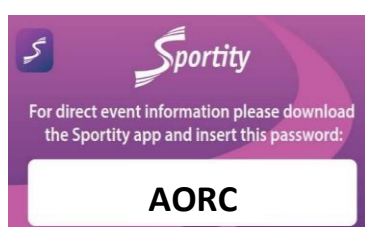

## ARTICLE 5

## EVENT DESCRIPTION

- A) The Event will be known as **Loveday 400** and will be a National Championship Long Course Off Road Event conducted at Loveday 4x4 Adventure Park, located 15km south of Barmera, in the State of South Australia on Friday 26th July to Sunday 28th July 2024.
- B) The Event will be Round 3 of the Motorsport Australia Off Road Championship, Round 3 of the SXS Motorsport Australia Championship and Round 2 of the SA Off Road Championship.
- C) The Event consist of four sections over two days. The Event will start on 27 July 2024 and will be approximately 400 km long. A prologue will be held on the 26 July 2024 that is approximately 7 km long
- D) The Motorsport Australia South Australian Off Road Championship will be the first 8 laps of the 40km course.

## ARTICLE 6

## EVENT ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the AORC Sporting Regulations, with the addition of;
- B) South Australian Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations

## ARTICLE 7

## VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the AORC Sporting Regulations,
- B) South Australian Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations, and
- C) All *Automobiles* must comply with the conditions outlined in the 2024 Motorsport Australia Manual – Vehicle Technical, Appendix Off Road Appendix–General Requirements and Specific Requirement for Off Road Vehicles.

## ARTICLE 8

## COMPETITOR AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

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- A) As per the AORC Sporting Regulations.
- B) All crews and automobiles will be eligible for SA Off Road Championship points and awards.
- C) Compulsory crew briefings will be held at 1250 on Friday 26 July 2024 in the Tavern area

## ARTICLE 9

## ENTRY FORM, ENTRIES, ENTRY FEE & REFUND POLICY

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- A) Entries are to be made via the online entry form available from [Motorsport Event Entry](#). Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Event Secretary. Payment is to be by Credit Card or bank transfer, as directed on the entry form. Entries will only be accepted when the Competitor, Driver and Navigator have been nominated on the entry form and payment has been made in full.
- B) All entries **MUST** include a copy of all required documentation i.e. licenses (Motorsport Australia and civil), automobile registration papers and club memberships.
- C) Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- D) Entries close at 2359hrs on Monday 15 July 2024, for all crews.
- E) The number of entries will be limited to **100**. If this limit is exceeded, preference will be given to higher seeded drivers and/or those who have competed in other AORC events in 2024, and then in order of receipt of completed and paid entry forms. The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR (or to cancel the event if less than 40 entries are received by the close of entries).
- F) The entry fees for the Event are fixed as follows:
  - Motorsport Australia Off Road Championship (10 Laps) \$1,550.00
  - South Australian Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations (8 Laps) \$ 550.00
- G) Additional navigators may compete, providing they are properly nominated on the entry form.
- H) AORC and SXS entries include the AORC promotional Fee of \$95 that the organisers will remit to Motorsport Australia within 7 days of the Event.
- I) Entry fee includes Motorsport Australia permit and promotion fees, medical services fees, transponder hire, track reinstatement, officials support, RallySafe unit hire and RallySafe personnel.
- J) There is a \$30 per person admission fee for the weekend into the Loveday 4x4 Adventure Park payable at the gate on arrival. This applies to everyone including competitors, service crew and spectators. This grants access for the weekend and applies to every person over 14 years of age. Under 14 free  
The main gate will be closed for entry from 10:00pm to 6am Friday and Saturday.
- K) Entries withdrawn after close of entry but prior to publication of the Entry List for the event will have their Entry Fee refunded less \$100 (Administration fee).
- L) Any entry withdrawn after the Entry List has been published and prior to <DATE>, may be refunded up to 30% of their entry fee. For withdrawals after this date there will be NO REFUND,
- M) If the Event is cancelled less than 48 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition for reasons of Force Majeure, the Organisers may retain up to 25% of the Entry fee as per the NCR.
- N) Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

## ARTICLE 10

## INSURANCE

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Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

- A) Service vehicles, management vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, are not to be considered as official participants of the event. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the Event and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.



