FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for being part of the Coulson's Autosolo 2023, organised by Cambridge Car Club with support from other clubs in the AMSC.

Venue

The venue is Flying Station Wattisham.

Access is via Crowcroft Rd, Nedging Tye, Ipswich IP7 7HR

This is an active Army Base, and **you will need some form of Photo ID with you to access the venue.** We will have registered your name & car details with the Station, so if you have to change your car you will need to let us know.

The access and route instructions are in the Safety Manual which is also on the Sportity server (see below). Please make yourself familiar with the contents of the manual for your safety and convenience and the safety of others.

Speed outside of the tests themselves should be kept very modest and there is an overall limit of 20 mph. Be aware that there may be people walking between tests. There will also be other vehicles and people in the surrounding area who are not involved in the Autosolo.

Please do not drive on the grass unnecessarily and do not damage it.

Security

As Flying Station Wattisham is an active MOD base, all areas outside the paddock, test areas & access to the area are out of bounds.

Anyone found in those areas could be held by the station security team and ejected from the venue or subject to whatever sanction the venue owners regard as appropriate.

You may take photographs and videos of the Autosolo but not of any military equipment, buildings or personnel.

Invited Club

Lotus Motor Club is now an invited club.

Timetable

In advance of the event please:

- Check your car meets the necessary regulations (see SRs, paragraphs 7 to 11). For vehicles to be eligible for the Autosolo event they must be road legal, taxed and, if more than 3 years old, to have an MOT certificate available for inspection
- Scrutineering and signing-on will be carried out on the day on the venue.
- Remember to bring your competition licence, club card, and your car's MOT if applicable

On Sunday 4th June the timetable will be:

7.30am	Access to the venue opens – Please do not arrive earlier- Have ID ready.
7.45am	Scrutineering & Signing on opens (do scrutineering 1 st please)
9.15am	Access to the venue closes
9.30am	Marshals briefing at event office– PA will be in use
9.45am	Drivers briefing at event office – PA will be in use
10:00am	First tests start.

The event office is the Blue Campervan parked in the paddock near the access to the tests with a CCC flag nearby.

We intend to hold at least two runs of each of four tests before a lunch break (we hope to run 3).

We will then hold at least two runs at each of four tests that will have been reversed from the morning runs, all time permitting.

There will be a 1 hour lunch break and engines must be switched off during this time.

We would recommend you install and use this App as it is the way we will be publishing documents for this event. – If you have trouble accessing the documents, please contact the Secretary of the Meeting or Clerk of the Course before the day of the event.

If you want paper copies of the test diagrams you will need to print these out – they will not be available at the venue.

Numbers will be provided by the organisers and must be attached in the rear side windows, or on the rear wings if there are no suitable windows.

Your number is given in the entry list on the On-Line Notice Board linked to above.

Timing will be via a smartphone app, marshals will be briefed separately on this. There will be no paper timecards filled in by the marshals.

You will have a timecard that you can record your times on that the marshals will show you at the end of each test, this is just for your personal use.

Competitors will be able to check the live results via their own smartphones or similar devices, see details at the end of this document.

Facilities

JD will be the food outlet in the paddock area, selling hot food and drinks.
Please patronise this facility.

There will be two toilets, one in the paddock area and another between tests B and C.

Please take away all rubbish that you generate through the day. We recommend you bring a rubbish bag.
Please clear up any spills, thank you.

How to monitor the results

As for the last few years CCC, along with other clubs, have been using online timing software. The marshals use this to record the times for each test and any penalties. These are compiled into an online results sheet that can be viewed whilst the competition is in progress.

You can install the app on your smart phone or tablet as follows:

- Android – go to Google Play – search for Autotest from Sapphire Solutions
- Apple – go to App Store – search for Production Car Autotest from Sapphire Solutions
- Alternatively open the website <https://autotest.sapphire-solutions.co.uk>
- Open the app and press Live
- Select the event **AMSC Coulson AutoSolo 04-06-23**.

There are several different views – Minimum, Overall, Detailed and Sub-Totals – according to how much information you want.

Internet access will be necessary if you want to use this feature. It is for competitors themselves to bring along a suitable device with mobile data. EE appears to have sufficient coverage on the airfield; we have not checked other operators.

Note that the rankings (e.g. 1st in class) will not necessarily be correct during the day as it will depend which scores have been received at the instant that you check the results.

We look forward to seeing you and hope that you will have an enjoyable day's sport at a great new venue.
