4.6. Refunds

The entry fee will be refunded in full if the registration is not retained.

Refund in case of whitdraw of the entry:

A written declaration of the whitdraw of the team must be sent by email to the organiser entry@omloopvanvlaanderen.be

This declaration should contain the following:

- · The reason for withdraw
- All necessary data for reimbursement.

A receipt will be sent to one of the team members as confirmation.

If the whitdraw is submitted before 15/08/2025 at 23:59, a full refund of the total entry fee will be made within a maximum of 90 days after the end of the rally.

If the team's withdraw declaration is submitted after 15/08/2025 at 23:59, there is a refund of 50% of the entry fee by the organiser and this within a maximum period of 90 days after the end of the rally.

Refund of the entry fee in case of cancellation of the competition due to force majeure:

The organiser will refund 90% of the entry fee and retain an amount of 10% as administrative costs.

5. Insurance

Contract no. 730.261.439 AXA Belgium. Applicable for the rally.

The organisers have taken out a Civil Liability Motor Vehicle Insurance - according to Art 21 of SR BRC 2025 chapter 2/2 of the National Sporting Code and the law of 21 November 1989 - Art 8, covering damage to third parties by the nominal competitors and teams listed (on the official list of competitors) and this only during the shakedown, and participation within the time schedule on the rally course, from the start of the first competition element until the end of the rally or at the moment of permanent abandonment or exclusion.

5.1. Civil liability " Car "

Warranties:

- bodily injury : unlimited per claim
- material damage : €100,000,000 per claim (indexed)

All cars participating in the rally must have insurance valid for public roads. A valid green card (International Motor Insurance Card / Carte.

Internationale d 'Assurance Automobile) or other certificate proving that the insurance policy to which this certificate relates meets the requirements of the relevant legislation applicable in Belgium and France and serves as proof that the car is validly insured. This document must be presented during the administrative control.

Connection routes are not covered by the organiser's BA insurance contracts.

"Service", "Auxiliary" and reconnaissance vehicles, even if they, carry the special rally plates, issued by the organiser, are not covered by the organiser's civil liability insurance policy



5.2. Civil Liability "Organiser"

The organisers have taken out Civil Liability Insurance "furnisher" for damages to third parties caused by an accident during the preparation, conduct and material conclusion of the event and attributable to organisational error.

Limits of cover

 physical, material and immaterial immaterial consequential damages mixed : 5.000.000 € per claim.

exemption : 125 € per material damage claim

Legal aid : 15.000 € per claim

Insured Persons:

Organiser, RACB, Official, National Sports Commission, Members of the Red Cross or similar Organisation, Members of Civil Protection, Participants, Marshals, the drivers of the Intervention cars, and in general, any person participating in the organisation of the rally.

5.3. Civil Liability "Volunteers"

Civil liability of the organisers for damage caused to third parties by volunteers he calls upon, during their activities as volunteers.

bodily injury : 12,394,676.24€ per claim (indexed)
 material damage : 619,733.81€ per claim (indexed)

5.4. Conduct in an accident (National highway code)

In the event of an accident involving only material damage, pilots are **obliged** to make a verbal report to the next time control and a written report with a detailed report before the end of the "Stage" to the course director (reporting officer). Failure to make a declaration will be penalised by a €500 fine. In case of an accident with physical damage, the riders must immediately inform the competent police services and the Rally Control at the Rally HQ at the telephone number indicated on the back of the time sheets. (Art. 53.3.8)

In case of an accident in which a spectator, or any other person, suffers bodily harm, the (co)pilots must remain at the scene and stop the next car to let them report this to the next radio post, as mentioned in the road book and indicated along the route. (Art. 53.4)

The law of the country, where the race takes place, should be applied in relation to procedures to be followed in case of an accident. Under Belgian law, hit-and-run is a correctional

criminal offence. All competitors stopped in such procedure will be awarded an appropriate time in accordance with Art 52 SR BRC 2025.

Safety regulations in case of accident by a participant will be included in the road book.



5.5. Recovery of the car

For safety reasons, the Organisation may decide to transport a car that did not complete the special stage in order to no longer hinder the course of the trial.

5.6. Waiver of recourse

The organiser disclaims all liability related to the consequences of violations, committed by pilots or competitors, of the laws, regulations and decrees applicable to the crossed lands. The consequences will be borne by the offenders themselves.

