


This event will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) including appendices, the General Prescriptions applicable for all FIA Championships, FIA CEZ Regulations as well as the MNASZ General Sporting Regulations and Provisions, the MNASZ Cross-Country Rally Regulations, and the present Supplementary Regulations, the WADA/NADA Codes, and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations of the countries the event passes shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

The entry fee includes:

- Additional compulsory liability insurance
- Identification and Advertising decals
- 1 pc. Basic service plate
- Basic service area per vehicle (50m²)

4.4.2. To be paid on site!:

Rent of GPS navigation and safety tracking system 140 €

Deposit for GPS navigation and safety tracking system: 300 €

Service park **environmental deposit:** 100 €

Extreme Insurance: 5€ / Day / Competitor

To maintain the cleanliness of the service park, the organizer is entitled to have the marshals inspect the service areas of the competitors.

Upon leaving the service park, competitors are required to remove any waste generated in their service area and restore it to its original condition.

To ensure compliance with this rule, each registered crew must pay a **deposit of HUF 40,000 (100€)** at the administrative checks. This amount will be refunded at the end of the competition or after the competitor's withdrawal, after the designated marshal inspects the service area, finds it in order, and issues a receipt to the area's responsible person. The deposit will be reimbursed upon submission of this receipt to the rally office during its opening hours.

After this period, the deposit cannot be refunded. If multiple crews share a service area, multiple receipts will be issued accordingly.

To preserve the condition of the area, it is mandatory to place an oil- and waterproof tarp of at least 5 x 3 meters under each race car at the service and repair locations.

Teams with more vehicles wanting to enter to the service parc, must purchase an additional 50m² service area. For a Service area up to 50m², max 2 entry permission (service plate) can be purchased!

Extra service areas requested and the number of extra service plates has to be indicated on the Entry Form

4.4.3. Other Fees

- additional permission to the service parc (service plate):	30 €
- Additional service area (50m ²):	60 €
- Trailers, Motorhomes, Promotion Vehicles:	60 €
- Waterproof Road Book	80 €

The Entry Form will be accepted only with the proof of payment of the entry fee. Entries after the entry deadline are considered "On-site entries" by the organizer! (150%)

4.4.4. Individual accident insurance- Extreme Insurance

All competitors are obliged to have Extreme Insurance cover! To be paid at the Administrative Check!

With signing the Entry Form, competitors agree, the GPS system operators to give their data to the organizer, event's officials.

Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry application is rejected

The organiser may partially refund entry fees, if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure and stated in a written notification of this at least 72 hours before the event at julianna@garzoneraiding.com.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

MNASZ insurance information 2025.

Additional compulsory liability insurance is included in the Entry Fee.

Extreme Insurance to be payed on the spot- mandatory for each competitor! (5€/day/competitor)

For extreme insurance, we ask all competitors to bring their international insurance card.

Service vehicles are not considered official participants of the competition, even if they carry the "service" plate issued by the organizer. The mandatory competition liability insurance does not apply to them, and all liability rests solely with the vehicle's operator and driver.

The organizer assumes no liability for any incidents involving the participants. Competitor crews take part in the competition at their own risk; however, the organizer provides them with extreme insurance coverage.

Art. 6. Advertising and Identification

Art. 6.1 Obligatory organiser’s advertising

Art. 6.2 Optional organiser’s advertising

The organiser will provide each crew with the number identification and advertising stickers, which must be affixed to their competing vehicle prior to scrutineering, on the stated positions indicated in the Supplementary Regulation. The placement of the Optional advertising stickers is only accepted as indicated! Any other placement of them will not be accepted at the Technical Scrutineering, until it is placed on the required spot or have been payed the “Without optional advertising the Entry Fee: +60%”.

Art. 7. Tyres

Art. 8. Fuel

Only commercially available fuel can be used, without adding any additives.

Art. 9. Administrative checks

At the administrative both members- driver or the co-driver must be present.

Art. 10.2 Requirements at technical scrutineering:

- Vehicles must be presented with all start numbers, rally plates, and advertisements fixed properly on the designated place.
- GPS navigation and safety tracking system installed and operable
- Scrutineering Sheet- provided at the administrative check - filled up
- Homologation Form, valid Technical Passport
- All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented
- Technically corresponding and approved size fire extinguisher properly fitted in the car
- Warning triangle, medical kit. The new medical kit...etc. is not mandatory (Art.CCRSR APPIII. 1. Medical kit, 2. Survival kit)
- OK / SOS board

Art. 10.3 Installation of the GPS Navigation and Safety Tracking System

All vehicles must **only** be fitted with the GPS Navigation and Safety Tracking System provided by the Organiser. You can rent them just before the Administrative check, returning the GPS Navigation and Safety Tracking System at the Parc Fermé, to the GPS crew, where the deposit will also be refunded after confirming that the equipment remains undamaged.

In the pre-start area before TC0, the GPS functionality will be checked, and competitors will receive their time card only if the system is working properly.

Guidelines for using the GPS tracking system can be found in Annex 6 of the Supplementary Regulations, in the Sportity App, and on the terep-rallye.hu website.

