## For the first time the Burnside Piling Scottish Tarmac Rally Championship heads to Dunoon presents .... Argyll Rally

The Scottish Tarmac Rally Championship organisers are delighted that Mull Car Club have welcomed their unique Championship to be part of this great event. This is the first year that this event has featured in the Championship and a new award has also been initiated in honour of the event's inclusion, the **West Coast Challenge** which will be awarded to highest placed driver & co-driver upon successful completion of the 3 'West Coast Events', the **Argyll Stages**, the **Mach1 Stages** at Machrihanish and the **Mull Rally**

The Scottish Tarmac Rally Championship has been running successfully for over 25 years. Its unique class-based scoring system gives drivers and co-drivers from each class the opportunity to become the overall champion. This year the Championship features 10 rounds, a mix of single venue and closed road rallies.

The Championship organising team were delighted to welcome back again main Championship sponsor, Burnside Piling Contractors and thank them, and the championship sub-sponsors for their support, without whom this popular championship wouldn't be possible.

The STRC are delighted that once again Carnegie Fuels will be supporting registered competitors throughout the 2024 season. This proved very popular & welcomed during the 2022/2023 season, and again this year there will be a draw at all counting rounds of the STRC to include ALL fully registered championship competitors (drivers & co-drivers) who start these events, and the winner will be presented with a £250 Tyre Voucher which can be redeemed in exchange for goods at either Wheels Around or AW Motorsport.

Although the 2023 Champions, Des Campbell and Cameron Dunn aren't competing at this event many of the competitors at the top of the 2024 Championship leader board are, including drivers Barry Groundwater, Simon Jennings and Steven Smith and co-drivers Greg Bates, Daniel Johnstone and Rachel Matheson.
