Article 1 Announcement

1.1. The BTRDA Ltd will organise the Protyre Motorsport UK Asphalt Rally Championship in association with *Motorsport News* 2025, which will be coordinated by Paul Wakely and sponsored by Protyre. Permit No CH2025/RALLY 006 (B) has been issued by Motorsport UK Ltd.

Article 2 Jurisdiction


2.1. The event will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Championship Regulations, and any written instruction issued.

Article 3 Eligibility

3.1. The Protyre Motorsport UK Asphalt Rally Championship 2025 is open to all fully paid-up members of the BTRDA who are registered for the championship, having a Competition Licence of a grade appropriate to each event issued by Motorsport UK, or by Motorsport Ireland. Also, any professional competitors and drivers holding a licence issued by any EU country showing an EU Flag, being fully paid-up members of the BTRDA and registered for the championship, shall be entitled to take part and score points in the Championship.

Article 4 Registration

- 4.1. The registration fee is £80 for Drivers and £70 for Co-drivers. This registration fee includes full membership of the BTRDA (£30) which is an invited club on each event. Championship registration and BTRDA membership is free to new members under 25 for their first year of registration.
- 4.2. Membership can be done on-line at www.btrdamembership.com. Acceptance for the championship will be acknowledged by the issue of a registration card which must be produced at documentation on each event. Registration will open on the publication of these regulations and close at the conclusion of event signing-on at round 4, the Dunoon presents Argyll Rally on Friday 20th June 2025.
- 4.3. In order to score points on any event, you must be registered for the championship prior to that event taking place. Championship points will not be awarded retrospectively.
- 4.4. It would be in the competitor's interests to register for the championship well in advance of the first event, you can then supply the rally organisers with your 4-digit registration number as proof of registration, which will help with an entry should the rally be popular.
- **4.5. Competitors MUST** display the series decals as specified on every qualifying event. These include a compendium sponsor panel on each side, sponsors bumper decal on each side, and sponsors windscreen or bonnet decal.
- 4.6. Prospective competitors should check their own sponsorship and signwriting arrangements before deciding to enter the championship.
- 4.7. If Championship decals are not displayed as required at the start of and during an event, the competitor will be deemed ineligible for the allocation of championship points for that event, which will be reallocated to the next registered competitor.
- 4.8. Decals must not be modified by altering logo sizes or colours. They can be trimmed where exceptionally necessary to fit the vehicle, but this must be approved in writing by the eligibility scrutineers or championship coordinator.





- A. Compendium Sponsors panel on the leading edge of the front door on each side, approx. 225mm x 450mm.
- B. Sponsors bumper decal on each side, approx. 150mm x 50mm.
- C. Sponsors windscreen (at top of screen) or bonnet (at leading edge) decals, approx. 115mm x 1000mm.
- D. R&R sticker on rear screen as photo.
- 4.9. Once a competitor has registered for the championship, it is not possible to de-register, even if the series decals are removed.

4.10. ALL THE ABOVE DECALS MUST BE FIXED IN THE CORRECT POSITION BEFORE THE CAR IS PRESENTED FOR SCRUTINEERING.

Article 5 Enforcement of Regulations

- 5.1. The championship is subject to the General Competition rules of the BTRDA Ltd and the Motorsport UK. Any query regarding these regulations or the running of the Protyre Motorsport UK Asphalt Rally Championship 2025 must be referred to BTRDA Ltd via the championship coordinator. Any subsequent protest must be referred in writing to the BTRDA Panel of Stewards, via the BTRDA Ltd secretary within the time limits in accordance with the Motorsport UK NCR's together with the appropriate fee. (Competition Fees Appendix 1). The BTRDA Ltd panel of stewards will comprise any three from, Mr Andrew Kellitt, Mr Martin Leonard, Mr Jason Murphy and Mr Ryland James.
- 5.2. In the event of a variance between these regulations and the BTRDA Ltd championship rulebook, these championship regulations take precedence.

Article 6 Vehicle Classes and Eligibility

- 6.1. All competing vehicles must comply with the 2025 Motorsport UK safety and technical regulations for special stage rallies.
- 6.2. Homologation papers for cars in classes 1, 4, 5, 7 must be carried in the rally car and be always readily available for inspection.
- 6.3. The engine capacity of all turbocharged and rotary engine cars is deemed to be increased by a factor of 1.7; forced induction rotary engines equivalence is 2.89 (1.7×1.7); rotary engines are allowed a maximum of 2 rotors and will be considered equivalent to 4 valves per cylinder petrol engines in respect of the maximum engine capacity including the abovementioned equivalency factors and the appropriate class must be entered.