## ARTICLE 11

## RUNNING OF THE EVENT

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- A) The Event will start from Loveday 4x4 park, at 0900 hrs on 26 July 2024
- B) The starting system for the event will be in accordance with the AORC Sporting Regulations.
- C) The official time for the Event shall be set to Australian Central Standard Time, Adelaide SA, (GMT+9:30).
- D) Competition in each section will only be available to an automobile:
  - Having finished the previous section; or
  - Having started, but not necessarily finished, the previous section and has requested to be seeded for the next section.
- E) Any crew wishing to start in the next section must advise the Competitor Relations Officer of the intention to restart no later than the time allocated in Article 2 Event Program in the front of these Supplementary Regulations.
- F) Course marking shall be in accordance with the standard signs noted in Article 10 of the Motorsport Australia Off Road Standing Regulations.
- G) The Event will consist of a prologue of 7km to determine the start order for Section 1. The Event comprises 10 laps of the 40km course for AORC and 8 laps for SAORC.
- H) The Event will be run in four sections comprising a maximum of three laps per section and heats if required. The surface of the course will be a combination of gravel, dirt and natural surfaces.
- I) If heats are used, the number of heats will be determined by the number of entries and/or Automobiles still competing prior to the start of a section at the Clerk of the Course's discretion, and advised to competitors.
- J) If 2 heats are used for a section, the field will be split slowest 60% and fastest 40% or as close as viable.
- K) Refer to the event schedule for running times.
- L) The start order for the prologue will be determined by the Sporting Director based on seeding in each class and advised by the Organiser to Competitors.
- M) Automobiles will start 1 at a time with a minimum of 20 second intervals for all sections.

## ARTICLE 12

## SCRUTINEERING

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- A) Competitors will be required to Self-Scrutiny their competition *Automobiles*, apparel and safety devices and complete the Self Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance and the Self Scrutiny Checklist.
- B) These forms can be found via [www.loveday4x4adventures.com](http://www.loveday4x4adventures.com) website Loveday 400 tab - the entry form has been submitted and must be completed and submitted by the online upload form before 7pm Tuesday 25 July 2024.
- C) Self-Scrutiny and Statement of Vehicle Compliance forms are to be uploaded here [www.loveday4x4adventures.com](http://www.loveday4x4adventures.com) website Loveday 400 tab. The organisers will conduct Full Scrutiny on 10% of the field. The organisers will notify the competitors that need to conduct Full Scrutiny. Apparel checks will be done throughout the event.
- D) Failure to return the forms will result in your entry declared null and void.
- E) All signage required by the AORC Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations must be in place for scrutineering, at which time, scrutineers will check the signage placement.
- F) Scrutiny spot checks will be carried out at any time throughout the event to check compliance.
- G) Should it be found that a Competitor, Driver or Co-Driver/Navigator is using non-compliant apparel or has otherwise presented and or competed in a non-compliant *Automobile*, be it a safety or eligibility non-compliance, then that Competitor, Driver or Co-driver/Navigator must be referred to the Clerk of the Course/Stewards, in accordance with the NCR.
- H) The Clerk of the Course/Stewards will be required to investigate the matter, as appropriate, and ensure that action is taken commensurate with the infringement which may include disqualification from the event and any other penalty as deemed necessary.

- I) **Please Note that there will be random Self Extrication tests conducted as part of Scrutineering, at the discretion of the AORC Technical Delegate and Chief Scrutineer of the event. All competitors will be tested throughout the course of the year.**

## **ARTICLE 13 RECONNAISSANCE**

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- A) As per the AORC Sporting Regulations.
- B) A reconnaissance schedule is shown in Article 2 Event Program.
- C) Competition crew will be given the opportunity to reconnoitre the 40km course once on Friday 26th July in a suitable road registered vehicle during the time listed in the event schedule. Proof of registration must be provided if requested and vehicle conditional registration and or permits will not be accepted.
- D) The maximum speed for reconnaissance is 80km/h and will be monitored and enforced.
- E) Competition crew will be given the opportunity to conduct reconnaissance of the 7km Prologue course on Friday 26 July in their competition vehicle in full competition attire at the time listed in the event schedule.
- F) During prologue reconnaissance only 1 lap is permitted with a maximum speed of 120km/h
- G) No vehicle will be permitted to start reconnaissance after the sweep vehicle departs.

