in the financial responsibility of the Competitor and may result in the disqualification of the same.

Art. 10.3.2 Navigation System (NAV-GPS; FIA CCRSR Art. 12.2)

Competitors are obliged to be equipped with one or two Navigation System(s) (NAV-GPS) downloaded with the waypoints given by the Organiser. When a crew uses two NAV-GPS, it must indicate in writing, at scrutineering, which of the two will be considered as the official one.

Crews on ITALIAN BAJA 2024 will be equipped by the organization with ANUBE'S STELLA system that integrates the «car-to-car communication system» into the GPS. NAV/GPS devices shall be collected during the Scrutineering. Anube will collect the devices from the vehicles at the finish Parc Fermé or service park for retired competitors. The information relevant to the installation of the system on the vehicle is available on the rally website and from ANUBE.

The Competitor must contact directly ANUBE to order the support/power supply kits for this equipment. **The components kit is not included in the entry fee**

All competitors on the rally must have this system to pass scrutineering.

This system must be working during the running of each Stage. If it is noted that the system is not functioning due to the crew will be reported to the stewards for sanctions.

Any competitor caught by another competitor must pull over and allow themselves to be overtaken.

All competitors who have received 3 requests to overtake (aural warnings) coming from the one and same competitor, in a lapse of time less than or equal to 45 seconds must, in the 60 seconds following the third request, do everything possible to allow the competitor making the request to overtake (if the terrain so allows).

The competitor who has not, in the 60 seconds following the third request to overtake, let the competitor who has made the request pass, will receive penalties as Appendix I Art. 47.3 of 2024 FIA CCRSR.

Any infringement will be penalized by the Clerk of the Course according to Appendix I – Art. 47.3 of the FIA CCRSR.

Art. 10.3.3 Connection of the Systems (FIA CCRSR Art. 12.3)

The specifications for the standard power connector are laid down in the FIA CCRSR Appendix VI.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the Safety Tracking System(s) and the NAV-GPS always remain permanently connected and switched on with the antenna connected throughout the duration of the competition.

Art. 10.3.4 GPS Data Logger

Vehicles selected by the FIA after the publication of the entry list may be equipped with a GPS Data Logger to monitor their performances during the event.

See FIA CCRSR Article 13.1.

Art. 10.4 On-Board Cameras

See FIA CCRSR Article 11.

Each Competitor wishing using any on-board camera must:

- Fill in the request form available on the Event(<https://www.italianbaja.it/en/for-pilots/registration/fia-event>) and send it to entry@italianbaja.com before 20th June 2024;
- Indicate number and position of all the on-boards camera;
- Crews not complying with these will be reported the Stewards;

Team cameras will be identified by an adhesive decal by the Organiser during administrative checks and must be mounted in the vehicle at the time of Scrutineering. The mountings shall comply with Article 283-2 of Appendix J. All camera positions and mountings used must be shown and approved during Scrutineering before the Start of the competition.

Art. 10.5 Electronic Equipment

Any radio or electronic means of communication, or any other device not expressly permitted in FIA CCRSR regulations is forbidden on board the vehicles.

Art. 11. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 11.1 Drivers' Briefing(s)

See programme (SR Art. 3)

At the first briefing of the event, the participation of at least one crew member is compulsory.

Art. 11.2 Pre - Start Area

- The Pre-Start Area will be set-up on the same place of Parc Fermé, competitors MUST enter the Pre-Start Area as per Article 3 Programme of these regulations (from 12:30h to 13:00h).
- The Pre-Start Area will be secured. Access is limited to crew members, VIP and media representatives carrying the appropriate identification/accreditation.
- Cars must be driven by one of the Drivers or any Team member representative to the Pre-Start Area where any kind of service is strictly forbidden; Any type of this infringement will be reported to the Stewards.
- Each entering and any delay in the Pre-Start Area outside the indicated time window according to Art. 3 of these regulations will be sanctioned by C.o.C with a € 100 fine.

Art. 11.3 Ceremonial start procedures and order

Art. 11.4 Electronic start procedure at Selective Sections

According to Art. 42.2 of the 2024 FIA CCRSR

Art. 11.5 Finish procedures

- At the end of the stage, all cars shall pass the finish ramp (ICIP - Parterre) for interviews and then go to the Parc Fermé until its opening on the instructions of the Stewards.
- The prize-giving ceremony will take place at the "Parterre" of the Interporto Centro Ingrosso at 21.00.
- After having parked their vehicles in the Parc Fermé at the passage of the finish line, the participants' team (Crew) must remain available by telephone (mobile phone) until the publication of the final classification.
- The podium and prize-giving will take place according to Article 3 of these regulations. The presence of both crew members is mandatory.
- The prize-giving will take place by awarding prizes to the first group and then to the first five in descending order according to the provisional overall classification.

Art. 11.6 Permitted early check-in.

With reference to Art. 38.2.11 of FIA CCRSR, crews are authorised to check-in ahead of time without incurring a penalty at the following time controls:

P1B – P1D – 1B – 1C – 2B – 2C – 3B

Art. 11.7 Official time used during the event.

