TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS, AND MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA OFF ROAD STANDING REGULATIONS.

4: PRINCIPAL OFFICIALS

12: SCRUTINEERING

Competitors are required to complete the Motorsport Australia “Self Scrutiny Checklist – Off Road” and present it at Event Documentation on Friday April 19 (if they haven’t submitted it already with their entry). Please note that Targeted Scrutiny and Self Extrinsication Testing may still be conducted during the time allocated for the “Show N Shine” activity on Friday April 19. Competitors are required to present their vehicles at the “Show N Shine” in “Race Ready” condition, including providing all apparel and helmets for inspection. Please note that Media Representatives may wish to conduct interviews during this time, so please don’t stray too far from your vehicles!

Competitors are reminded to ensure they meet the minimum required standard for Fire Extinguishers in their vehicles (4kgs, with at least 2 kgs accessible from within the cockpit) and that their extinguishers are compliant and are in date.

There will be a \$500 prize awarded to the Best Presented Vehicle at the “Show N Shine”, which will be judged between 16:00 and 17:30.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE ARE CURRENTLY NO ATMS AVAILABLE IN POONCARIE (DUE TO A TECHNICAL FAULT), SO YOU WILL NEED TO BRING CASH WITH YOU IF YOU REQUIRE IT

(EFTPOS is available at the Port Pitstop, Pooncarie Pub, and the Old Wharf Café, as well as most of the vendors (if not all) at the Racecourse. None have the ability to provide “Cash Out” with transactions)

Camp Fires are permitted in the Camping area, provided they are fully contained, and in a suitable fire pit/drum (i.e. not on the ground). No fires are permitted at any time in the Pit area.

Firewood will be available for purchase at the Port Pitstop General Store in Pooncarie. It is forbidden to collect wood from any private properties adjacent to the Racecourse, or indeed the local area. Showers and Toilets are available at the Racecourse, and there will be food vendors selling Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner, as well as Coffee and Cold Drinks. The Bar will also be open, and bags of Ice will be available for purchase. There is also Ice available for sale at the Pooncarie Pub.

Dogs are only permitted in the Camping Area, and must be kept on a leash at all times.

The Port Pitstop General Store will have fuel available for Sale (Diesel, 91 Unleaded and 98 Unleaded), as well as food, drinks, and basic groceries. They will open with extended hours especially for the event, from 6am-7pm on the Saturday and Sunday. The nearest Supermarkets are down in Wentworth or Dareton. For those who don't wish to camp at Pooncarie (there is no accommodation available) the nearest motel is the Coomealla Club Motel (supporters of the event) in Dareton.

For anyone requiring a Vehicle Rental whilst attending the Event (remembering that Reconnaissance of the Full Course must be conducted in a Road Registered Car), Sixt Car Rentals in Mildura are supporters of the event, and will look after anyone associated with the Pooncarie Desert Dash.

When choosing your route to Pooncarie, please note that the majority of the Menindee-Pooncarie Road is now sealed, and all weather. It is not advised to use Wamberra Rd as a shortcut from Mildura (despite what Google Maps tells you!) as it is very rough, and likes to destroy trailers (as some found out last year)!

Travel safely, and we look forward to seeing you all at Pooncarie on April 19!