## **ARTICLE 14 PIT/PADDOCK AREAS AND REFUELLING**

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- H) As per the AORC Sporting Regulations and Article 11.10 Refuelling of the 2024 Motorsport Australia Off Road Standing Regulations.
- I) The Event will be using a Paddock and Pit format; only competition Automobiles permitted in the Pit.
- J) No unauthorised persons, including persons under the age of 16, are permitted in the pit area.
- K) Any person/s working on competition Automobiles must be registered as service crew, signed on and wearing their issued arm band at all times.
- L) Crew members are always reminded of their responsibility regarding the wearing of passes and of the entry of unauthorised persons into their pit area.
- M) Entry in and out of these areas must be via the designated entry point/s
- N) The maximum permitted speed is 20kph.
- O) Competition Automobiles are required to park on tarps or drop sheets.
- P) Welding/grinding may only occur in the designated hot work area.
- Q) No open flame devices, eg BBQs, heaters etc., are to be used between 7:00am and 5:00pm each day within the Pit/Paddock.
- R) The Pit/Pit Lane shall be used for all repairs, servicing and refuelling during a section.
- S) If you are towed/escorted back and wish to continue in the section, allowed time permitting, you must work on your Automobile in the Pit Lane. If you return to the Paddock area during a section you will be deemed to be out of that section and classified as Did Not Finish.
- T) Only tow vehicles and competition Automobiles permitted in the Paddock.
- U) Self-contained vehicles located in the Paddock may be slept in, all other camping is available in the designated camp area, behind the Loveday Tavern.
- V) Fires are permitted in the Paddock from 5:00pm until 11:00pm each day in fire drums or fire pits with a 4 metre clearance of all objects, other than humans. No burning of general waste or plastics. BYO firewood or purchase from the Tavern at \$20 per bag.
- W) Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 10 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

## **ARTICLE 15 APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS**

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For consistency, the penalties and other Sporting Regulations in the AORC Sporting Regulations shall apply to all crews entered in the Loveday 400 (AORC), and any other associated events.

## ARTICLE 16

## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND RED FLAGS

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Crews must make themselves familiar with these emergency procedures, as outlined in the Supplementary Regulations and in front of the road book. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty.

### A) Emergency Procedure

- I. In the case of an accident where urgent medical or fire attention is required, where possible the red "SOS" sign should be immediately displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. The Crew, if possible, where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) should press the "SOS" button, if available. The system will ask "Medical" or "Fire"? The Crew must press one of the buttons to confirm the situation which will advise Event Command so the correct emergency service can be dispatched. This can be done at any time following an accident, even if the "OK" message has been activated. If possible, the Crew should call the Rally Command emergency number and advise of their status.
- II. Any crew which has, the RallySafe red SOS screen displayed, the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees an automobile which has sustained an accident but is not displaying the green "OK" sign shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance.
  - a. All following automobiles shall also stop.
  - b. The first automobile on the scene shall remain to render assistance.
  - c. The second automobile at the scene, if necessary, shall proceed to inform the next SOS radio point.
  - d. Notwithstanding the above, any person with appropriate training should remain on the scene if the situation demands
  - e. Subsequent automobiles shall leave a clear route for emergency vehicles and proceed at a reduced speed, to a maximum of 60kp/h, until the end of the lap, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers.
  - f. Crews affected by this procedure will be allocated a time according to Article 5.4 of the AORC Sporting and Technical Regulations
- III. In the event of an automobile stopping on the stage or an accident where immediate medical or fire intervention is not required, the "OK" sign must be clearly and actively shown by a Crew member to at least the three following Automobiles and to any helicopter attempting to assist. Where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) the Crew **MUST** press the "OK" button within 1 minute of the Automobile stopping, for any reason. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty

### B) Red Flag

In the event of a section needing to be stopped, for any reason, Check Point officials will wave a red flag and the screen of the RallySafe console will turn red and show the message "RED FLAG". On seeing any of these indications the crew **MUST**: reduce speed to less than 80km/h for the remainder of the lap; and

- I. Crews must immediately confirm receipt of the electronic red flag by pressing the "ACKNOWLEDGE" button.
- II. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

## ARTICLE 17

## RESULTS AND PROTESTS

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- A) Provisional results will be published on Sportity and the Event Notice Board. These provisional results will become final 30 minutes after publication, subject to no protests being received, no issues are raised out of post event scrutineering and have been approved by the Stewards.
- B) Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- C) The events listed in Article 5 (D) will be scored and results issued by Rally Safe Results Service.