Official time throughout the entire event will be GPS time (Italian Time = GMT+2)

Art. 11.8 Road books delivery

The Organiser will issue the Road Book one day at a time.

The "WATER - RESISTANT" Road Books are available to the crews. Reservations are required no later than the closing date for entry (20th June 2024 at 06:00 pm) to the email entry@italianbaja.com.

The cost of each water - resistant Road Book is € 50.00 per day

Legal entrant's Team Manager can request an additional Paper Road Book

Art. 11.9 Servicing of vehicles

Art. 11.9.1 Service Areas / Bivouacs

From **TCP0** onwards, service of a competing car may be carried out in Service Areas (Service Parks and Bivouacs) and road sections as permitted under the FIA CCRSR.

The speed of vehicles in the service parks/bivouacs may not exceed 30kph

All the Teams which have to go to the own service area have to go before in the Service Accreditation Centre (SAC). **GPS POINT: N 45°56.704' – E 12°40.497'**


SAC will be open on Wednesday 03rd July from 03:00 pm to 09:00 pm and Thursday 04th July from 07:30 am to 06:00 pm, and there will receive the service plates and instructions to follow for the own service area.

All the Teams will be placed by the Organizer in the Service Areas.

Once positioned, only the service or passenger transport vehicles equipped with a pass (Service, Team Manager) will be able to enter and exit the service park. The rest of the vehicles will not be able to leave the Service Park until the end of the event.




"TRUCK" Plate:

- Vehicles over 3500kg.
- These vehicles can enter the service park ONLY on Wednesday, 03 July from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. and must be parked there until the end of the event.



"SERVICE" Plate:

- Vehicles less than 3,500 kg (van) used as service assistance.
- These vehicles can enter in the service park every day of the event.



"TEAM MANAGER" Plate:

- Vehicles less than 3,500 kg for the transfer of the team staff.
- These vehicles can enter in the service park every day of the event.

- All these vehicles must affix their plate on the centre of the bonnet or visible place

The "SERVICE" / "TEAM MANAGER" / "TRUCK" Plates must be affixed to the authorized vehicles. During the event, no vehicle will be permitted to enter the Service Park unless these plates are affixed. Inside the Service Park the staff in charge for servicing the competitor's vehicle must wear their armband supplied by the Organizers during administrative checks in a very visible way.

Art. 11.9.2 Identification of team personnel

In service areas, after the start of the competition, only 3 team personnel may work on a competing vehicle driven by FIA Platinum/Gold priority drivers. They will be identified by **tabards provided by the organiser**.

Art. 11.9.3 Service allowed in Selective Section

In accordance with article 49 of the FIA CCR SR, any service is forbidden during Selective Sections. Only crews with FIA groups vehicles still in the competition for the current Stage/SS may assist each other.

Service, pushing or towing done by marshal / organization vehicles is authorized for safety reasons.

Art. 11.9.4 Flexi Service

According to article 52 of FIA CCRSR.

After completion of Section Prologue (TC P1B) Flexi Servicing of **30 minutes** shall permit the removal of the competing cars from the parc fermé to the service park.

The operational window of Flexi Service time will be finished at 09:30 PM of Friday, 05th July.

Art. 11.9.5 Fuel and Refuelling Zone

Except as detailed for the change of a fuel tank, refuelling in the service area is not permitted at any time.

The crews may refuel only in the designated Refuelling Zone (RZ) or at commercial filling stations indicated in the Road book.

The Refuelling Zone (RZ) will be at:

Pordenone, Via Interporto Centro Ingresso, N 45°56.531- E 12°40.961

Refuelling zone is open with the presence of fire appliance and appropriate safety measures as follows:

on Friday, 05th July 2024 from 07.00 to 12.00 hrs

and whenever the vehicles pass by as part of the itinerary (see Road Book). 20 minutes time allocated for refuelling is included in the scheduled time for the road section.

In the RZ the procedures according to Art. 54.2 of the FIA CCRSR must be followed. To access the RZ, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava. Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation and the crew must remain outside the vehicle during refuelling.

According to article 54.1.6 of the FIA CCRSR the team is responsible for the refuelling and must protect the ground with an environmental mat. This applies not only to the actual refuelling process but also to the handling and storage of the tank barrels.

Any infringement will be reported to the Steward.



Appendix 4 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements.

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the FIA standards listed in Appendix L.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) **[Note: FIA 8856-2000 standard is valid for Regional Baja- Cups only]** or to the FIA 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 **concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 47.1.**

Any FIA-approved 8856-2018 garment customised using printing or transfers must be accompanied by a certificate from the manufacturer.

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of any type of jewellery, such as but not limited to, neck chains, bracelets or watches is prohibited during the competition. Exceptions to this rule, providing the CMO and/or Medical Delegate do not consider that due to size or location they may delay rescue or hinder emergency care, are:

- i. the wearing of watch(es) by co-drivers, on the condition that the watch(es) is worn over the overall,
- ii. the wearing of a single band-style ring providing it does not restrict the natural range of motion of the hand, and
- iii. the wearing of body piercing(s) providing they are not worn in and/or around the oral cavity.


