FINAL INSTRUCTION 1

Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry to the Carrick on Suir Willie Loughman Forestry Rally 2024.
The seeded entry list is available on the Sportity App.

We extend our gratitude to our sponsors and Rally HQ - Rhu Glenn Hotel, Suirway, Kilsheelan Lime Quarries and Suir Shipping. We thank Coillte for the use of the woods.

The event will be promoting the Motorsport Ireland "Keep Race in its Place" initiative for the weekend and we ask that everyone respect the rules of the road and protect the sport.

GARDA SPEED CHECKS WILL BE ENFORCED THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND.

1. Sportity App:

The organisers are using the Sportity App to assist competitors to easily access all documentation relating to the rally including Regulations, Final Instructions, Start Lists, Competitor Bulletins etc.

You will receive a push notification on your phone when any new information is published.

2. Entries / Documentation:

Please note that IRDS/BRDS insurance will only apply for the Rally Route and the Parc Ferme Route as detailed in the event road book.

3. Parking of service vehicle and trailers

Parking of trailers and competitor vehicles is strictly forbidden around Rhu Glen Hotel, Rally HQ on Saturday and Sunday. As the Hotel have other functions with limited parking, they have asked that the competitors find alternative parking during the event on Sunday. Competitors are asked to park their own cars in the trailer park.

Competition cars may be unloaded near the Scrutiny venue in compliance with no parking restrictions. A Trailer Park is provided across from scrutiny in Seed Technology, Belview Port, X91 D5DV.

Please do not park trailers or service vehicles along the road in front of the HQ.
Please do not carry out any servicing in this area.

NO EXCEPTIONS. We thank you for your co-operation.

4. Trailer Park:

A Trailer Park is provided at Seed Technology Limited, Eircode: X91 F5DV
Unloading of competition cars may take place near the Scrutiny venue in the Trailer Park area.

5. Scrutineering:

Mechanical Scrutineering will commence at an earlier time of **13:00 hrs** at Suir Shipping, Belview Port, X91 R3NF. ****PLEASE NOTE AMENDED START TIME.

SCRUTINY WILL FINISH AT 6PM SHARP.

Due to the large entry and club commitments we ask you all to please arrive early to assist with this time schedule. Scrutineers have reported that in recent event, very few competitors arrive during the first two hours and then a queue has to be managed near finishing time.

Trackers, Competition Numbers and Drivers IRDS will be available at the scrutiny venue from 12.45 pm.

Unloading of rally cars may take place near the Scrutiny venue provided you comply with no parking restrictions.

Please present cars ready for scrutineering in accordance with Appendices 2, 25, 29 & 29.1 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2024, with decals attached, the scrutiny sheet signed by the driver and all other relevant documentation provided as per previous bulletin. **The Safety Tracker System must be fitted prior to Scrutineering.**

A secure pre-event Parc Fermé will be located at Rally HQ.

Competition cars must be placed in Parc Fermé no later than 20 mins following completion of mechanical scrutineering. **Paper Scrutiny should be done promptly as the rally office is closing at 18:30pm sharp.**

Ensure that you sign on for IRDS at Scrutiny before you bring the competition car on to the public road.

The driving of competing cars outside of the specified route as laid out in the road book may lead to exclusion.

Only the named driver is covered by IRDS at any time and only while travelling on the rally route, as specified in the road book. IRDS insurance does not extend to service crews.

6. Safety Tracking System:

A Safety Tracking System will operate on the rally. Collection, installation and operation of the system is advised in a separate Information bulletin. The Safety Tracking System must be fitted to the car before Scrutineering.

7. Rally Start:

Each crew member **MUST** attend the Competitors Safety Briefing at 7:15 am on Sunday 14th of April at Rally HQ. This applies to junior entrants also.

8. Time Cards:

PLEASE NOTE: Time Cards will be handed out at the Drivers Briefing once full crew attendance is confirmed. Please ensure that you bring your competition licence for identification purposes.

All competitors must be in place to enable the Briefing to start at 7.30 am. Non-attendance at drivers briefing may lead to exclusion, with the entry fee being non-refundable. A random roll call will take place to ensure attendance throughout the briefing.
The rally will start from Control A at HQ (Parc Fermé Out).

9. Juniors:

Competitors in class 21 will compete on all stages. These competitors – both driver and navigator must attend **Driver's Briefing at 7:15am** in rally HQ.

10. Service:

Service Stickers will be supplied in the Competitor's Pack at Documentation Scrutiny. The Service Area is located at Suir Shipping, Belview Port. Eircode X91 R3NF
The Service Area will open on Saturday 13th from 12pm to 6 pm and on Sunday 14th from 6.30am.

Parking for Competitor's road cars will be provided in Seed Technology Limited, adjacent to the Service Area on Sunday 14th April.

Access to the Service Area will be from 6am Sunday and is restricted to authorised service vehicles and competition cars only. Where multiple cars are being serviced from the one service vehicle, it is advisable to contact the Service Area Manager, Derek Butler (+353 86 8720675) to arrange your location. One service sticker will be issued to each competition car to allow access to service. This sticker must be physically stuck on the vehicle.

Please Note: **A 5m x 4m ground sheet** must be used for servicing and any oil spills must be cleaned up promptly. All waste must be disposed of in bins provided. Please familiarise yourself with the fire requirements for the Service Area as per Appendix 25, Article 2.10.2 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

Smoking is not permitted within the Service Area.

Please exercise caution when refuelling or performing any works that involve heat generation while servicing. Refer to the Event Regulations, Article 9 Servicing.
All service crews are requested to have fire extinguishers clearly disabled.

11. Rally Finish:

The finish of the rally will be Control E at Parc Fermé In, located at the Rhu Glen.

Competitors must proceed directly to Parc Fermé as directed by marshals and remain there for 30 minutes as per Article 3.9 of Appendix 25 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

Provisional Results will be posted on the Official Notice Board and on the Sportity App.
