## Program

- This is the only Team leaders meeting
- Provisional time schedules are in the Sportity App
- Finale Time Schedule will be available 1 hour before the start of the competition in the Sportity App

## Timing

- Main Clock: on the scoreboard and the infield
- Next start time: Countdown on the scoreboard
- Start time first distance $=$ fixed time
- Start time next distances = 'not earlier than'

## Transponders \& Arm bands

- Transponders
- 500 meter: distributed directly at the start
- Other distances: pick up at top of the stairs on the infield (before each race)
- Return after each race
- Must be worn on both ankles
- Arm bands
- Bring your own arm band
- There is assistance at the start and some spare arm bands
- Each skater is responsible for wearing the correct color arm band on their right arm



## Drawing

- On the first 3 distances all 5 year groups will be joined together for drawings (women, men 30-50 men 55-60 \& men 65+ separately)
- All competitors will be admitted to the last distance
- The final distance drawing, classification and final ranking will be done in separate 5 years age groups independent of the number of participants per age group



## Groupings

- On the first two distances of the Masters' International Allround Games, the skaters will be seeded in groups of 6 skaters for the draw, according to
- their best times of the current season
- their best times of last season
- or their personal best times (and in that order)
- All groupings are available in the Sportity App