Art. 11.9 Electronic start procedure at the start of a Selective Section

The start of the selective section is happening based on an electric clock and lamp, connected to a false start alert system.

When the car arrives at the start line, the front of the car should be positioned behind a stick placed by the marshal to define the exact start position. One minute before the start time, but not before the car has stopped in its exact position, the marshal shall remove the stick and the crew shall refer to the automatic countdown clock. Any subsequent change of the car's position until its start time is not permitted and will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 11.10 Service

Using a min 5x4m protector groundsheet under the racing vehicles is mandatory. 1pc at least 4kg validated manual fire extinguisher is mandatory. Each service team has to ensure that after carrying out their activities on the site, they do not leave any pollutants. They will be checked by the scrutineers, and not complying will entail a 50.000HUF fine.

The Organizer calls the attention of the participants, that the Service Park is not guarded at night time!

Art. 11.10.1 Service Areas

Senior's Club, 9515 Pápoc, Vásár str.37

Entry will be permitted to the Servicepark only showing the Service Plates. Accompanying team cars can enter only by purchasing a 10.000HUF sticker at the Administrative Checks.

Art. 11.10.2 Service allowed in Selective Section, Tyre fitting zone

Art. 11.10.3 Fuel and Refuelling Zone

There is no petrol station along the whole track of the Riverside Baja 2025., refuelling can be done in the servicepark area with the engine turned off. Having a min.4kg fire extinguisher and a protector canvas underneath is mandatory!

Art. 11.11 Speed Control Zones

According to Roadbook

11.12 T4-NAT Technical Conditions Modification

Based on Decision No. 9/2025 (2025.03.14) of the Cross-Country Rally Committee, the technical conditions of the "Cross-Country Rally T4-NAT Group Championship" are modified as follows:

Appendix II, Section 2.1 of the 2025 Cross-Country Rally National Championship General Regulations: The vehicle must comply with the FIA technical regulations for the SSV – T4 group (Appendix J, Article 286A (2024)), with the following possible deviations:

A "reference" vehicle is any Side-by-Side vehicle produced in large quantities (minimum 250 units/year) and eligible for road registration in Hungary.

General Regulations, Article 6. Minimum Weight

6.1 For vehicles narrower than 1900 mm:

900 kg if the vehicle is equipped with a turbocharged engine

800 kg if the vehicle is equipped with a naturally aspirated engine

1100 kg if the vehicle is equipped with a naturally aspirated engine with a displacement greater than 1050 cm³

For vehicles wider than 1900 mm:

1250 kg

The complete original FIA homologation form, the FIA Passport and the vehicle's technical documentations must be available for final checks.

In addition to the Technical Protest Fee, the stewards may impose a dismantling deposit based on the recommendation of the technical steward. If the protest is unfounded, the assembly costs shall also be borne by the protester.

All protests and/or appeals must be lodged in accordance with Articles 13 and 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and, where applicable, with the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.

Appendix 1 – ITEMS AT THE ORGANISERS' DISCRETION

1. TIME CARD PROVIDING, EXCHANGES

Time cards will be issued before the Start of each Leg, which must be submitted to the marshalls at the Finish of each Leg. Time card exchanging: at regrouping.

2. LIMITED TIME DELAY

Maximum delay between two TC is 30 minutes per Leg. Delay exceeding this limit will result in disqualification.

3. FIXED PENALTY

On race days, competitors who incur a designated penalty may rejoin the race at the Regrouping until the scheduled time of the first vehicle indicated in the timecard.

On each race day, completing at least one selective stage is mandatory, and rejoining the race can only occur at the Regrouping.

4. PARC-FERMÉ RULES

Parc Fermé will only be set up at the end of the race.

Protecting canvas under the racing vehicle is **NOT mandatory!**

According to CCRSR 58.1, the regrouping area qualifies as Parc Fermé, therefore the Parc Fermé rules apply in the Regrouping.

5. MAXIMUM SPEED

The FIA maximum speed are monitored by the GPS system, exceeding them will be and punished by the Stewards.



STEP 1 – GET FAMILIAR WITH THE SYSTEM COMPONENTS




NOTE: If needed we can provide an additional extension cable to place the radio antenna on a better position.

- **IMPORTANT! NO CUTTING OF CABLES, MODIFICATION OF CONNECTORS OR OTHER INTERFERENCE IN THE SYSTEM COMPONENTS IS ALLOWED! ANY DAMAGE TO THE EQUIPMENT MUST BE PAID ACCORDING TO THE GEOTRAQ PARTS LIST!**


STEP 2 – PREPARE POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE CABLE FROM THE BATTERY TO THE DASH BOARD AND INSTALL INSULATED TERMINAL CONNECTORS (ONLY THOSE SUPPLIED BY THE ORGANISATION)

- **IMPORTANT! THE BATTERY MASTER CUT-OFF (KILL) SWITCH MUST NOT DISCONNECT THE POWER SUPPLY FOR THE RALLY SAFETY SYSTEM.**
- It is the responsibility of the competitors alone to provide, **DIRECT POWER SUPPLY** from the vehicle's battery according to the drawings provided.
- The power cables **MUST** be "flexible" (multi wire), insulated cables – 2 x **min 0.75** to 1.25 mm² (**WITH RED** for positive (+) wire and **BLACK** for negative (-) wire insulation color).
- The connection **MUST** have an **IN-LINE FUSE** - "BLADE TYPE" of 5A.