## ARTICLE 18

## AWARDS

- A) As per the AORC Sporting Regulations.
- B) The following awards may be presented:  
South Australian Off Road Champion Outright awards will be presented to:  
Event outright 1st, 2nd and 3rd Drivers and Navigators  
Event class awards may be presented to:  
1st in class where there is 3 or less entries in a class  
1st, 2nd and 3rd where there are 4 or more entries in a class

## ARTICLE 19

## INTEGRITY

- A) Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorized by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.  
Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- B) **Consumption of alcohol in the Service Park or any section of the competition venue under the control of event officials is forbidden until ALL competition is concluded each day.**

## ARTICLE 20

## EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

### A) COURSE DETAILS

The Prologue Lap will be approximately 7 kms in length.

The Full Course Lap will be approximately 40kms in length. The time allowed to complete each full course lap is 45 minutes as listed below.

AORC Competitors shall complete the following;

Prologue	1 x 7 km lap		
Section 1	2 x 40km laps	Start order from Prologue	Allowed time 90 minutes
Section 2	3 x 40km laps	Start order from Section 1 results	Allowed time 135 minutes
Section 3	3 x 40 km laps	Start order from Section 2 results	Allowed time 135 minutes
Section 4	2 x 40km laps	Start order from Section 3 results	Allowed time 90 minutes

SAORC Competitors shall only complete prologue and Sections 1 to 3.

### B) JUDGES OF FACT

Event Officials, Starter and Timekeepers will be deemed Judge of Fact about whether or not a vehicle follows the prescribed course, relative order, time of arrival, direction of travel, direction of entry into controls, start procedure and jumping the start. Competitors should note that RallySafe is a Judge of Fact in relation to timing, cutting of the course, and failing to reasonably allow competitors to overtake.

### C) RECOVERY

Recovery vehicles will be provided and managed by the Event Organisers. They will be identified with a vehicle number (ie. R1), and a white flag on the vehicle. Recovery will be conducted during the Event, and all efforts will be made (where safe and reasonable) to get competitor *Automobiles* to a location where service crews may collect them or returned to Pits/Paddock. No persons, other than authorized Event officials, are permitted onto the course at any time, without the express permission of the Clerk of the Course

#### **D) INCIDENT REPORTS**

Competitors involved in any form of incident during the event (including damage to property or farm infrastructure) must fill out and submit an Incident report. Failure to do so may result in competitors being referred to the Event Stewards for further action.

*Automobiles* which are involved in an accident involving damage shall be re-examined by the Chief Scrutineer or his delegate before being permitted to take further part in the competition.

#### **E) OBSERVERD LICENCE TEST**

Competitors are advised that Observed Licence Tests (OLTs) will NOT be conducted at this Event, as there is no provision for such an activity at the venue. Competitors will need to ensure they have the appropriate licence prior to attending the Event.

#### **F) VISION RECORDING EQUIPMENT**

Cameras on vehicles may be checked for secure mounting. Other Photography is restricted to Public Areas with the exception of Accredited Media.

No aerial photography by “drone” or other similar device is permitted unless the User has registered by Monday 24 July 2024 and can present evidence of authorisation issued by CASA/Motorsport Australia and proof of public liability insurance.