The organiser also refuses all responsibility in the event of natural disasters, demonstrations, riots, attacks, sabotage and terrorism etc. of which the competitors, pilots, team members or vehicle occupants could be victims and the consequences of which (material, criminal and sporting) will have to be borne by themselves.

Sticker under the competition number : 67x17cm : publicity of the BRC 2025 Top of windscreen, size : 12.5cm wide: publicity of the BRC 2025 Top rear window, full width, dimension: 8cm publicity of the BRC 2025

The organiser will provide each crew with the competition numbers (67x17cm), which must be affixed to their car in the specified places prior to the technical inspection. Each panel must be placed horizontally at the front of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the panel should be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. **The panel should not be cut.**

6.2. Optional publicity of the organiser

Additional publicity from the organiser:

6.3. Identification

Race numbers and rally plates according to SR RACB Art. 27 and 29 will be issued by the Organiser.

Numbers and plates must be affixed to the rally car before the car is brought to the technical control and must remain visible during the course of the rally.

Deviations from the regulations on rally plates and identification numbers will be penalised as follows:

• one missing rally plate or competition number : fine of 100 €

rally plates or competition numbers missing at the same time : disqualification
 rally plate invisible or number plate partially covered : fine of 100 €

• Absence of optional publicity by the Founder : payment of the entry fee without publicity

6.3.1 Team service cars

Service / Auxiliary pass certificates (stickers) and other pass certificates (identification stickers) must be affixed <u>in upper left corner</u> of the windscreen.



7. Tyres

7.1. Regulations for the use of tyres during the rally

See Art. 13 RS BRC.

Cars of the classes RC2-RC3-RC4-RC5 must compulsorily use MICHELIN tyres from the distributor appointed by RACB Sport.

7.2. Tyres for use during the explorations

Only commercial tyres approved for road (asphalt) use are allowed.

7.3 Amount of Tyres

The maximum number of tyres permitted for this rally (in accordance with Article 13.1.5 of SR BRC):

• For the cars of classes RC1, RC2, RGT, RC3:

14 tyres

• for the vehicles with homologation RC4 to RC5 :

10 tyres

- The first 5 rain tyres must be declared, but they do not count towards the quota.
- Tyres, used during the shakedown are not included in the number of maximum tyres allowed for the rally.

Article 19.4 of the RS BRC 2025 regulations - tyre control card "tyrecard" will apply to all cars involved. Tyre cards will be distributed at the technical inspection.

The list of eligible asphalt tyres is available on the FIA website.

8. Fuel

8.1. Types fuel

All competitors must use fuel in accordance with Art 62.1 du RS BRC as approved by the suppliers of the Belgian Rally Championship 2025.

9.1.1 Procedure of registration

The registration form for the recce will be available together at the DSO. This form, fully completed, must be submitted by 03/09/2025 at the latest via registration tool, or during the distribution of Road book.

When a participant's recce car needs to be replaced for any reasons, the participant must inform the race director of it and provide details of the replacement car. The recce sticker must be placed on the replacement car.



9.2. Special rules

During reconnaissance, all national traffic rules must be followed, including but not limited to speed limits. Please note that special stages are not closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organiser may separately reduce the permitted speed by marking areas in the Roadbook and along the route.

Excessive speed during recce will result in a time penalty imposed by the Clerk of course according to Art. 34.2 RS BRC.

9.2.1 Passages

All crews are allowed a maximum of 3 reconnaissance passes over each Special Stage, and this in accordance with the reconnaissance program given in see Appendix 2. All reconnaissance of the rally route must be driven in the same direction as the rally, at a moderate speed and in strict compliance with the Highway Code. Special stages that are driven several times are considered as one stage during reconnaissance.

Teams are only allowed in and out of the special stages via start and finish checks. Furthermore, random checks may also be held on the special stages themselves.

11.2. Safety equipment of the pilots

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) meant to be used, e.g. HANS devices must be presented for technical inspection. They must be checked for compliance with Annex L, Chapter III.

11.3. Noise level

For all cars, the maximum noise level is 95 dB on the connecting sections. Cars not complying with this rule will not be allowed to start. Noise is measured with a sonometer regulated "A" and " SLOW", at an angle of 45 degrees and 50 cm from the exhaust, at a speed of 3 500 rpm.