6.4. The Historic classes must have a historic rally vehicle identity form available for inspection and must use fuel complying with 2025 Motorsport UK Technical Regulations. Category 3 cars must also present the appropriate homologation form, and any other documentation listed in the 2025 Motorsport UK NCR's. Only period modifications used in rallying on the particular make and model of vehicle are permitted.

6.5. A DRIVER OR CO-DRIVER WHO CHANGES TO A DIFFERENT CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS TO THAT WHEN THEY REGISTERED MUST NOTIFY THE CHAMPIONSHIP COORDINATOR PRIOR TO STARTING AN EVENT UNDER THE NEW CLASS

6.6. Any vehicles used by registered contenders may be subject to random eligibility and capacity checks throughout the year. These checks will be carried out by the championship scrutineers and/ or members of the Motorsport UK technical commission who shall be considered Judges of Fact in matters of eligibility. In the event of a car being found ineligible for any reason, then the penalties specified in Motorsport UK Regulations (NCR Chapter 2, Appendix 8) shall apply. The competitor will be responsible for any costs they incur as result of eligibility checking, whether found eligible or otherwise. The championship organisers reserve the right to reclassify any vehicle if they consider it appropriate to do so.

Article 7 Scoring

- 7.1. The Protyre Motorsport UK Asphalt Rally Championship 2025 provides the best selection of sealed surface events throughout the UK and the final points tables will be based on competitors best 5 scores from 7 rallies. This applies to all classes.
- 7.2. If through "force majeure" any of the qualifying events cannot take place the BTRDA reserves the right to:
 - a) Include the event on a different date if the original date has been altered due to military activity, a country pandemic, event postponement due to unforeseen circumstances.
 - b) Include another event on the same date.
 - c) Change a current event to a double header scoring round.
 - d) Alter the number of scores to count, for example, 5 from 7, 4 from 6.
 - e) Cancel the championship if less than 4 counting rounds take place.

- 7.3. The allocation of series points will be based on the final results of the qualifying events. The points will be published on the series website as soon as possible after each event. Queries should be addressed to the championship coordinator. Subject to no protests being received, these points will become final 7 days later. Similarly, at the end of the year, the series points will become final 7 days after the provisional points are published on the website.
- 7.4. Codrivers can score points with unregistered drivers provided the cars carry the Protyre sun strip and a BTRDA decal on the codrivers door.
- **7.5. Overall points** will be awarded to the highest placed **registered** drivers and co-drivers on each event as follows:

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1<sup>st</sup> - 30 points
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 2^{nd} – 28 points

3rd - 27 points

and so, on down to 2 points to the 28th placed registered driver and co-driver overall, and every subsequent driver and co-driver who finishes the event. 1 point will be awarded to every non-finisher.

7.6. Class Points – will be awarded to the highest placed **registered** driver/co-driver in each class on each qualifying round as follows:

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1<sup>st</sup> - 15 points
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2nd - 12 points

3rd - 10 points

4th - 9 points

and so on down to 12th - 1 point

7.7. Historic Cup Points will be awarded as follows:

 1^{st} – 30 points, 2^{nd} – 28 points, 3^{rd} – 27 points and so on down to 2 points.

7.8. Ford Escort Challenge Open to all two-wheel drive Mk1, Mk2 or Mk3 RWD Ford Escorts. Points will be awarded to registered drivers and co-drivers on each event based on class index of performance as follows:

 1^{st} – 30 points, 2^{nd} – 28 points, 3^{rd} – 27 points and so on down to 2 points.

7.9. Mini Challenge Open to all Minis in the historic classes.

Points will be awarded to registered drivers and co-drivers on each event as follows: $1^{st} - 30$ points, $2^{nd} - 28$ points, $3^{rd} - 27$ points and so on down to 2 points.

7.10. Juniors Points will be awarded to registered drivers and co-drivers on each event as follows:

1st – 30 points, 2nd – 28 points, 3rd – 27 points and so on down to 2 points.

Drivers under 25 years on January 1st, 2025, in all classes are eligible to score points. Co-drivers under 25 years on January 1st, 2025, in all classes are eligible to score points.

Note: The Fuchs award for each event is to the highest placed junior driver on each rally.

7.11. Index of Performance – Escort Challenge.

An Index of Performance will be established for each class by taking the average time of the best 50% of finishers (or if there is an odd number of finishers, the total plus one) in each class.

Competitor's times are then expressed as a percentage of this average.

Should the best 50% of finishers represent less than five competitors, then the times of the class winner will be added to the other times of the class a sufficient number of times so that the average for the class can be based on five scores.

7.12. Ties - Any ties will be decided in favour of the competitor with the greatest number of maximum scores within their best six scores. In the event of a further tie the greatest number of second highest scores shall decide and so on. Should this fail to resolve the tie, the first highest score will decide it.