#### **G) VENUE**

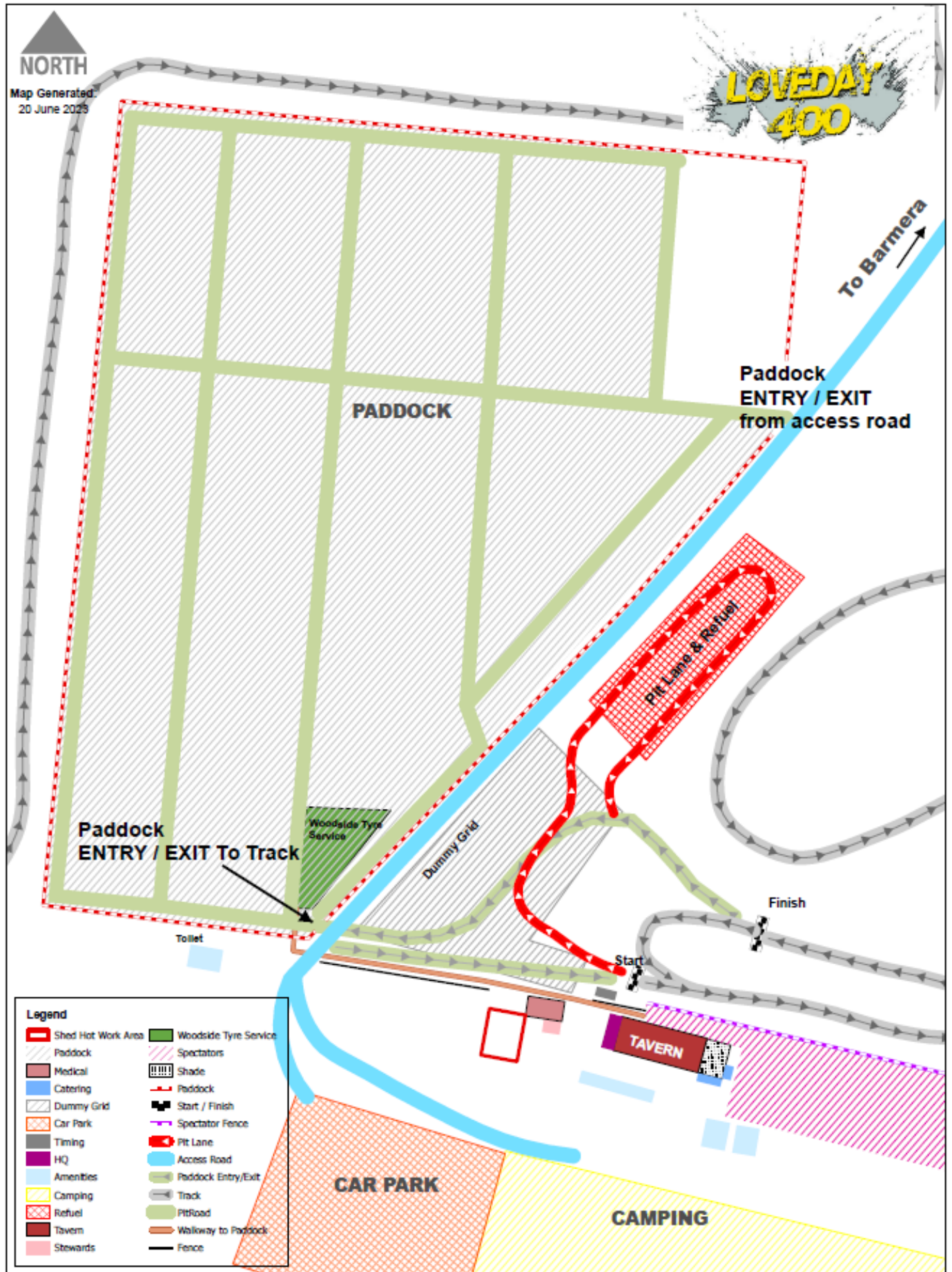
There is a \$30 per person admission fee for the weekend into the Loveday 4x4 Adventure Park payable at the gate on arrival. This applies to everyone including competitors, service crew and spectators. This grants access for the weekend and applies to every person over 14 years of age. Under 14 free

The main gate will be closed for entry from 10:00pm to 6am Friday and Saturday.

#### **H) MISCELLANEOUS**

- a) The maximum permitted speed in non-competition areas is 20km/h.
- b) Only officials, accredited media or competing crew are permitted on the course.
- c) No glass bottles or glass containers.
- d) No fuel will be available at the track.
- e) Catering will be available from Thursday evening for the weekend.
- f) A noise and general curfew shall apply from 11pm every night.
- g) Camping is available in the designated camping area at the venue and is included in the venue entry fee.
- h) No animals in or around the tavern or lawn area.
- i) No burning of crank cases, tyres or rubbish.
- j) Please place all rubbish in the bins provided.
- k) No BYO drinks into the tavern or grassed area's.
- l) No quads or bikes allowed (organisers excepted).
- m) No collecting of firewood on the property.
- n) No night driving except on main access road to enter or leave the venue.
- o) Any person found abusing the venue may be charged and referred to the Stewards. All competitors are responsible for the actions of their crew and vehicle/s (being competition or not).
- p) Competitors are reminded of their responsibility regarding the conduct of their crew at all times.

