DECISION 2

From: The Stewards

Date: 9/21/2025

To: Car 199

The Stewards, having received a report from the CRO that 2 members of the service crew of car 199 did not follow official's instructions and drove into the service area that was closed to all traffic except competition cars. The stewards have reviewed the matter and determined the following:

Driver and car No: Car #199 T. Pastrana and R. Gelsomino.

Time (fact): 5/20/2025 2100 (approximately)

Fact: Service crew of car 199 approached the entry to service approximately 45 minutes after the service area was closed to all traffic except for competition cars. Officials informed them of this and directed them to park in the same area where other late service crews had been sent. The service crew refused to comply and drove past the marshals into their service area. The CRO discussed the situation with the team manager. All other teams complied with these instructions.

Offence: RCR 4.1.7 Marshal Instructions

Decision: The team has received a verbal reprimand, a \$1,000 fine, and a suspended sentence of unsportsmanlike conduct.

Reason: This was the only crew that disobeyed marshal instructions. The CRO had a conversation with the team manager before reporting this to the CoC and Stewards. GCR 5.10 and 5.14 describe the responsibilities and conduct of the service crews and are compelled to comply with RCR 4.1.7. This violation is punishable under GCR 6.2.3.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 9 of the ARA General Competition Rules.