11.4. Special national requirements

- Belgian-registered cars need an A.K. certificate (Automobiel Keuring/Contrôle Technique);
- Every car must be equipped with a red reflective triangle, safety vests and a first aid kit in accordance with EU traffic regulations;
- There must be two belt cutters on board at all times, easily accessible to the pilot and copilot with the safety belts fastened.

11.5. Installation of safety tracking system (STS)

11.5.1 Retrieve

All cars must be equipped with a Safety Tracking System Geodynamics supplied by the organiser. The STS devices will be handed out during the Technical Zone in front of the podium, against credit card deposit, refunded on timely and undamaged return. The procedure and technical supplies will be explained in an additive. Competitors whose equipment has not been properly installed must put it in order before the start of the rally.

Any damage, loss or in case of theft, remains under the full responsibility of the team, even in case of abandonment or disqualification or any other course event.

11.5.2 Return

The organiser will dismantle the complete STS device in the Parc Fermé End of Rally.

In case of an earlier abandonment, the competitor can return the STS device to the Rally HQ J&B Motorsport, Zwaaikomstraat 1 8800 Roeselare during opening hours the HQ.

12. Other procedures and regulations

12.1. Start procedure and order

There is no ceremonial start.

The start of the rally will take place on 05/09/2025 at 17h30, from TC0A Startpark Out - Technical & Mediazone In, located J&B Motorsport Zwaaikomstraat 1 8800 Roeselare (see Roadbook).

Starting order and intervals throughout the event will be in accordance with Art 41.5 SR BRC. The time interval is 1 minute for all participants.

The start times will be published on 05/09/2025 at 17h00 on ONB and DNB.



12.1.1 Start Zone

The Start Park is considered the Media Zone. Service is not allowed in the Start Zone.

12.2. Arrival procedure

During the TC Parc of Fame In, all crews will be under the Parc Fermé regime and will have to follow the instructions of the officials on site to get to the Finish Podium. This area will only be accessible to officials with the correct pass.

After the Finish Podium ceremony, cars will make their way - according to the roadbook - to the waiting area of the Parc Fermé under the supervision of the Organiser.

Selected rally cars are escorted to the final control and/or proceed to the final Parc Fermé. The Parc Fermé regime will be controlled by the Organisers.

12.4. Special procedures and activities

12.4.1 Crew contact details

Competitors who park their vehicles in the Parc fermé after crossing the finish line must remain available by telephone (mobile) until the final standings are published.

12.4.2 Classification

The final classification will not be handed out after the rally. The final standings will be published on the DNB of the website.

12.4.3 Safety of competitors

All competitors are invited to pay special attention to Art. 53 SR BRC.

12.4.4 Crew contact details

At the administrative control, all teams will have to provide a mobile phone number. This phone will be on board the rally car at all times throughout the course of the race and will also remain connected and connected within 30 seconds of the car stopping on a special stage. This rule is part of the team safety procedures in the Trial Safety Plan.

A TEAM (service) mobile number must also be provided

12.4.5 Other points

Ouvreurs / gravel crew / route note cars (RNC)

Access to the special stages will be allowed under the following conditions:

- The organisation reserves the right to restrict access.
- The ouvreur document must be completed via the entry tool by Wednesday 03 Septembber 2025 at 3pm.



- The crew must hold an RACB licence and an identity card to collect the necessary documents and tracking.
- Only two people will be allowed in the car (listed on the registration)
- · Only one ouvreur per team will be accepted/admitted
- The team will be provided with a door number sticker RNC issued by the organisation
- The team may only start the stage from the start and only ride once per section
- · Access to the stage is limited to 60 min before the first competition car.
- Entry to the test session on Wednesday 03 September 2025 is STRONGLY PROHIBITED
- The crew must respect the Highway Code, including during the special stages
- The race director may suspend access at any time
- · Long stops on the stage or at the stop are prohibited
- The competitor is responsible for his ouvreur. First note is a fine of 200 euros.
- The door number sticker ouvreur gives access to the service park.
- Any behaviour contrary to and/or detrimental to the smooth running of the event caused by an ouvreur may be submitted to the RACB Sports Court under the responsibility of the competitor using this registered ouveur.
- All cars must be equipped with a Safety Tracking System GeoDynamics supplied by the organiser. These should be collected at Rally HQ J&B Motorsport on Friday 05 September 2025 between 2pm and 4pm. This must be delivered to Rally HQ J&B Motorsport no later than 21h00 on Saturday 06 September 2025 otherwise additional costs will be charged to the team.
- If the registered vehicle has to be replaced, this must be notified immediately to the organisers with the details of the other vehicle used. The tracking system should then be transferred to the other vehicle.