7.13. Should a registered driver or co-driver be in breach of the regulations, in the opinion of the Championship Organisers, any points which might have been awarded shall be forfeited and will be reallocated to the next registered driver or co-driver.

Article 8 Driver Incentives and Bonuses

- **8.1. Tyres** At the time of publication of these regulations, these apply to Michelin, Pirelli, and Hoosier tyres only. To **qualify** for the tyre prizes, **all** the tyres used in the championship must have been purchased from **Protyre Motorsport or their agreed suppliers, JD Tyres and Tyres South Shore**. You will also need to start a minimum of 3 rallies to qualify for the tyre prizes.
- 8.2. All competing cars must **always** carry the particular tyre manufacturer's logo on the car as the tyres they are running on the car at the time. Whatever brand of tyre you start an event with, you are to run with this brand of tyre for the entire event, unless due to weather changes or a supply issue, that the tyre manufacturer does not have a suitable tyre available. In this instance you must seek authorisation from the championship coordinator or a Protyre tyre representative.
- 8.3. The crew must wear the tyre manufacturer's winner's cap on the podium.
- 8.4. After each championship event, the Championship Coordinator will notify the tyre incentive manager with the names of the winners, the championship coordinator will also notify the winners via an email.
- 8.5. Tyres can be redeemed on the next championship event once you have started 3 championship rallies. 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} registered drivers overall in the general classification will not be eligible for class awards which will pass to the next classified driver.
- 8.6. Protyre will provide Michelin, Pirelli and Hoosier tyres to be used as awards to the best championship registered drivers in general classification on each event as follows:

1st overall 3 tyres.

2nd overall 2 tyres.

3rd overall 1 tyre.

In addition: 1st in class in **three** classes on each event as listed below will win 2 tyres each.

- 8.7. The tyres will match the ones used in the Championship by the driver winning the award. The prizes are only applicable where the driver has used Michelin, Pirelli or Hoosier tyres for the entire rally for which they are claiming the award.
- **8.8. Fuel** Vital Equipment / Carless Award winners of 2 classes on each rally will each win a 25litre drum of fuel for the next championship round.

Article 9 Championship Awards

- 9.1. All perpetual awards are the property of the BTRDA and will be retained by the club after the awards ceremony. These trophies will be made available for photographic purposes during the awards ceremony. **AWARD WINNERS MUST BE PRESENT AT THE END OF SEASON AWARDS CEREMONY**. Non-appearance may result in forfeiture of relevant awards. Awards not collected at the Awards Ceremony will **NOT** be posted.
- 9.2. TO QUALIFY FOR AN OVERALL AWARD OR CLASS AWARD A COMPETITOR MUST HAVE STARTED AT LEAST 3 QUALIFYING EVENTS.

9.3. Overall Awards

1st Driver - The Protyre Trophy, replica, & BTRDA Gold Star

1st Co-Driver - The Motordrive Seats Perpetual Trophy, replica, BTRDA Gold Star

 2^{nd} Driver - An Award 2^{nd} Co-Driver - An Award

 3^{rd} Driver - An Award 3^{rd} Co-Driver - An Award

1st, 2nd, 3rd overall drivers/co-drivers are ineligible for any class awards

9.4. Class Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class.

9.5. BTRDA Historic Asphalt Cup - Open to all Historic cars

1st Driver - An Award 1st Co-driver - An Award

9.6. Ford Escort Challenge

Awards to 1st, 2nd and 3rd Driver and Co-driver

9.7. Mini Challenge

Awards to 1st Driver and Co-driver

- **9.8. Fuchs Junior Driver Award** to the highest placed junior driver on each rally, 5 litres of Oil. To register as a junior driver, you will be 25 or under on January 1st, 2025.
- **9.9. OnThePaceNote Junior Co-Driver Award** OnThePaceNote will continue to support the Protyre Asphalt Junior championship, OTPN will offer the championship winning junior co-driver a professional style co-driver bag filled with many tools needed to do the job efficiently. There will be some OTPN merchandise. OTPN will give free access to the OnThePaceNote training course, Craig and Killian will follow their progress throughout the season as well as being on hand for any advice required during the 2025 season. All classes are eligible for the junior co-driver.
- **9.10. Tony Davies Memorial Award** to be presented to the individual who has done something special in relation to the Championship at the discretion of the Championship Coordinator.
- **9.11. Mintex Award** to the best improvement on start position awarded on each round to the registered competitor who finished the most places up from their start order position; the award offers 1 axle set FOC of Mintex Brake pads to suit the calliper used on the winning car.
- **9.12. The Dynamic Fluids Award** an award presented on each event from Lloyd Morgan of Dynamic Fluids to the owner / driver of the best presented car chosen by the championship eligibility scrutineer.
- **9.13. Additional Awards**. The organisers may present additional awards at their sole discretion.

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
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
