12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.2.1 CEREMONIAL START (add)

A pre-start holding area will be set up next to the WRC Square, where the start ramp will be located. All manufacturer teams are required to bring all their cars to the pre-start holding area on Wednesday, 30 July 2025 at 17.15–17.45. This applies also to Competitor No. 70 Team Flying Finn.

For the correct route to the pre-start holding area and the ceremonial start ramp, see Rally Guide 2, Appendix 4.4. An autograph session will be organised in this same area, for details see Art. 12.13 below.

The ceremonial start starts at 19.00. A start list will be published at 15.00 on the same day. For the Manufacturers (P1 crews), only one car per team will be driven to the start ramp (by the crew), with the other drivers and co-drivers of the team following on foot. Other competitors shall arrive to the pre-start holding area max. 10 min before their start time. **All P2 and P4 crews** shall arrive with their cars in order to drive over the start ramp. The rest of the competitors shall arrive to the ceremonial start on foot and will be interviewed on the ramp.

Driving overalls must be worn by all drivers. Regulatory underwear is not mandatory.

12.13 PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES WITH DRIVERS (add)

All P1 drivers are required to join a Photo Shoot at Harju. They should arrive to a meeting point at Harjukatu 6, Jyväskylä at 17.15 on Wednesday 30 July 2025, from where they will be guided to the photo location on foot. Driving overalls must be worn.

After the Photo Shoot, an autograph session will be organised in the Service Park of the rally, in the pre-start holding area next to the WRC Square, where the start ramp is located (for area lay-out, see Attachment 1). The autograph session takes place at 18.00–18.30 for all P1 drivers and co-drivers, as well as No. 70 Hakalehto – Ojala.

All competitors should bring their own promotional materials to be signed and given to the spectators.

A grid walk involving a small group of invited guests may be organised in the pre-start holding area. More information given on location.

12.14 VIRTUAL CHICANES (partly modified)

There will be approach warning signs counting down from 300 – 200 – 100 metres before the area starts. The SAS Tracking Unit will also be showing the distance to the start. The start and finish of the 200 metres long chicane area will be marked with ~~signs on both sides of the road~~ **arches over the road (during the rally)**.