Pack ouvreur costs €250 and includes:

- · Door stickers for the registered vehicle
- A road book and general map
- · A pass to park at the service park

Warming up of tyres and brakes

To ensure the safety of the public, it is forbidden during the connection to a special stage and the shakedown/test drive, to warm up tyres or brakes. It is also forbidden, on public access roads, to proceed to a start with an irresponsible driving style (zigzagging, ea.).

There are Tyre Warming Zones (TWZ) provided for each special stage (except kp Zoning) and shakedown/ test drive (art.44.4 RACB Sporting Regulations).

Any infringement will be reported to the Commissioners immediately.

RACB 48.2.1 SS Zoning, Houthulst and Rumbeke are with a flying start where the team must follow the instructions of the starter.

RACB 54.1.1 Restart is only possible in the following time control TC3E, TC5D, TC10E, TC15E

RACB 55.1. Each car who wants to restart the next section must present his car for approval to the scrutineers at the following time control: Tc Service Out – Technical & Media zone In

Speed

"Fact judges" (ISC Art 11.16) will be appointed to check compliance with all regulations relating to the Service Rules and Service Parks. Special attention will be given to compliance with the speed limit (30 km/h) in the Service Park and 5 km/h in the Fuel Supply Zone. (Art. 61.2).

Any infringement will be reported to the sports commissioners.



Service Park

Place of service Zwaaikomstraat 8800 Roeselare

Reservation of the service place is only possible via the website before 27/08/2025 at 23h59.

All teams must have a 6 kg fire extinguisher visibly available at their service place during the entire scheduled service time of the car. It does not have to be displayed during the technical inspection. Checks will be made at the service areas themselves via spot checks.

The use of a ground sheet is compulsory.

No fuel of any kind may be stored in the service park Slypskapelle for the shakedown/ test drive and in the service park Zwaaikomstraat and surrounding streets, in service cars and/or assistance vehicles. Confiscation of fuel will be accompanied by a €500 fine imposed by the race director. It is absolutely forbidden for a car carrying fuel to access and/or drive in the service park. Only a maximum quantity of 20L of fuel necessary to fill the reservoirs for the equipment (generator, heating, etc) will be allowed.

On-board cameras

- If requested by the Founder, a participant must accept an on-board camera or other recording device on board. This will be installed by the Founder and inspected by the technical delegates.
- The competitor of any car installing an on-board camera must obtain prior authorisation from the Founder. Authorised cameras will be identified by a sticker and must be fitted in the car before the technical inspection.

Images and/or data cards from on-board cameras may be exchanged in the service cars, with the approval of the course director.

Media zones

An enclosed media zone will be set up in front of the Service Park. Access to these media zones will be restricted to those with appropriate transit passes.

Collection of cars from closed car park end of rally.

After permission from the Sports Commissioners to open the "Closed Car Park End Rally ", cars may be collected, subject to release as scheduled and all cars must be removed by 06/09/2025 at 23:59.



Each competitor is obliged to affix the stickers below to the car. These stickers will be delivered at the distribution of material and are part of the compulsory publicity of this competition (Art. 27 RS BRC).





General rules

Article 57 of the Sporting Regulations Rally of the Belgian Championship is strictly applied.

Location

Service Park: Zwaaikomstraat 8800 Roeselare

Trailer car park: Parking Olivier Construct, Lodewijk de Raetlaan 24, Izegem

Parking Auxillary: Bleijko Beurtkaai 4, 8800 Roeselare

Times

Construction service park: Thursday 04/09/2025 from 6pm.

Opening service park : Thursday 04/09/2025 from 18h00 onwards.

Clearance Service Park : No later than Saturday 06/09/2025 23h59.

All movement of assistance vehicles is prohibited during the passage of participants. In any case, in case of abandonment or disqualification, the assistance vehicles of the reported team may leave the park after permission from the person in charge of the service park. In any case, they may not hinder any participant still in race.

Reservation of places in the service park

These applications can only be made via the organisation's website --> registration tool by 27/08/2025 at 23:59.

Dimensions

Each participant is entitled to 8 metres of frontage.

If a team provides assistance for several cars, they will each receive 5 metres extra per vehicle. (ie: 13 for 2 cars, 18 metres for 3 cars, ...).

Location

The organiser will limit and number the assistance places.