STEP 3 – MOUNTING THE SYSTEM - OVERVIEW

- You will receive two 6,3 mm female quick plug terminals for the power connection. **If you have old terminals, discard them and use the provided new ones!**

- **IMPORTANT! USE ONLY THE PROVIDED QUICK PLUG TERMINALS! DO NOT USE YOUR OWN!**
- **IMPORTANT! USE PROPER TOOLS TO CRIMP THEM!**




Following a change in the regulations, the 'Com-box' must be mounted in a central location as per indicated areas in blue, to enable both driver & co-driver to be able to reach the SOS button from their seat with seatbelts on. Shown are the mounting positions of the system components.

STEP 4 – MOUNT THE GPS TRACKER ON THE PROPER POSITION

- The best position is the “A-pillar” of the roll cage, or the horizontal member of the roll cage, with the tracker facing upwards.

- **IMPORTANT! THE GPS TRACKER MUST HAVE VISIBILITY TO THE SKY (NO METAL ON TOP OF THE DEVICE)**
- **IMPORTANT! INSTALLATION IS DONE WITH CABLE TIES THROUGH THE HOLES OF THE BASE OF THE DEVICE**
- **IMPORTANT! POSITION THE DEVICE IN SUCH A WAY THAT NO DIRECT DAMAGE CAN BE DONE!**



Installation of the GPS TRACKER on the roll cage “A-pillar” of a Car using cable ties.


STEP 5 – MOUNT THE COM-BOX MOUNTING BRACKET AND INSERT THE COM-BOX UNIT ON THE PROPER POSITION

- You can bolt the mounting bracket as shown in the graphics below, or you can use industrial grade velcro or double-sided tape to stick it to a good surface or use cable ties to fix it to a central location on the dashboard or to the overhead tube of the roll cage above the centre of the dashboard.
- If needed, additional opening can be drilled to fix it on the required position.





Installation of the Com-Box unit with bracket on the dashboard using bolts. **This must be in a CENTRAL location and not as indicated above, only in front of the co-driver.**

- When the mounting bracket is securely installed, you can slide-in the Com-Box unit in.
- When slided in you MUST lock the device in place by pushing the top locking mechanism.



IMPORTANT! THE ANTENNA NEEDS AT LEAST 55mm ON ALL SIDES TO WORK PROPERLY! MAKE SURE NOT TO PLACE IT RIGHT NEXT TO OTHER METAL COMPONENTS!

STEP 6 – CHECK THE STATUS OF THE RALLY SAFETY SYSTEM.

- First, make sure the antenna is connected (optional extension cable and antenna)
- Second, check the blue connectors (buzzer) are tight
- Third, check the connection of the black connectors between the GPS Tracker and the Com-Box unit
- Finally check the connection of the 2 power terminals (positive and negative)

IMPORTANT! WHEN CONNECTING THE POWER TERMINAL MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THE PROPER POLARITY – RED is POSITIVE, BLACK is NEGATIVE!

IMPORTANT! IF ALL THE COMPONENTS ARE CONNECTED PROPERLY, THE COM-BOX UNIT WILL DISPLAY A “GREEN STATUS” ON THE BATTERY ICON AND “BLUE/GREEN STATUS” on the RADIO ICON

STEP 7 – FINAL INSPECTION AT SCRUTINEERING

- Install the cables loosely using only a few cable ties and in such a way that they can be clearly checked at scrutineering.
- Only **after** you receive **APPROVAL** from the Scrutineer and/or the GPS Technician, you can fully fasten the cables onto the vehicle using cable ties. **DO NOT** overuse cable ties!
- **DO NOT** use insulating or any other tape to group the cables.

- **IMPORTANT! DO NOT PLACE THE CABLES FOR THE SYSTEM IN DIFFICULT OR HIDDEN PLACES (INSIDE THE DASHBOARD OR HARD TO REACH LOCATIONS). THE INSTALLATION WILL BE CHECKED TO ENSURE THE SYSTEM AND ADDITIONAL COMPONENTS ARE PROPERLY INSTALLED AND OPERATIONAL AT SCRUTINEERING AND IF REQUIRED, YOU WILL NEED TO REROUTE THE WIRING.**

STEP 9 – RETURNING THE SYSTEM

When it's time for you to return the system from your vehicle you **MUST** do this in the following order:

- First disconnect the negative (-) wire, then disconnect the positive (+) wire from the cable from your vehicle's battery at the female quick connect terminals.
- Second disconnect the COM-BOX - TRACKER cable
- Third disconnect the Buzzer – COM-BOX cable

• **IMPORTANT! WHEN YOU RETURN THE SYSTEM TO THE GPS DESK, YOUR EQUIPMENT WILL BE CHECKED FOR DAMAGE & DEFECTS AND IF FOUND – YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR THE DAMAGE TO THE EQUIPMENT ACCORDING TO THE GEOTRAQ PARTS LIST!**
