THE SPRING CUP 2023 ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

With this short Handbook the Organizing Committee of SPRING CUP would give all Teams the first information about the competition.

ENTRANCE TO PALASESTO ARENA and BUS PARKING:

Teams Entrance in the Palasesto is on left side of the Arena (Via Gramsci)
Buses are requested to stop in the reserved area on the left side of the Arena.

PASS for ENTRANCE in the ARENA:

During all Competition, Accreditation Cards given to different categories of people have to be worn and shown in a visible way in order to allow OC Personnel to authorize passages in the different areas of the Arena.

Accreditation Cards are nominative and strictly personal and must be shown to the staff on request. Any violation will be report to the organizing committee.

DURING THE OFFICIAL PRACTICES and during COMPETITION all Teams will get to the upper level and enter the arena-ice-rink through the adjacent corridor #10.

AFTER OFFICIAL PRACTICES and COMPETITION SHORT PROGRAM/FREE SKATING, Teams will exit the arena-ice-rink and reach their dressing room at the lower level through the adjacent corridor #7.

To watch the competition, all **Teams** <u>Teams will no longer have to use the passageways adjacent</u> <u>to the exits of locker rooms #7 & #10</u> to go from the lower level to the upper level.



TIME REFERENCE:

During Official Practice and the Event, the time will be indicated by the clock in the Ice Rink.

DRAW:

The **Official Draw** for Senior and Junior will take place on **Friday 17th at 18,30** at the GRAND HOTEL BARONE DEI SASSI – VALADIER ROOM. Only Team Leaders, Team Managers, Coaches and 5



skaters for each Team are allowed to attend the draw

There will not be any intermediate draw. The Starting Order of the Free Skating will follow the reverse order of places in the Short program, according to the Rule 963 par. 2f.

OPENING CEREMONY:

The **Opening Ceremony** will take Place on Saturday 18th at 14:00 at the ice rink <u>without the participation of teams.</u>

AWARD CEREMONY:

Award Ceremony for Junior and Senior will be held.

SUNDAY 19th, 2023 @ 19:20, the whole team is requested on the ice.

The skaters must be ready at the lower level of the ice rink (warming up area) before the end of the competition in order to speed up the preparation of the ceremony.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE:

DURATION of THE OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Official Practice for the Short Program will last for 10 minutes and for the Free Skating Program 12 minutes', starting from the moment the team starts to enter the ice. The Team must leave the ice immediately after the announce to do so. The exit of the Team and the entrance of the following Team will be at the same time.

MUSIC DURING OFFICIAL PRACTICE

The competition music will be played twice, both time without interruptions.

SHORT PROGRAM OFFICIAL PRACTICE:

10 minutes: Music can be played twice without interruption.

Music can not be restarted. Music will be played, the first time, no later than 2 minutes after the start of the practice, and, the second time, no later than six minutes after the start of the practice.



FREE SKATING OFFICIAL PRACTICE:

12 minutes: Music can be played twice without interruption. Music cannot be restarted. Music will be played, the first time, no later than 2 minutes after the start of the practice and, the second time, no later than seven minutes after the start of the practice

PROCEDURE FOR THE WARM-UP AND CALL TO START:

The first team to skate in the competition, or after an ice resurfacing, will get a minimum of one minute of warm-up. Referees must ensure that each team has a minimum of one minute of Warm-up and one minute before the Call to Start.

After the previous team is off the ice, the Referee's Assistant at Ice level can put the next team in to the Ice Rink for Warm-up period, of no less than one minute, during which the marks of the previous team are finalized and announced.

As per Rule 838 par.4:

Each Team must take the starting position and make a signal to the Referee of each Segment of the competition (Short Program and Free Skating) at the latest thirty (30) seconds after their name has been announced. If this time has expired and the Team has not yet taken the starting position, the Referee shall apply a deduction (deducted from the final score) as per Rule 843, paragraph 1. n). If sixty (60) seconds started from the call to the start have expired and the Team has not yet taken the starting position, they will be considered as withdrawn.

WARM-UP AREAS:

4 WARM-UP Areas will be provided by OC at Palasesto Ice Rink in the days of competition. The Warm-up areas are marked and Warm-Up time will follow the detailed schedule.

ALTERNATES & COACHES @ ICE RINK

When a Team enters the ice, ONLY one (1) coach and ONLY one (1) alternate without blade guards are allowed to stand near the Referee's Assistant at the Ice Level during the execution of the program. Both must stay in the space reserved for them (marked on the ground) during the whole stay of the team on the ice.

During the program, the second coach, if any, team leader and other alternates will stand in the kiss and cry area located at the right hand of the Judges' side of the Rink Exit.

MUSIC

Music must be sent by email by 31/01/2023 to media@springcup.it At the time of accreditation, a copy on USB support must be delivered. This will be returned at the end of the competition.
