4th June 2023 Flying Station Wattisham
FINAL MARSHALS INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for being part of the Coulson's AutoSolo 2023, organised by Cambridge Car Club with support from other clubs in the AMSC.

Venue

The venue is Flying Station Wattisham.

Access is via Crowcroft Rd, Nedging Tye, Ipswich IP7 7HR

This is an active Army Base, and **you will need some form of Photo ID with you to access the venue.** We will have registered your name & car details with the Station, so if you have to change your car you will need to let us know.

The access and route instructions are in the Safety Manual which is also on the Sportivity server (see below). Please make yourself familiar with the contents of the manual for your safety and convenience and the safety of others.

Speed outside of the tests themselves should be kept very modest and there is an overall limit of 20 mph. Be aware that there may be people walking between tests. There will also be other vehicles and people in the surrounding area who are not involved in the Autosolo.

Please do not drive on the grass unnecessarily and do not damage it.

Security

As Flying Station Wattisham is an active MOD base, all areas outside the paddock, test areas & access to the area are out of bounds.

Anyone found in those areas could be held by the station security team and ejected from the venue or subject to whatever sanction the venue owners regard as appropriate.

You may take photographs and videos of the Autosolo but not of any military equipment, buildings or personnel.

Timetable

On Sunday 4th June the timetable will be:

7.00am	Access to the venue for senior officials for 10 minutes.
7:30am	Access open for all – Have ID ready
7.45am	Signing on & Scrutineering opens
9.15am	Access to the venue closes
9.30am	Marshals briefing at event office– PA will be in use
9.45am	Drivers briefing at event office – PA will be in use
10:00am	First tests start.

The event office is the Blue Campervan parked in the paddock near the access to the tests with a CCC flag nearby

We intend to hold at least two runs of each of four tests before a lunch break (we hope to run 3).

We will then hold at least two runs at each of four tests that will have been reversed from the morning runs, all time permitting.

There will be a 1 hour lunch break and engines must be switched off during this time.

We would recommend you install and use this App as it is the way we will be publishing documents for this event. – If you have trouble accessing the documents please contact the Secretary of the Meeting or Clerk of the Course before the day of the event.

Timing will be via the Autotest app from Sapphire Solutions. You can install the app on your smart phone or tablet as follows:

- Android – go to Google Play – search for Autotest from Sapphire Solutions
- Apple – go to App Store – search for Production Car Autotest from Sapphire Solutions

We plan to use 2 different methods of timing on different tests – the usual combined Start and Finish on tests A, B and C. We plan to use the separate Start & Finish timing on test D.

The event is **AMSC Coulson AutoSolo 04-06-23**.

If you want to have a go at using the app the access code is 2496.

Use the **CCC Test AutoSolo** to try it out.

Internet access will be necessary. EE appears to have sufficient coverage on the airfield, we have not checked other operators.

We hope to be able to allocate two timing marshals to each test. For tests A, B and C we plan that each of them time a car through the test and then complete the timing by calling them away from the stop line, adding any penalties to the system, showing the competitor the time on the app, filling in your check sheet and sending the result to the server.

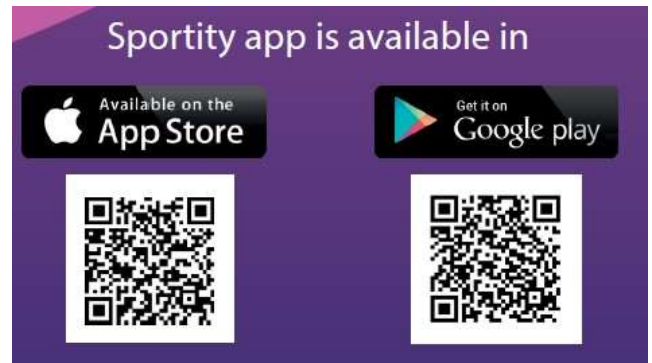
For test D, one marshal will time the competitor starting the test and the other will time the competitor finishing. The finish marshal will also add in any relevant penalties e.g., cones or wrong tests. The finish marshal, or a third marshal at the finish if available, will note the time and penalties on the check sheet.

There will be no paper timecards. Competitors will have a time card, for their own use, to record their times that you show them at the end of their run.

Competitors and marshals will be able to check the live results via their own smartphones or similar devices by using the Autotest app. There are several different views – Minimum, Overall, Detailed and Sub-Totals – according to how much information you want.

There will be VHF radios operating on this event using the following channels:

- Channel 5 for event management
- Channel 6 for test A
- Channel 7 for test B
- Channel 8 for test C
- Channel 9 for test D



Use the person's name for all formal communication. Precede calls with safety or urgent as appropriate if dealing with an incident. Wait out if an urgent call is in progress.
