Art. 11.1 Riders' Briefing(s)

See programme (SR Art. 3)

At the first briefing of the event, the participation of the competitor is compulsory. Any competitor not attending the pre-event briefing will incur a penalty of 100,00 €.

Then, an electronic briefing will be published on sportity at 5.00 pm.

Every day, the W2RC "winner of the day" will be awarded. The presence of the best classified rider of each category on the day's Stage among those eligible to score points for the FIM Cross Country Rallies World Championship Regulations is compulsory.

Art. 11.3 Starting order procedures and order

For all the stages (except for the Prologue), the minimum gap between the ideal start time of the last motorcycle and the start of the first car will be 30 minutes.

Reminder: By no means can a rider start once the first car has started.

Starting order for prologue:

The starting order for prologue will be:

RallyGP riders by W2RC Standings, next RallyGP riders by crescent numbers.

Rally2 riders by W2RC Standings, next Rally2 riders by crescent numbers.

Rally3 riders by crescent numbers.

Quad riders by W2RC Standings next Quad by crescent numbers.

Starting intervals for prologue, SS2 and SS7:

RALLYGP: every 1 minute

RALLY2/RALLY3/QUADS: every 1 minute

Starting order for stage 1:

See Art. FIM 80.17.3

Ten competitors will choose their starting order for Stage 1 from the first ten places.

These ten competitors will be made up of the Rally GP and the first Rally2 from the prologue.

Competitors will choose their starting order in accordance with the procedure described in article 80.17.3 of the World Championship regulations."

Starting Order for subsequent stages:

The starting order of Stage 2 and the following stages will be established in the order of the scratch classification of the Selective Section, or of the accumulation of the Selective Sections of the previous day.

Starting intervals:

- First 10 riders: 3 minutes interval
- From 10th to 20th: 2 minutes interval
- From 21st: 1 minute interval will start one at a time (or two at a time), every minute or every thirty seconds.