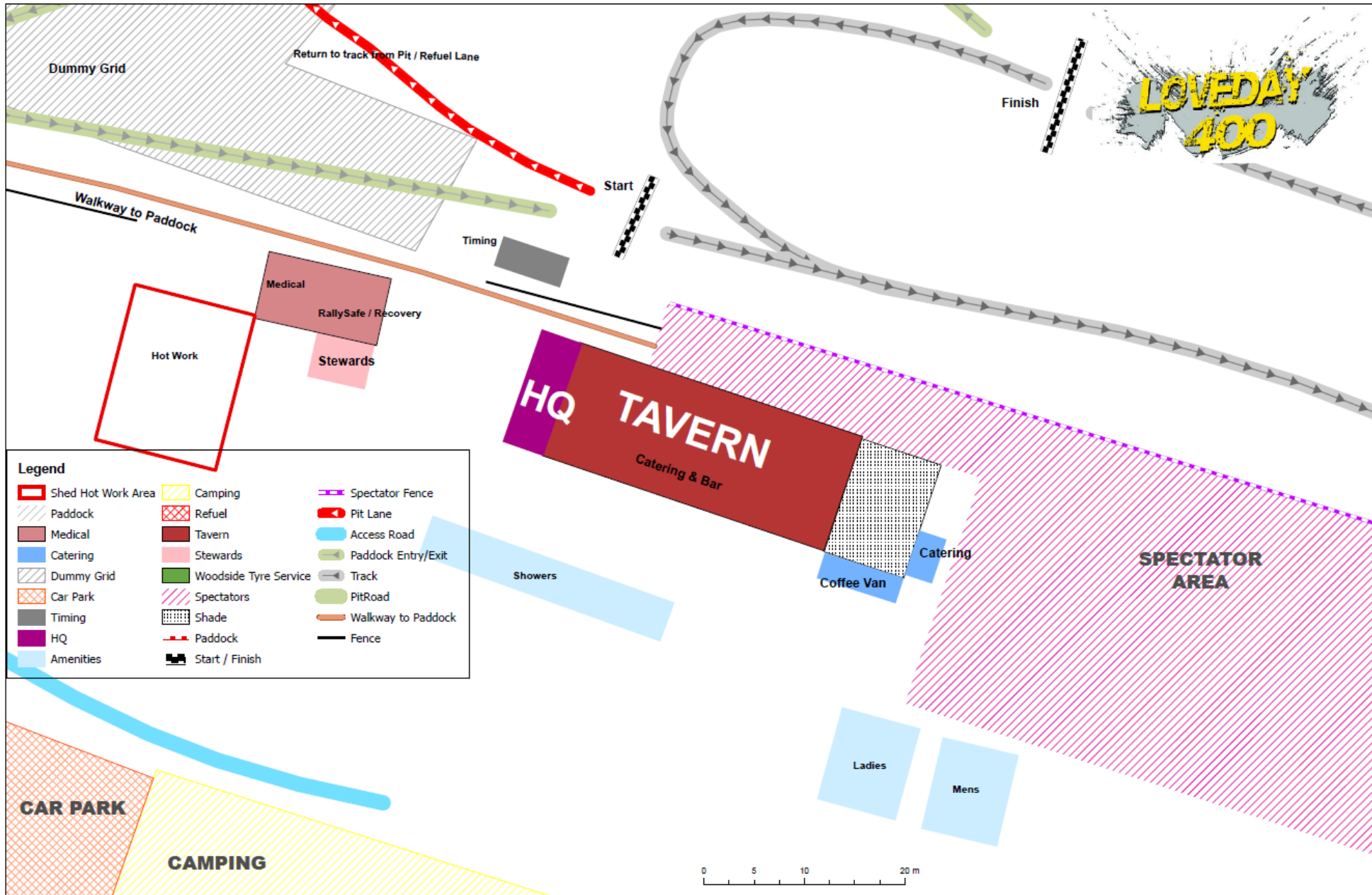
# ATTACHMENT 1 Paddock / PIT