(Round 5) 21st/22nd June 2024 Dunoon Presents Argyll Rally

Round 5 takes the Championship to the West Coast for the Dunoon Presents Argyll Rally <http://argyllrally.co.uk/> on the 21st/22nd June. This is the first year that this event has featured in the Championship and a new award has also been initiated in honour of the event's inclusion, the **West Coast Challenge** which will be awarded to highest placed driver & co-driver upon successful completion of the 3 'West Coast Events', the **Argyll Stages**, the **Mach1 Stages** at Machrihanish and the **Mull Rally**

(Round 6) 6th/7th July Burnside Piling Mach1 Stages, Machrihanish

Round 6, and the 2nd of the West Coast Challenge events, is the Mach1 Stages being organised by www.dunfermlinecarclub.co.uk Preparation is well under way for this popular event at this iconic venue, Supplementary Regulations published, [Mach1 2024 Regulations v4](https://www.rallies.info/webentry/2024/mach1/webentry.php) entries open <https://www.rallies.info/webentry/2024/mach1/webentry.php>.

The Juniors again this year, will also be enjoying approximately 90 stage miles for £395 over the 2 days of the weekend the 6th/7th July. This event is also a counter in the Scottish Single Venue Rally Championship, the Back to Roots Rally Championship and the North of England Tarmacadam Rally Championship.

A wee gap in the STRC calendar till Round 7 takes us to Central Scotland for the Memorial Garden Stages at Condor on the 21st September, followed by Round 8 the Beatsons Mull Rally, then to Fife again for Round 9, the Kingdom Stages at Crail, with the final round at Kinloss for the Winter Stages on the 16th November.