MAP

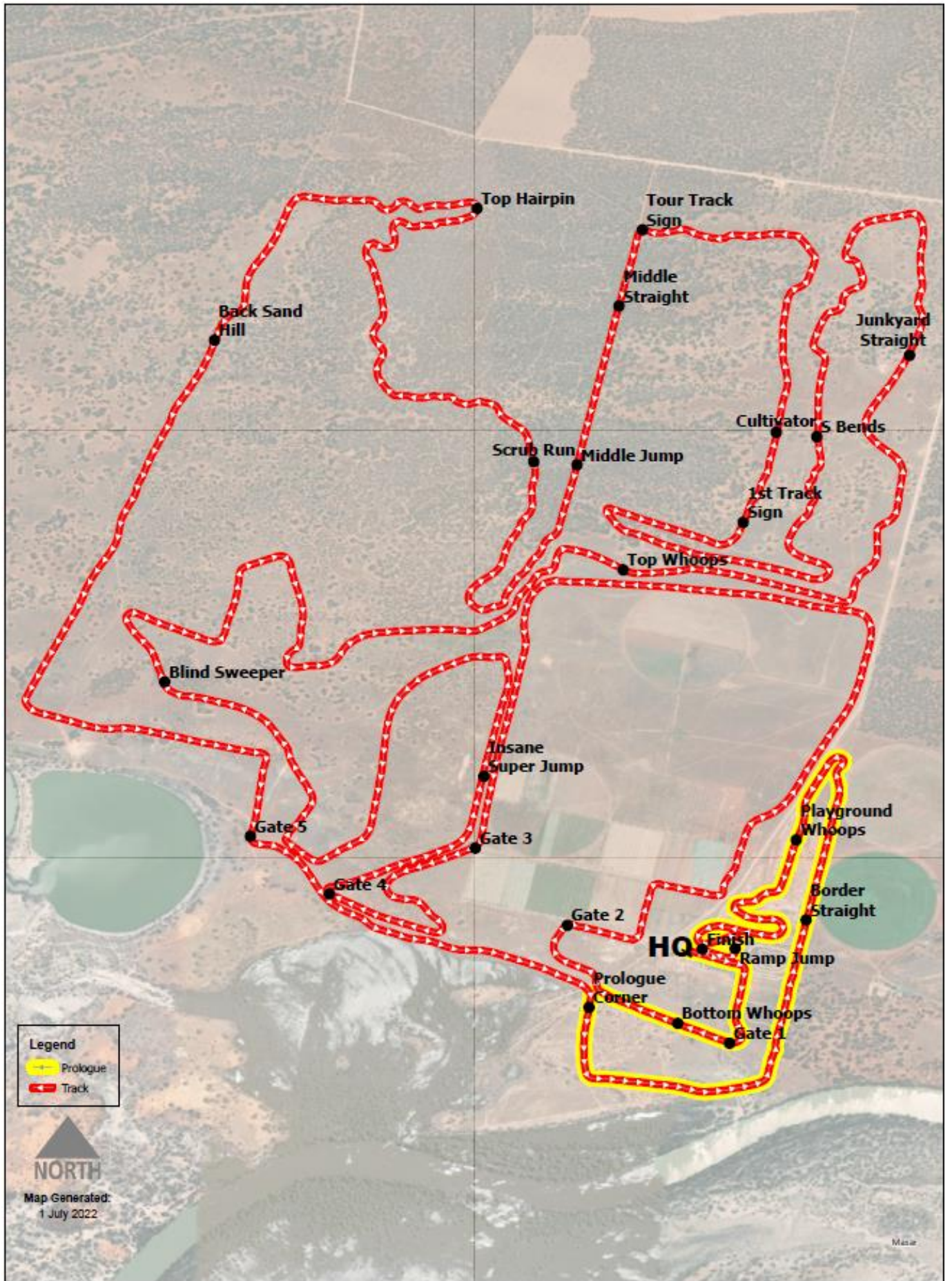


# ATTACHMENT 2 VENUE ZOOM
